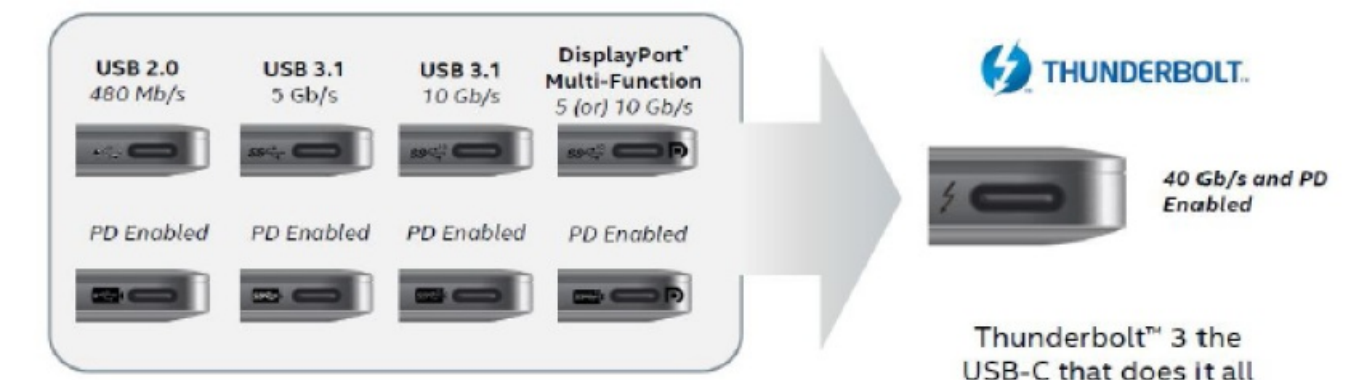

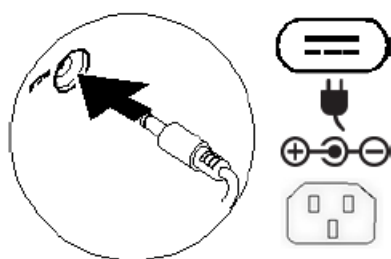


Power Adapter

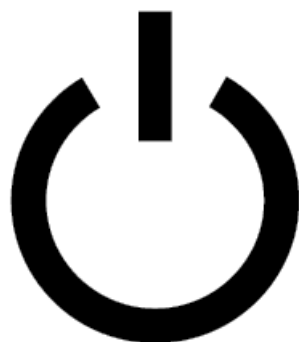
1. **Input voltage** 100-240V
2. **Input current (maximum)** 1.7 A / 1.7 A / 1.5 A
3. **Input frequency** 50-60 Hz
4. **Output current** 3 A / 3.25 A / 4.5 A
5. **Output voltage** 20 V

- Connect the power adapter or the power cable to your computer and to the display, if required.

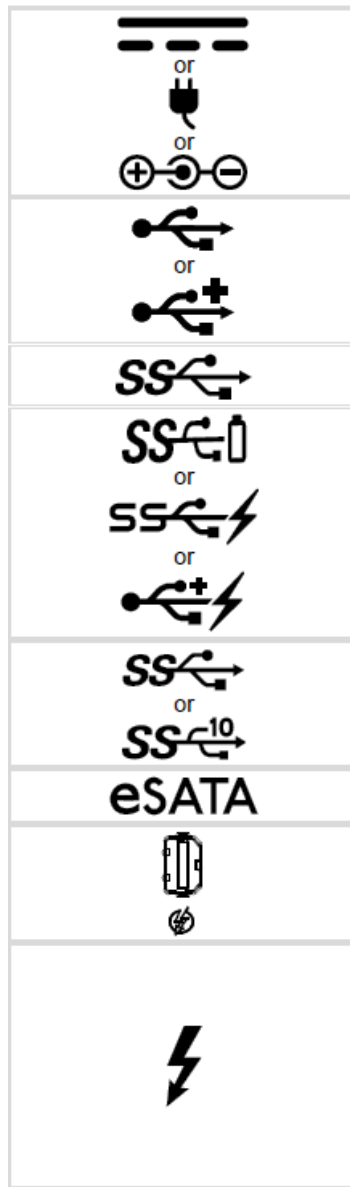


- Power on the computer (and the display, if connected).

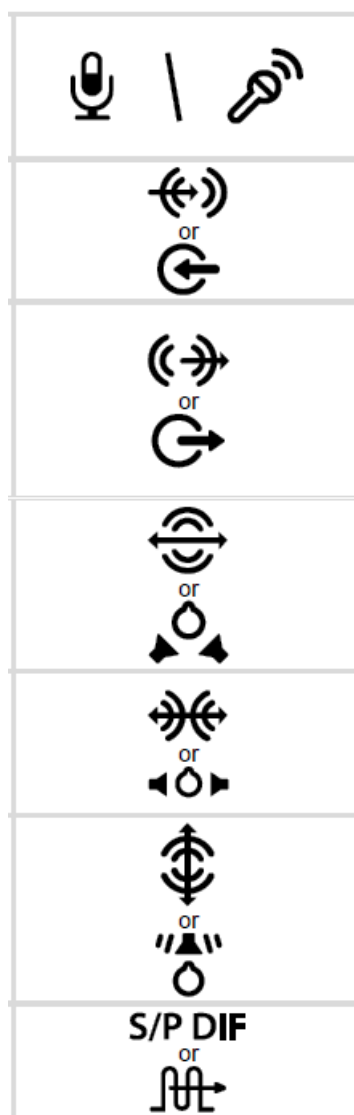






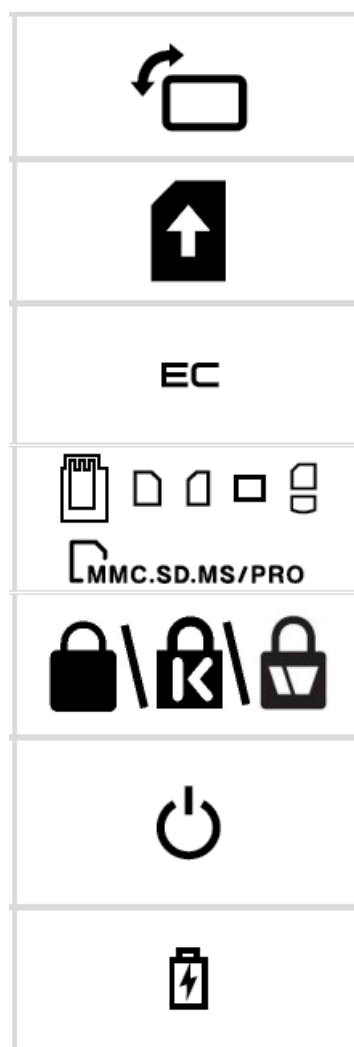
