Connect the Wireless Module

For programming, the MX10 Pro Gen 2 ESC requires a connection to the MX10 Pro wireless module. Follow these steps:

1. Plug the wireless module into the port between the fan connection and the power switch.

IMPORTANT: Verify correct polarity when plugging in the module.

1. If desired, use foam tape to secure the wireless module to the vehicle.
2. Refer to the MX10 Pro Gen 2 Electronic Speed Control online manual for detailed instructions on downloading and operating the Trinity ESC programming application.

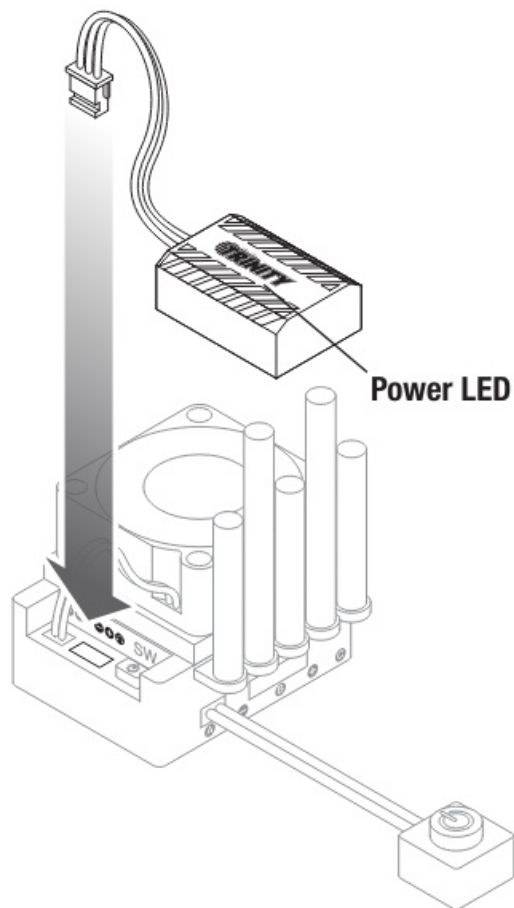

2. If you'd like, use foam tape to secure the wireless module to the vehicle.

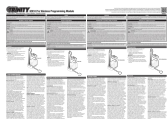
