IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

For indoor use only.

Regularly check the cord, the transformer, and all other parts for damage. If any part is damaged the product should not be used. Important information! Keep these instructions for future use.

CAUTION!

The light source of this product is non-changeable light diodes (LED).

Do not disassemble the product, as the light diodes can cause damage to the eyes.

Do not immerse in water.

Cleaning

Use a damp cloth, never a strong cleaning agent.

CAUTION!

Strangulation hazard.

Hang out of reach of young children.

CAUTION

This is an electric product – not a toy!

To avoid the risk of fire, burns, personal injury, and electric shock it should not be played with or placed where small children can reach it. Do not use this product for other than its intended use.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

When storing the product, carefully remove the product from wherever it is placed, including trees, branches, or bushes, to avoid any undue strain or stress on the product conductors, connections, and wires. When not in use, store neatly in a cool, dry location protected from sunlight.


cause harmful interference to radio or television reception, which can be determined by turning the equipment off and on, the user is encouraged to try to correct the interference by one or more of the following measures:
