Installation:

To install the TCXTM Automation Conversion kit, follow these steps:

- 1. Remove the old timeclock from the enclosure.
- 2. Seamlessly fit the TCXTM into the enclosure for a quick and easy upgrade.
- 3. Connect the system to WiFi for wireless control.

Configuration:

To configure the TCXTM for operation, choose the pool pad system you want to swap with from the list of compatible systems provided in the manual.

Wireless Lighting Operation:

If you wish to add wireless lighting operation, ensure your installation location has a neutral wire at the existing light switch. Install the wireless light switch in your home for automated control.
