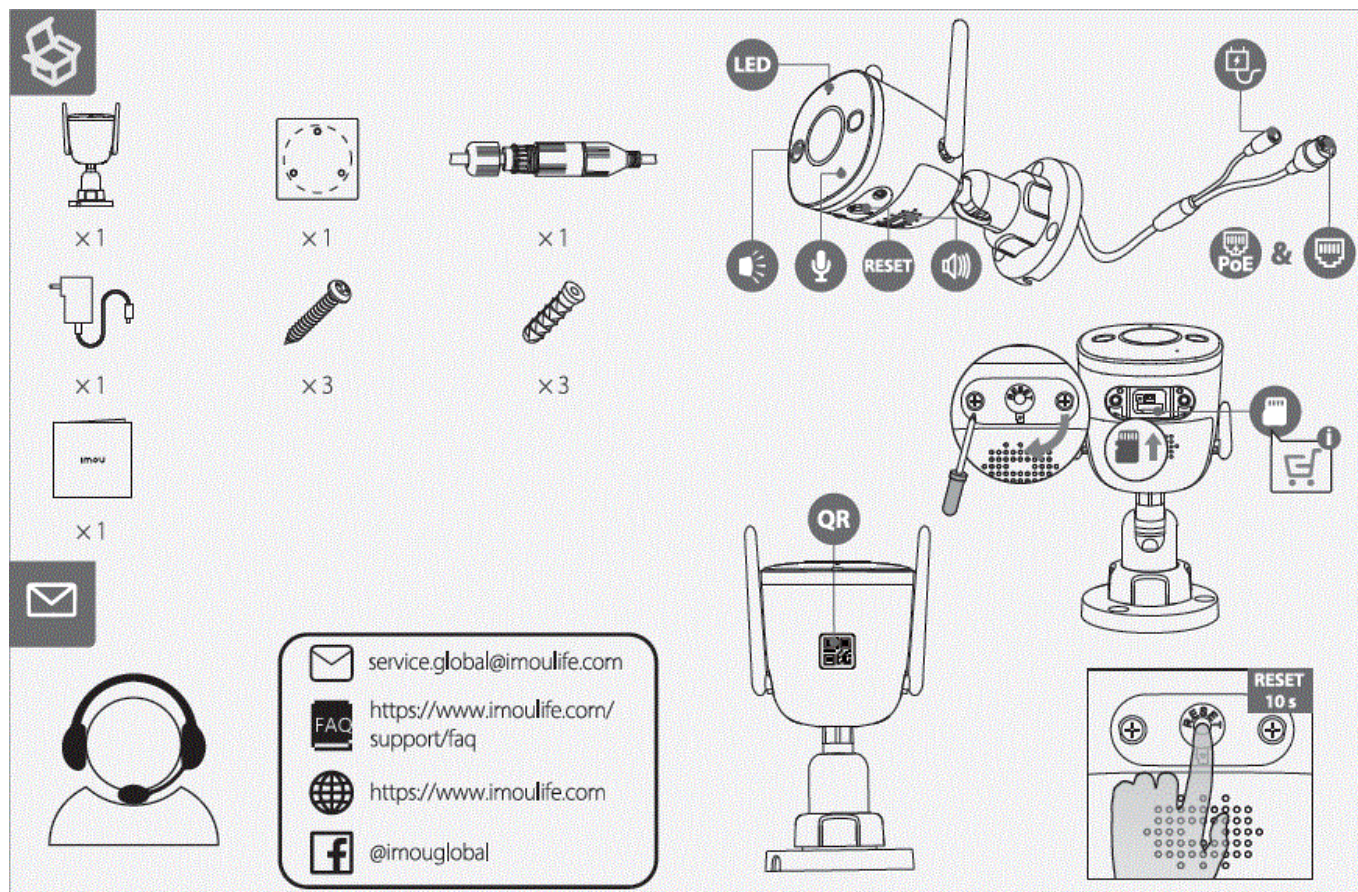

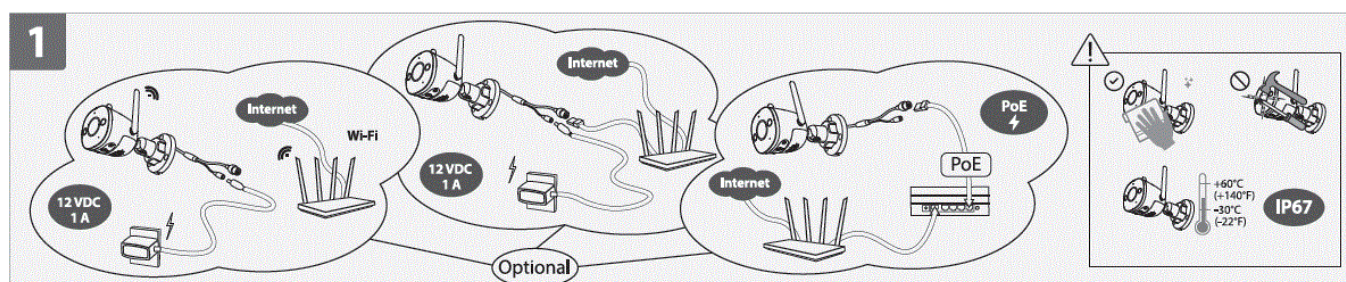

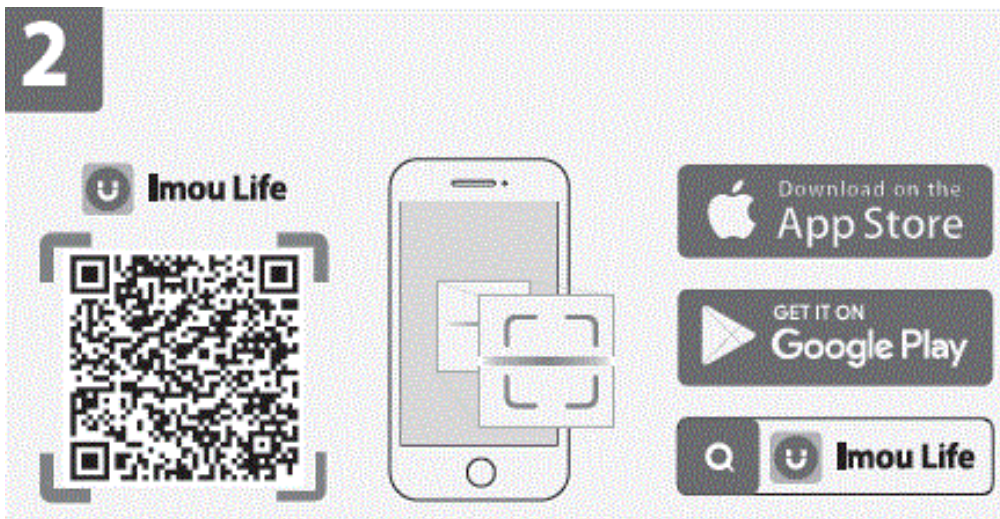

Power On the Camera



- Connect the camera to power. You can choose a wireless or wired network connection. Since the camera is PoE-featured, you can also connect it to a POE device such as a POE switch with an Ethernet cable to transmit both power and data (see part 1).

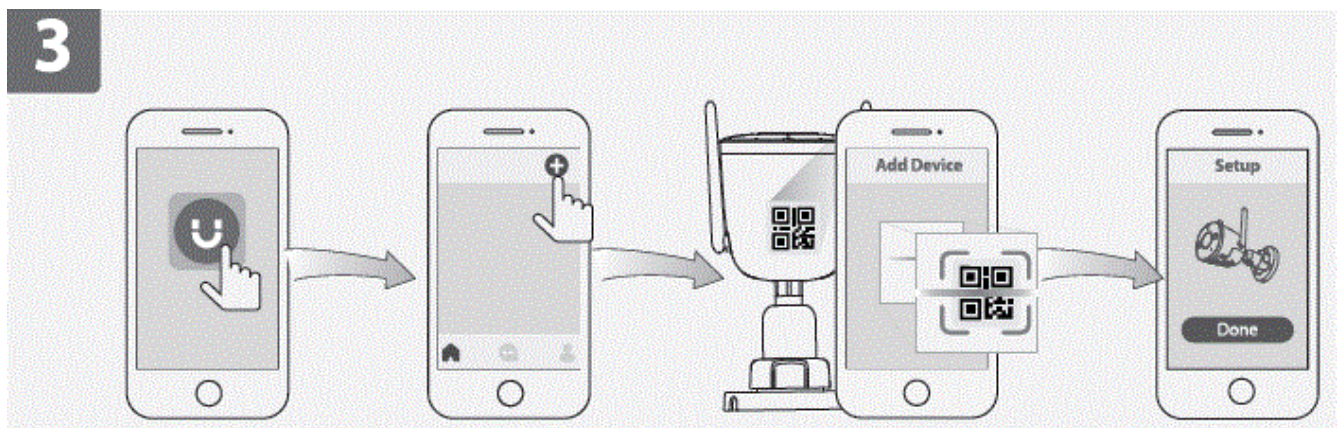
Get the Imou Life App

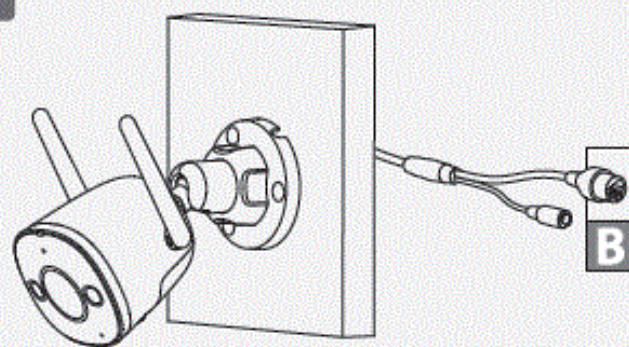

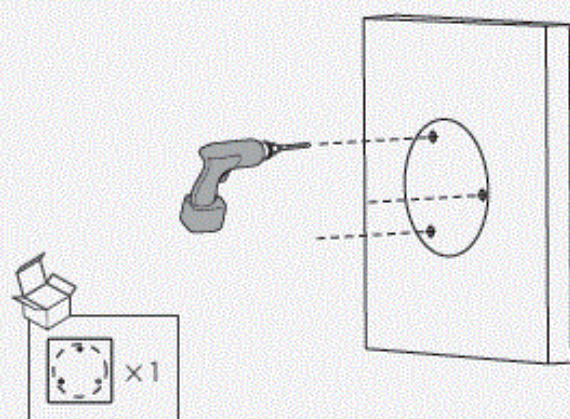
Scan the QR code on the body of the device or on the cover of this guide with the app, and then follow on-screen instructions to complete the setup (see part 3).

- Make sure the mounting surface is strong enough to hold three times the weight of the camera. For a detailed installation process, please see part 4.

		Device malfunction
Green & Red	Alternating	Updating firmware

		LED turned off

If you need to reset the camera, press and hold the reset button for 10 s. The LED turns solid red when the camera is booting.
