Product Usage Instructions

Bluetooth Connection

• To reduce volume: Short press

• To play the previous song: Long press

• To increase volume: Short press

• To play the next song: Long press

• To power on/off: Long press

• To switch light or mode (TF card required): Click or long press accordingly

• To pair TWS (True Wireless Stereo): Double click on any machine

Low Voltage and Automatic Shutdown:

If the battery level is lower than 10%, the audio system will emit a prompt tone. Charge the device promptly. If the battery level drops below 3%, the machine will automatically shutdown.

TWS Function:

To activate TWS, turn on both machines simultaneously, then double-click on any machine to pair. Wait for the pairing prompt tone and tick sound to indicate successful pairing. Use the host to connect to Bluetooth and double-click the switch key of the auxiliary machine to pair/disconnect TWS.

Bluetooth Connection:

- 1. Long press to turn on speaker until blue LED flashes quickly for pairing mode.
- 2. Search for 'HP BTS02 Bluetooth Speaker' on your Bluetooth device list and connect.
- 3. Once connected, the speaker emits a prompt sound and the blue LED stays on constantly.
- 4. In subsequent uses, automatic connection occurs when Bluetooth on the mobile device is turned on.



Tum off: When not using the audio system, press and hold the" prevent power loss.

Low voltage alarm and automatic shutdown function: When the battery level is lower than 10%, the audio system will emit a prompt tone. At this time, the audio system should be charged in a timely manner. When the battery level is lower than 3%, the machine will automatically shutdown.

TWS function: when carrying out the TWS function, prepare two whole machines, turn on both machines at the same time, after turning on the machine, double-click any machine (double-click is the host), the sound of "tick" and "tick" appears when double-clicking, and wait for about 1 minute after the prompt tone appears. The sound of "tick" will appear when the pairing is completed, and the machine has been paired successfully, and then you can choose a song to play on the Bluetooth device. When the host is connected to Bluetooth, double-click the switch key of the auxiliary machine to pair/disconnect the TWS. 2. No Bluetooth connection status Double-click any machine for TWS pairing/disconnection.

Bluetooth audio connection



- 1. After pressing and turning on the speaker fora long time, the blue LED will flash quickly, and the pairing mode will be entered.
- 2. Tum on the Bluetooth device to search for Bluetooth devices. Find "HP bts02 Bluetooth Speaker " in the Bluetooth device list. After successful connection, the speaker emits a prompt sound and the blue LED turns on constantly.
- 3. In subsequent use, as long as the Bluetooth on the mobile device is turned on, it can be automatically connected.

 - A: The audio system will emit a prompt tone when the battery level is below 10%. Charge the device immediately. Automatic shutdown occurs when the battery level is below 3%.
- Q: How do I activate TWS function on the Bluetooth speaker?
 - A: Turn on both machines simultaneously, then double-click on any machine to pair for TWS. Follow the pairing prompts for successful connection.
