Jabra Mini Outdoor Edition

What is the Advanced Audio Distribution Profile (A2DP)?

Advanced Audio Distribution Profile (A2DP) is a Bluetooth profile that enables multimedia audio communication, such as music, between a Jabra headset and a supported Bluetooth device. A2DP is used in selected Jabra headsets.

Note: A2DP is not supported by all Bluetooth devices. Check the user manual of your Bluetooth device.

Product Information

The Jabra Mini Outdoor Edition is a Bluetooth headset that supports the Advanced Audio Distribution Profile (A2DP). A2DP allows for high-quality multimedia audio communication, such as music playback, between the headset and a compatible Bluetooth device. Please note that not all Bluetooth devices support A2DP. Refer to the user manual of your Bluetooth device to check for compatibility.

Product Usage Instructions

Pairing the Headset

- Ensure that the headset is charged and turned on.
- Put your Bluetooth device into pairing mode (refer to the device's user manual).
- On the headset, press and hold the pairing button until the LED indicator starts flashing blue.
- Follow the Bluetooth device's instructions to complete the pairing process.
- Once paired, the LED indicator on the headset will turn solid blue.

Connecting to a Bluetooth Device

- Turn on both the headset and the Bluetooth device.
- Ensure that Bluetooth is enabled on the device.
- On the Bluetooth device, search for available devices and select "Jabra Mini Outdoor Edition" from the list.
- If prompted, enter the PIN code "0000" to complete the connection.
- Once connected, you can start using the headset for audio communication or music playback.

Adjusting Volume

To adjust the volume on the headset, use the volume buttons located on the side of the device. Press the "+" button to increase the volume and the "-" button to decrease the volume.

Answering/Ending Calls

To answer an incoming call, press the multifunction button once. To end a call, press the multifunction button again.

Charging the Headset

To charge the headset, connect it to a power source using the provided USB cable. The LED indicator will turn solid red during charging and will turn off once fully charged.
