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#### **How to Charge Jarvisen Translator 2**

Jarvisen Translator 2 comes with a Type-C charging port. The total charging time is 1.5 hours using a standard DC 5V / 2A power supply

## Standby Time of Jarvisen Translator 2

Under the full power state, there is no network black screen standby for ten days, and it provides continuous translation for 6 hours. \*The iFLYTEK laboratory provides the data. As for actual use, it will be slightly different according to the use environment, the degree of battery loss, etc

Then, slide up from the bottom of the voice translation page to set the language. To set the language, slide upwards from the bottom of the page. (1) Gesture Detection: The device can recognize gesture changes and distance detection near the mouth. The Gesture Detection is beginner-friendly and ready-touse for users. The Gesture Detection is beginnerfriendly and ready-to-use for users. After finishing their side of talking, they can hand it out to others. And the translation display can be enlarged on the screen so that others can see it more clearly. The translation context can be highlighted with matched broadcast sound, guiding the other party to understand the translated information better. After turning on the "Gesture Detection" switch, the main page of the voice translation will guide the user to pick the device up near the mouth and talk through the dynamic effect signal. Then, the voice capture will be activated (accompanied by radio sound tips and light flashing). After speaking, the translation result will be displayed and played. If you want to show the translation result to the other person, the screen will zoom in to present the translated content. The translated context after voice translation will be marked, making it easier for both parties to understand the information. (2) Physical Buttons: Translate by holding down the finger or clicking the button on the screen. Compatible with long and short press operations, users can pick up the ready-touse device without thinking or trying the long and short press buttons. This function not only meets the existing use of the current translator device, "hold on to speak, let go to translate," but also caters to some users' operation habits to press once to capture the speaking voice with an automatic stop ending the conversation. When the user turns off the "Gesture Detection" switch in Settings, the gesture interaction of" pick up to speak and hand out to translate" will cease functioning. In that case, the user must click the button at the bottom of the screen to speak. If the "Physical Buttons" are turned on, the user can speak by pressing the volume "+" "-" keys on the right side of the device and release them to translate." image-6="" headline-7="h2" question-7="How to switch languages when using voice translation?" answer-7="Please swipe up from the bottom of the screen to select the desired language on the voice translation pag" image-7=""

Then click the upper right corner to start the photo translation, or the user can also swipe the home page to the left to activate it. "image-8="" headline-9="h2" question-9="If the voice translation is mis-recognized, is it modifiable?" answer-9="No, it isn't." image-9="" headline-10="h2" question-10="What kind of ways are supported by the Jarvisen Translator 2 to access Internet services?" answer-10="WiFi, mobile phone hotspots, and SIM cards are available. In-machine purchase of traffic card (global Internet access function, free for 2 years from the date of machine activation) no card network is also supported" image-10="" headline-11="h2" question-11="If no WiFi is available after getting out of the hotel abroad, how can the device be connected to the Internet? (How to use the Global Internet Access Function?)" answer-11="1. The user can share the hotspots through phones and connect the device to the Internet. 2. The user can use the global Internet traffic. After buying the buying Jarvisen Translator 2, two years of free global Internet traffic is provided. 3. # How to adjust the screen lock time?

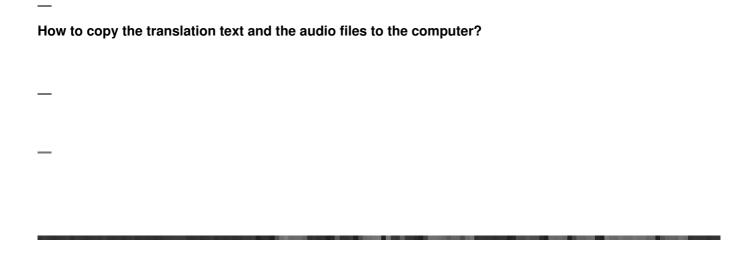
You can adjust your screen lock time by swiping down the notifications and clicking the Settings in the upper right corner - Display - Dormancy period.
