### Product Usage Instructions

#### Connecting the Controller

To connect the wireless controller to the PS4 host, follow these steps:

1. Ensure that the host is turned on and in pairing mode.
2. Press and hold the PS button on the controller to turn it on.
3. Once the controller is turned on, press the PS button again to initiate the pairing process.
4. The controller will automatically search for available hosts and establish a connection.

#### Charging the Controller

To charge the controller, follow these steps:

1. Connect the charging box of the controller to the host using the USB cable provided.
2. The host can also be awakened through Bluetooth.
3. Ensure that the host is turned on and connected to a power source.
4. Place the controller into the charging box, ensuring proper alignment.
5. The controller will start charging automatically.
6. Wait for the controller to fully charge before use.

### Controller Buttons and Functions

The wireless controller features various buttons and functions:

- Share, Option, L1, L2, L3, R1, R2, and R3 buttons are command keys in the game.
- The RGB light on the handle serves as the channel indicator, with different colors assigned to different users on the host.

### FAQ (Frequently Asked Questions)

#### Q: Can I connect the controller to other devices besides the PS4 host?

A: No, this Bluetooth controller is specifically designed for use with PS4 hosts and may not be compatible with other devices.

#### Q: How far can the wireless controller be used from the PS4 host?

A: The wireless controller has an online distance of over 10MM, providing a reliable connection within a reasonable range from the host.

**Q: Can I use the controller while it is charging?**

A: Yes, you can use the controller while it is charging. However, it is recommended to fully charge the controller before extended gaming sessions.

**Q: How do I know when the controller is fully charged?**

A: The controller's charging indicator light will turn off once it is fully charged. You can also check the battery level on the PS4 host's interface

This is a Bluetooth controller applied to PS4 hosts. The Bluetooth controller has an online distance of over 10MM, is equipped with a 6-axis functional sensor, capacitive touch function, and built-in speaker, and can be connected to 3.5MM headphones and microphones. The charging box of the controller can be connected to the host through a USB cable, and the host can also be awakened through Bluetooth. After long pressing the PS button on the controller to turn it on, a short press to connect to the host. The Share, Option, L1, L2, L3, R1, R2, R3, and other buttons are command keys in the game. The RGB light on the handle is the channel indicator light, which is distinguished by different colors for different users on the host.
