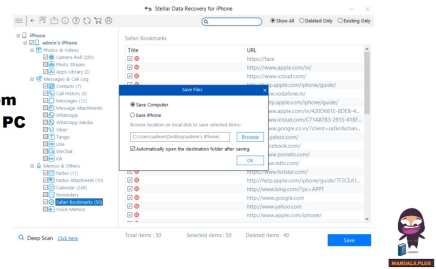

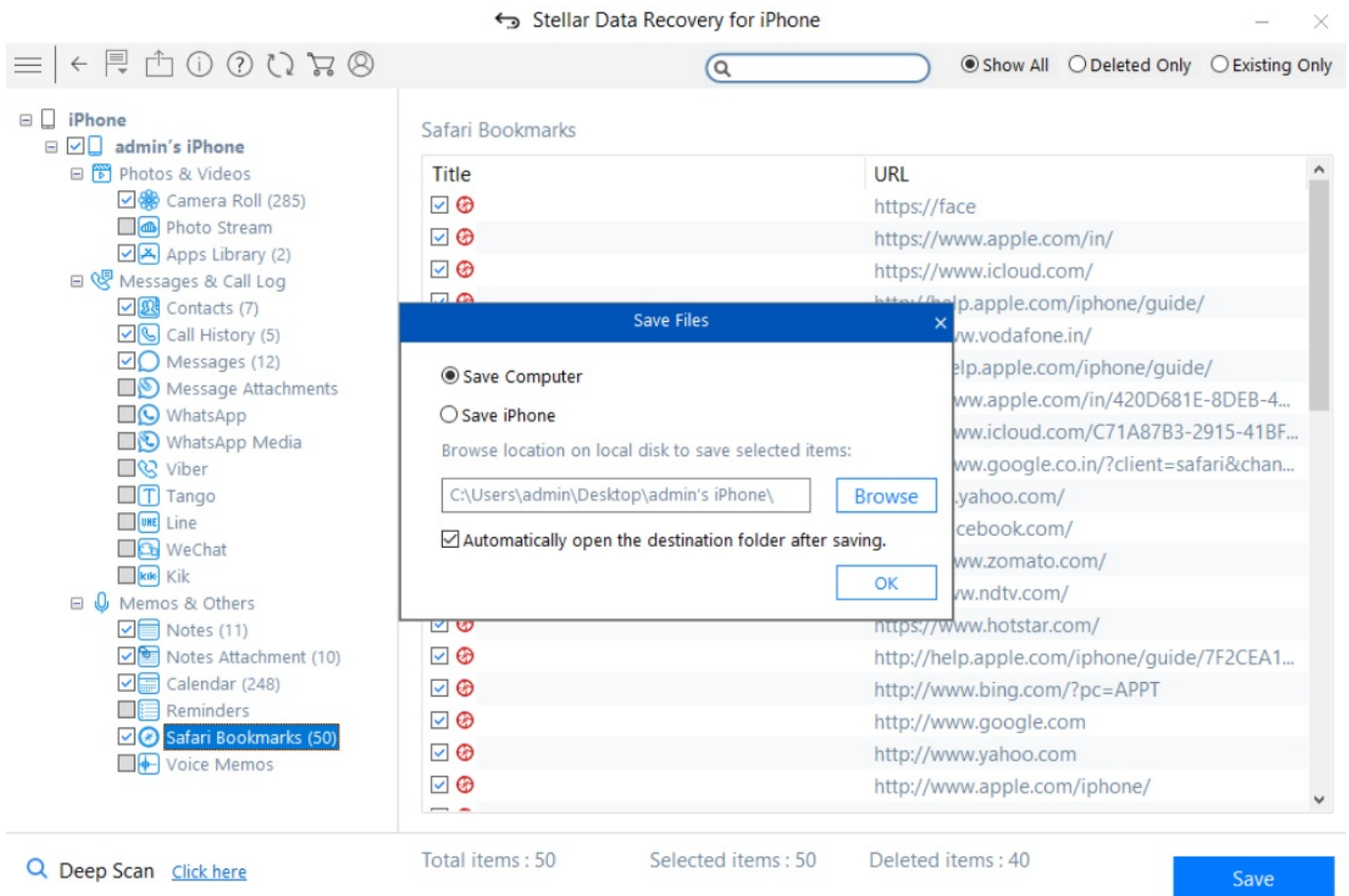

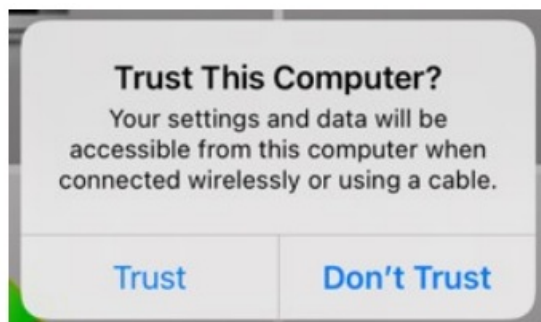
Specifications

- Product Name: HouseMate iOS Backup & Restore
- Compatibility: iOS devices
- Software Required: iTunes

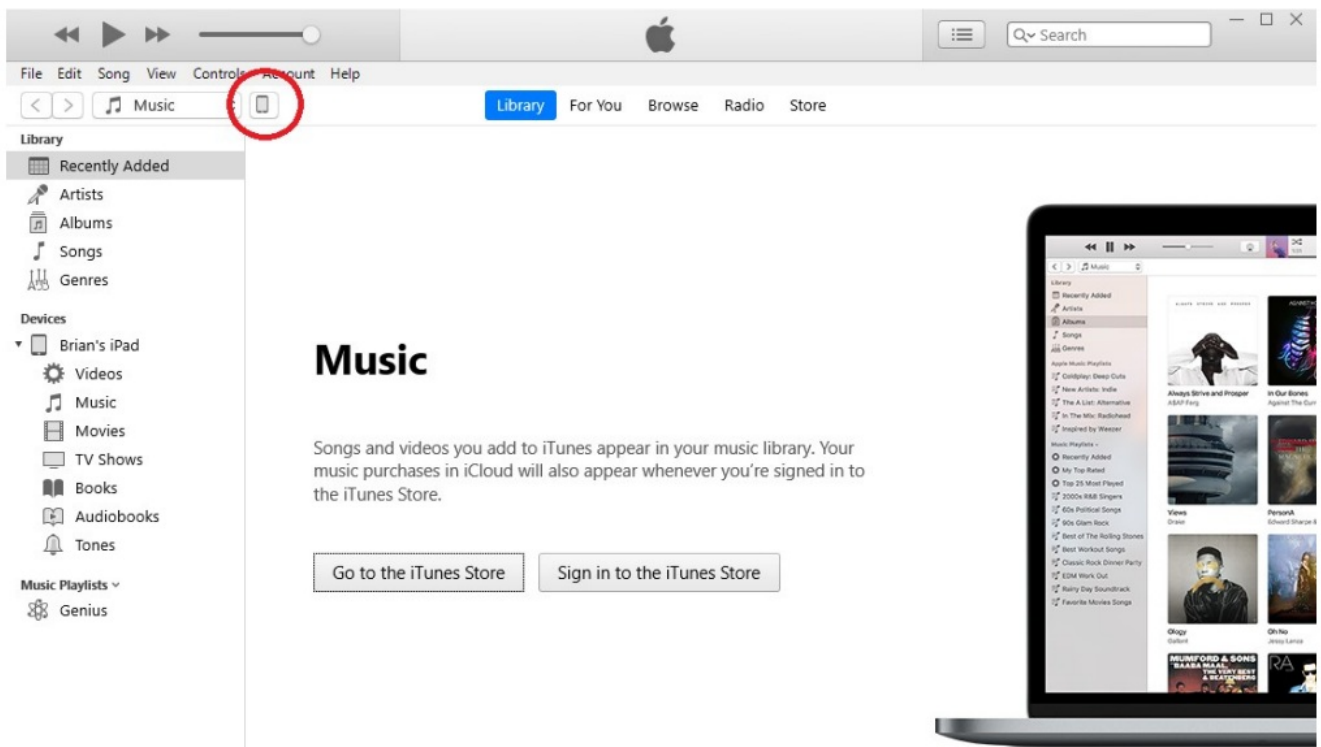
Step 1: Install iTunes on your PC.

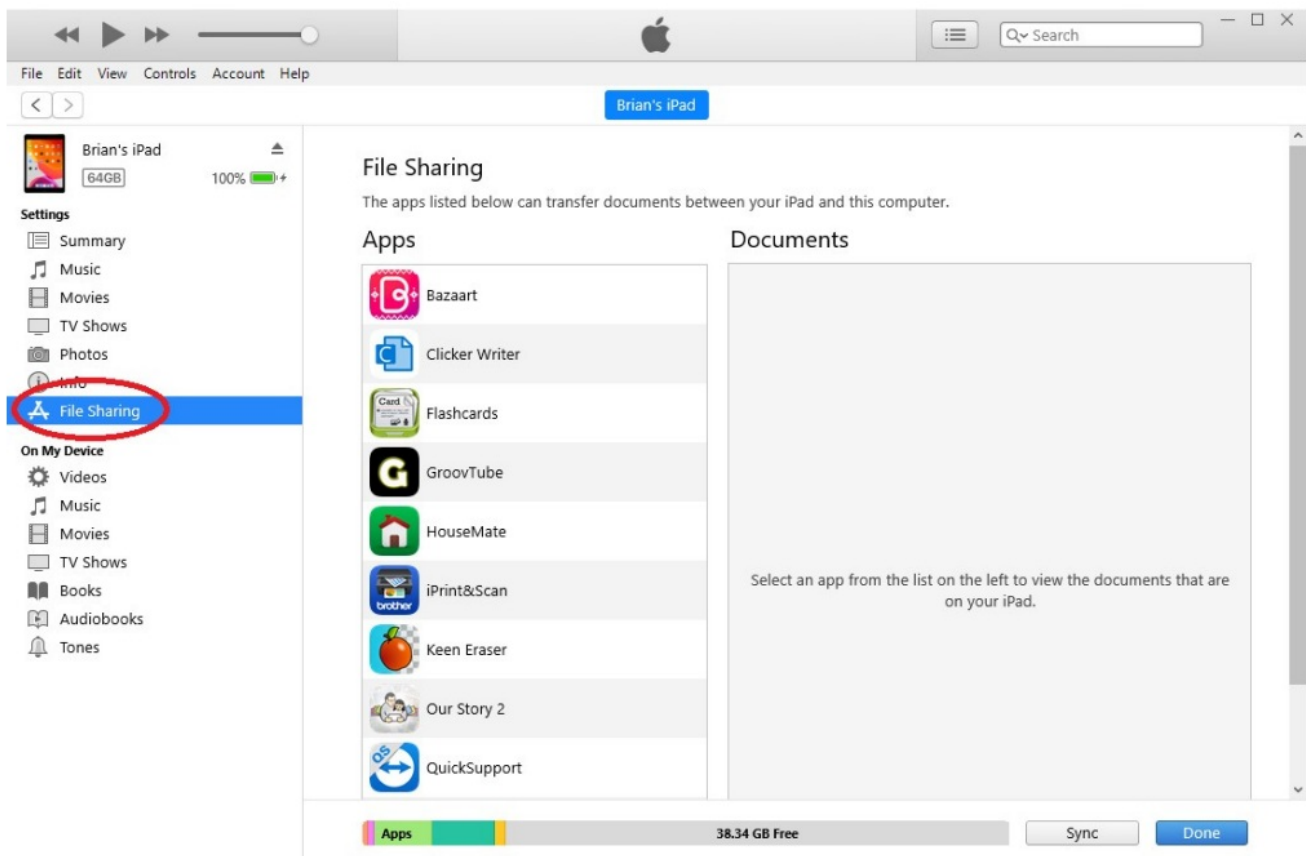
Step 2: Connect your iOS device to the PC. Choose “Trust” from the popup dialog on your iOS device.



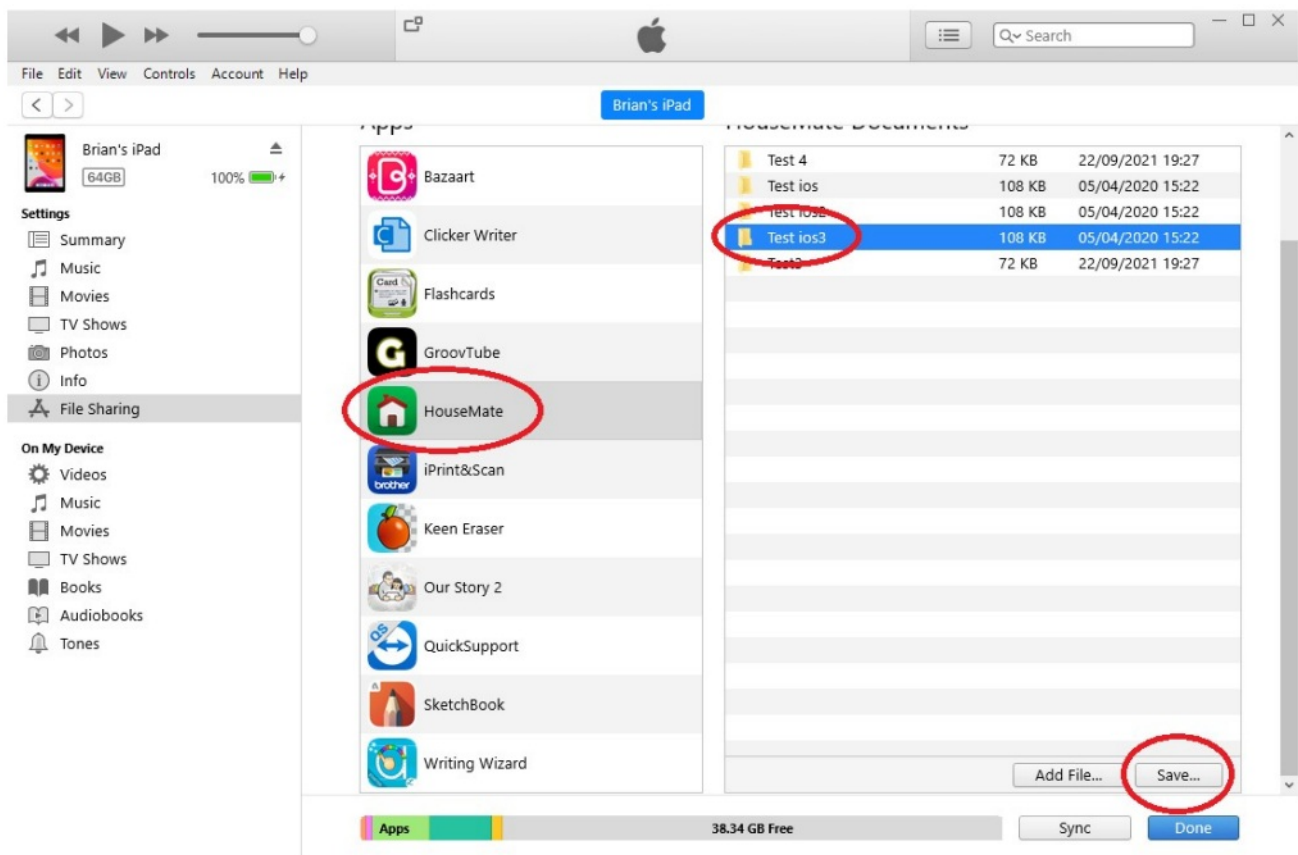
Step 3: Launch iTunes and click on the iOS device symbol.



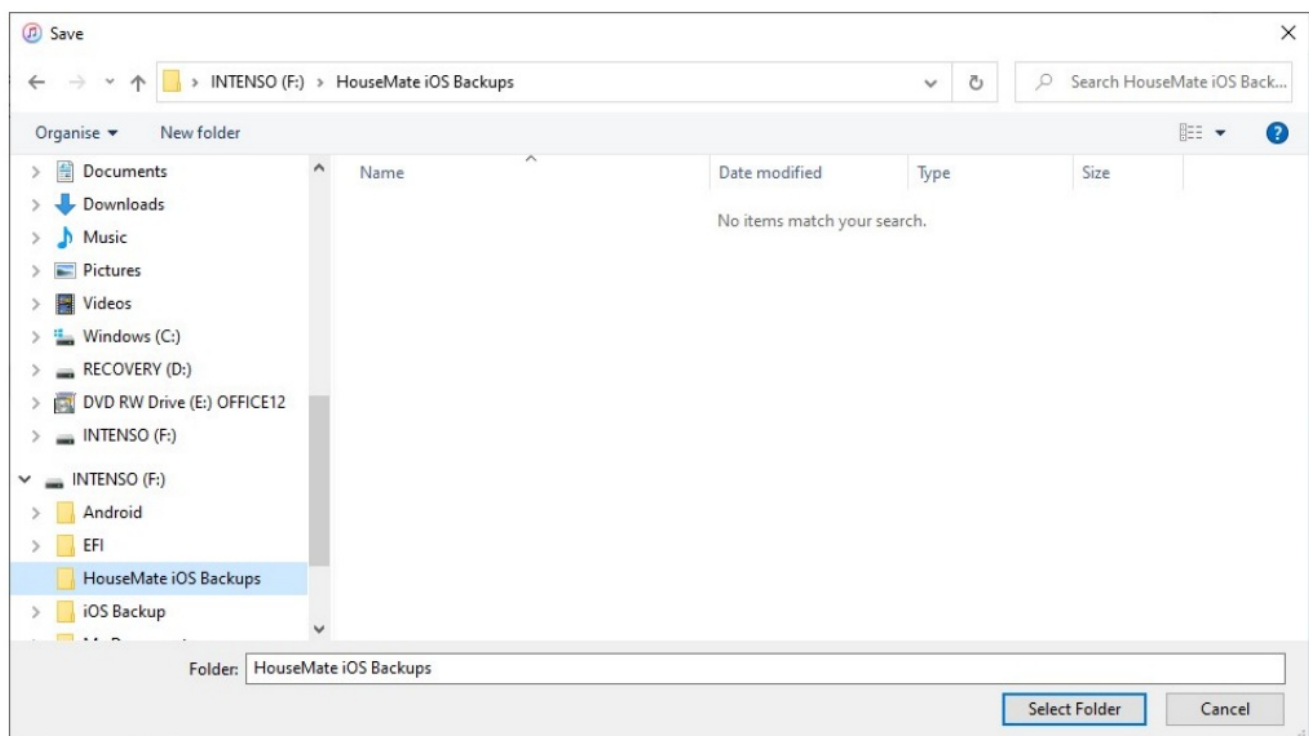
Step 4: Click on File Sharing.



Step 5: Click on HouseMate and then click on the backup you want to save to your PC. Then click Save.



Step 6: Choose a location to save the backup folder:



Backing Up HouseMate Files

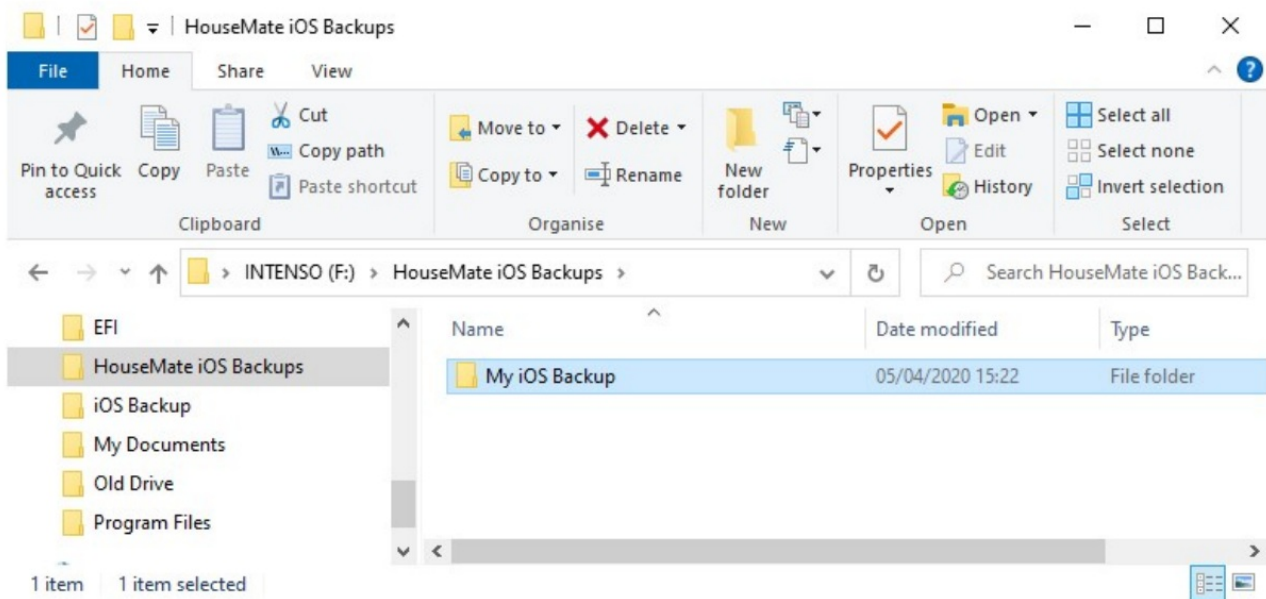
1. Install iTunes on your PC from [here](#).
2. Connect your iOS device to the PC and choose "Trust" on the popup dialog.
3. Launch iTunes and click on the iOS device symbol.

- Click on “File Sharing” and select “HouseMate” to choose the backup you want to save to your PC. Click “Save”.
- Choose a location to save the backup folder on your PC.

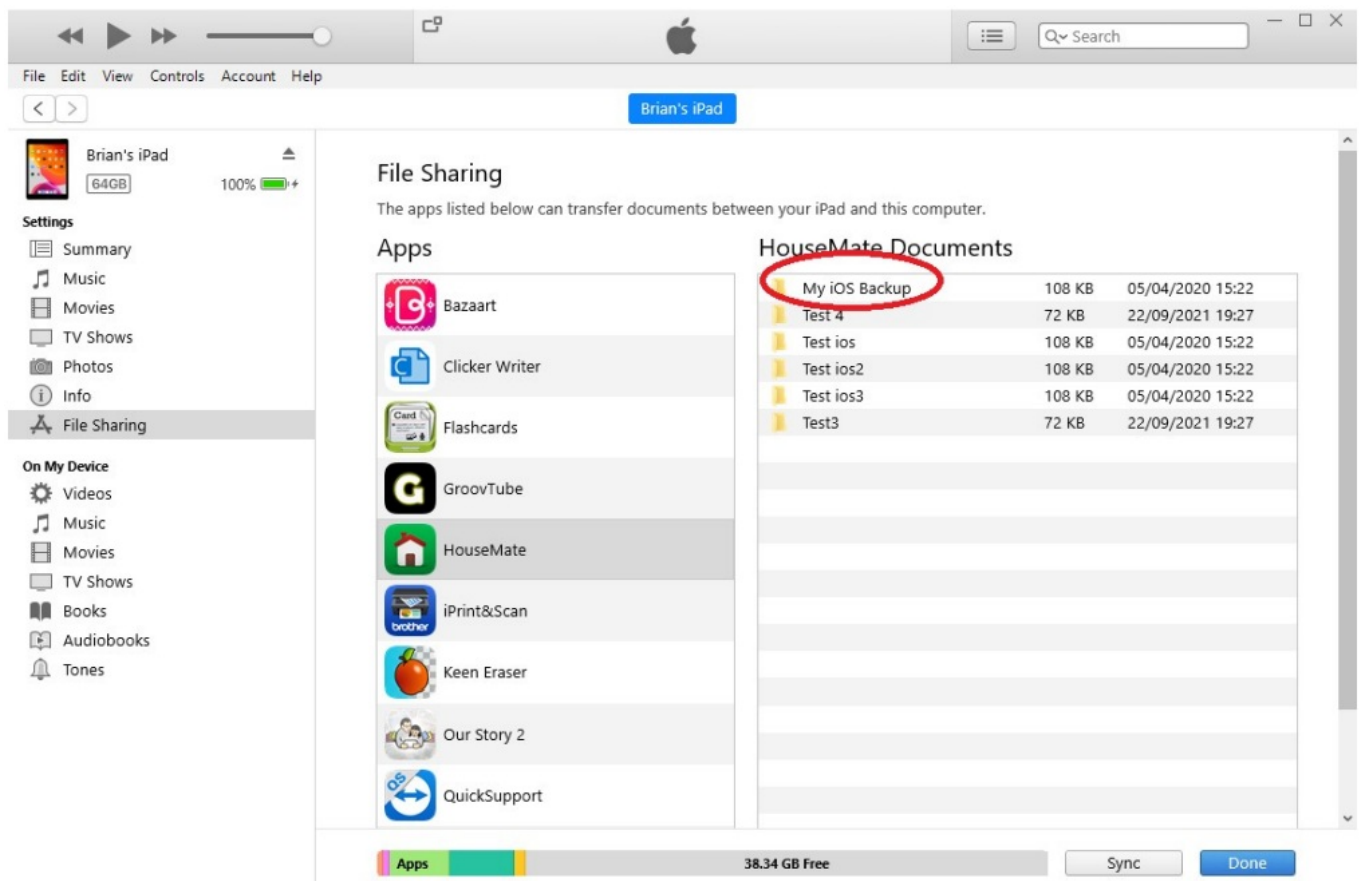
Restoring a Backup

- Launch iTunes and connect your iOS device to the PC.
- Open Files on your PC and locate the backup you want to copy onto your iOS device.

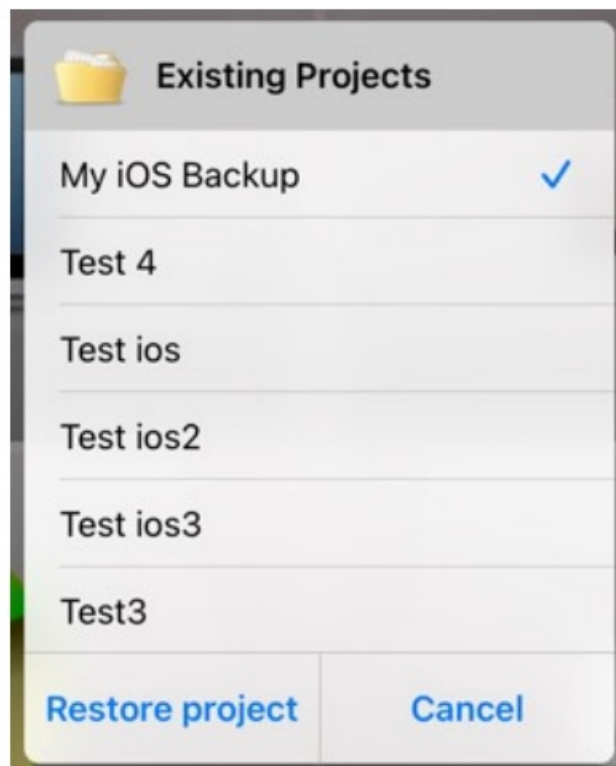
Step 1: Launch iTunes and connect your iOS device. On your PC open Files and locate the backup you want to copy onto your device:



Step 2: Drag the backup folder and drop it into the list of HouseMate documents. It should then appear in the list.



Step 3: Within the HouseMate app on your iOS device launch technician mode and then choose Project- >Open Project and choose the newly transferred project you want to restore.



FAQs


How can I access the HouseMate files on my PC?

To access HouseMate files on your PC, follow the steps mentioned in the manual to make a backup using iTunes.


Can I restore a backup from one iOS device to another?

No, backups made using this procedure are specific to the iOS device they were created from. You cannot restore a backup from one device to another.
