Product Usage Instructions

- Follow the installation instructions provided in the user manual to set up the product correctly.
- Use the designated power button to turn the fan on or off as needed.
- Use the speed control settings to adjust the fan flow rate based on your preference.
- Regularly clean the fan blades and ensure proper ventilation to maintain optimal performance.

CAUTION

For safe operation, please read and follow the instructions below carefully.

WARNING

- 1. If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer or its service agent, or a similarly qualified person in order to avoid a hazard.
- 2. Domestic use only.
- 3. To avoid the risk of electrical shock, do not immerse the unit, cord, or plug in water or any other liquids.

- 4. This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory, or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
 Minors should be supervised at all times to avoid the mistreatment of the unit and/or possible injury.
- 5. When the appliance is not operating, and, prior to cleaning, please unplug it from the power socket.
- 6. When assembling the fan, make sure that the protective fan grill covers are properly installed.
- 7. Do not dispose of this product as unsorted municipal waste. This appliance requires special treatment for disposal. It is prohibited to dispose of this appliance in domestic household waste. To prevent possible harm to the environment or human health from uncontrolled waste disposal, recycle it responsibly to promote the sustainable reuse of material resources.


To return your used device, contact the retailer; it is possible they may dispose of it at a recycling facility.

RULES FOR SAFE OPERATION

- 1. While the fan is operating, no sharp objects, such as pencils, should be inserted through the protective grill. Be extra cautious when handling and be certain no fingers penetrate beyond the protective grill area; this should be strictly avoided at all times.
- 2. Be certain that the fan is disconnected when repositioning from one location to another.
- 3. Be certain that the fan is on sturdy grounds while operating, to avoid accidental tipping.
- 4. Be extra cautious when operating near a window, as rain may cause an electric shock.
- 5. This device is intended for domestic use only.


Useful Tip

• Prior to installation, remove the fan leaf lock nut and the mesh hood lock nut from the fuselage.

Installation

• Install by rotating (screwing) the pole to the base.

Front and back protective Fan Grill Installation



Casing Screw Nut Screw the cover nut counterclockwise and then install the fan's front

protective grill.

Locknut of **Protective Grill**

Screw the locknut clockwise, and then install the front cover of the fan.




Remote control functions



Useful Tip

• The remote control operates best when it is within a range of 5 meters from the fan, and with an angle of no more than 30°.

Instructions for main unit



Air Speed Button

 Press for a short period of time to adjust the air speed, prolonged period (two seconds to set the timer.

MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTION

This fan requires limited maintenance. Do not attempt to fix it on your own. Always refer to qualified personnel if any service is required.

- 1. Prior to cleaning and assembling, the fan must be unplugged.
- 2. To ensure adequate air circulation, vents should be free of dust at all times. Do not disassemble the fan in order to remove the dust.
- 3. The exterior parts of the device may be wiped with a soft and damp, with a mild detergent, cloth.
- 4. The use of any abrasive detergents or solvents should be avoided, as this may result in scratching the surface. The use of gasoline or paint thinner for cleaning purposes

- should be avoided.
- 5. Water or any other liquids in the motor housing or interior parts of the device must be avoided at all times.

CLEANING

- 1. Prior to performing any cleaning, the device must be unplugged.
- 2. All plastic parts of the device should be cleaned with a soft, moist cloth and with mild soap.

Thoroughly clean any soap excess with a dry cloth.

A: To clean the fan blades, first, ensure the fan is unplugged.
 Use a soft, damp cloth to gently wipe down the blades, avoiding any harsh chemicals.

Q: Can I use this product in a humid environment?

 A: It is recommended to avoid using the product in high-humidity areas to prevent damage to the internal components.
