Product Usage Instructions

- 1. Choose the appropriate needle from the NS260 or NB260 set, based on the component being handled.
- 2. If required, select the appropriate suction cup from the CU260 Cups Set.
- 3. Connect the tool to the station suction plug.
- 4. For correct suction, insert the needle into the cup as shown in the picture. Ensure the needle does not protrude from the cup.
- 5. To activate suction, cover the pen hole with your finger and lift off the component.
- 6. To release the component, lift your finger from the pen hole.



Connections




- Choose the needle that best fits the component and the suction cup if needed.
- Connected the tool to the station suction plug.


Working



- For a correct suction process insert the needle in the cup as shown in the picture.
- Make sure the needle does not protrude from the cup.

Suction





- Once the suction is activated, cover the pen hole with your finger (1) and lift off the component.
- Lift your finger (2) from the pen hole to release the component.
