

Product Usage Instructions


Connecting the Charging Dock:

- 2. Attach a wireless receiver to the bottom of the Imation Charging Dock.
- 3. Plug the magnetic unit into your MX series mouse charging port (Type-C).
- 4. Place your MX series mouse on the Imation Charging Dock. The dock will start charging your mouse automatically.

Precautions:


- Do not strike, bend, drop, wet, or apply excessive force to the Imation Charging Dock IMMC to avoid data loss or damage.






