




Remote Control Activation

- Connection Range: 2m



Note: Only one remote control can be connected to the device at a time.


Battery Installation




3.0V lithium battery coin cells

Use 3M dual lock to stick the remote control.



2. Use the elastic straps to secure the remote in place.
