Product Usage Instructions

Initial Safety Instructions

- · Read all instructions before use to ensure safety.
- Do not use this product in a window.
- This appliance has a polarized plug. If the plug does not fit fully into the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician. Do not modify the plug in any way.
- This product has overload protection (fuse). If the fuse blows, unplug the product and follow the fuse replacement steps provided. If the replacement fuse blows, contact an authorized service facility for examination and/or repair.
- This appliance is for household use only. Do not use outdoors.

READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USE TO ENSURE SAFETY, AS THEY MAY NOT ALL BE OBVIOUS.

- Any use of this product or its accessories in any manner not recommended by the manufacturer may cause injury to persons or damage to the appliance.
- This product has no user-serviceable parts except for the fuse. Other than the instructions provided in this
 manual, do not attempt to examine or repair this product yourself. Only qualified service personnel should
 perform any servicing.
- Do not allow a child to use this appliance. Keep the appliance out of children's reach at all times. Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with this appliance.
- Keep any parts or packaging materials well away from children. These are a potential source of suffocation or other danger.
- Always operate the appliance on a dry, flat, stable surface.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons with reduced physical, sensory, or mental capabilities that may lead to improper use or injury from operating the appliance.
- Discontinue any operation of the appliance if any of its parts malfunction or are damaged in any manner. Take the appliance to the nearest authorized service facility for examination, repair, or adjustment.
- Do not use the appliance if it has been submerged or placed under running water.
- Do not leave the product unattended while in use. Unplug the product from the electrical outlet when not in use.

 Do not operate the fan if the motor, housing, cable or any other parts appear to be damaged.
- Do not operate the fan in the presence of explosive or flammable fumes.
- Do not place the fan or any parts near an open flame, cooking, or other heating appliance.
- Avoid contact with moving fan parts.

Getting Started and Assembly

- 1. Carefully remove the fan from the carton and pass the cord through the base.
- 2. Assemble the two base halves together by positioning the base half with the alignment pin over the other base half with the alignment sockets. Press the two halves together until flush.
- 3. Assemble the base to the tower bottom by aligning the 4 base sockets onto the tower bottom pins. Tighten the thumb screws securely.


Thank you for purchasing this quality fan from IMPECCA! To assemble your new fan:

1. Carefully remove the fan from the carton. Pass the cord through the base. Assemble the two base halves together. Position the base half with the alignment pin, over the other base half with the alignment sockets. Press the two halves together until flush.





2. Assemble the base to the tower bottom. With the tower on its side, align the 4 base sockets onto the tower bottom pins. Tighten the thumb screws securely.



How to Operate

- 1. This fan can be operated using the Manual Controls located on top of the unit or by the Remote Control.
- 2. Place the fan on a firm and level surface.
- 3. Plug the cord set into the outlet.

\bigcirc	On/Off: To turn fan on, press the Power button.
\mathcal{O}	Oscillation: To activate press the Oscillation button once. Press again to turn off.
S	Sound Level/Speed Control: Press the Fan button repeatedly to change level.
()	Auto-off Timer: This setting will automatically turn your fan off from 1 to 8 hrs. 1 hour: Press one time 2 hours: Press two times 3 hours: Press three times 4 hours: Press four times 5 hours: Press five times 6 hours: Press six times 7 hours: Press seven times 8 hours: Press eight times Turn Timer off: Press nine times or press power button

Remote Control

- 1. Install batteries (AAA size, not supplied) as shown.
- 2. All functions performed with the Remote Control work identically to the Manual Controls.
- 3. Do not mix old and new batteries. Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc), or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.
- 4. Do not dispose of batteries in fire. Batteries may explode or leak.



Cleaning

Clean the fan regularly according to the instructions provided in the user manual.

- Be sure your fan is in the OFF position.
- Unplug the fan before cleaning.
- To clean inlet and outlet ribs, use a common household vacuum.
- Do not use water to clean these parts of the Fan.
- · Do not disassemble for cleaning.

- Do not immerse the fan in water and never allow water to enter the Motor Housing.
- Do not use gasoline, paint thinner or other chemicals to clean the fan.

Storage Instructions

For storage, you may leave the fan assembled and covered to protect it from dust. Store the fan in a cool, dry place.

Troubleshooting Tips

If your fan fails to operate:

- Make sure the power cord is plugged into a working electrical outlet.
- If the problem persists, return the fan to the place of the original purchase or refer to the warranty for further
 assistance. Do not attempt to open the motor housing yourself as it may void the warranty and cause damage
 or personal injury.

If your Fan fails to operate: Be sure the power cord is plugged into a working electrical outlet. If you have a problem that cannot be resolved by the step listed above, please return the fan to the place of the original purchase or see your warranty. Do not attempt to open the motor housing yourself; doing so may void your warranty and cause damage to the fan or personal injury.

OTHER ELECTRICAL SAFETY

WARNING: To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock or personal injury:

- Do not use this fan with any solid-state speed control device.
- Unplug fan before cleaning or servicing.
- To reduce the risk of electric shock and injury to persons, do not use this product in a window.
- This appliance has a polarized plug, meaning that one blade on the plug is wider than the other. To reduce the
 risk of electric shock, this plug is intended to fit into a polarized outlet only one way. If the plug does not fit fully
 into the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician. Do not attempt to modify the
 plug in any way.

This product employs overload protection (fuse). A blown fuse indicates an overload or short-circuit situation. If the fuse blows, unplug the product from the outlet and follow the fuse replacement steps later in this guide. If the replacement fuse blows, a short-circuit may be present and the product should be discarded or returned to an authorized service facility for examination and/or repair.

- Completely assemble the product for use before plugging it into an outlet.
- Make sure the power cord does not touch any hot surfaces.
- Extension cords are not recommended for use with this appliance.
- Do not plug or unplug the product into/from the electrical outlet with wet hands.
- Discontinue any operation of the appliance if the cord or plug are damaged.
- To disconnect the fan from an electrical outlet, ensure the product is turned off and then pull directly on the plug; do not pull on the Power Cord.
- Do not put any stress on the power cord where it connects to the product, as this is likely to cause a malfunction or safety hazard.
- Always ensure the product is un-plugged from the electrical outlet and that all parts have stopped before assembling, disassembling, re-locating, or cleaning it.

 Do not route the cord underneath any carpeting. Do not cover the cord with throw rugs, runners, or similar coverings. Do not route the cord under furniture or other appliances. Arrange the cord so it is away from areas where it could be tripped over.

PARTS – if the product is determined to have a manufacturing defect, within a period of six (6) months from the date of the original purchase, Impecca® will repair or replace the product parts at no charge (for parts) to consumers in the U.S.A. and Canada.

LABOR – if the product is determined to have a manufacturing defect, within a period of thirty (30) Days from the date of the original purchase, Impecca® will repair or replace the product at no charge to consumers in the U.S.A. and Canada.
