HOW TO SYNC THE PROCUBE CONTROLLER TO THE Wii U™

- 2. Press the sync button on the console once more, and the Wii U™ will display the type of controllers you can
- 3. Press the sync button on the Pro Cube controller then follow the on-screen instructions.
- 4. When your Pro Cube controller is finished pairing, one LED on your controller will light up, showing your player number.
