Quick Start Guide

This Quick Start Guide will help you get started with your CAR1013. For detailed instructions, please download the complete owner's manual from <https://www.jensenmobile.com> or contact customer service at 1-888-921-4088 (Monday-Friday, 9AM-5PM EST).

1. Step 1: Power On

Ensure that your CAR1013 is connected to a power source. Press the power button located on the device to turn it on.

2. Step 2: CD Playback

To play a CD, insert the CD into the CD slot. The CAR1013 will automatically start playing the CD. Use the controls on the device to adjust the volume, skip tracks, and pause/play.

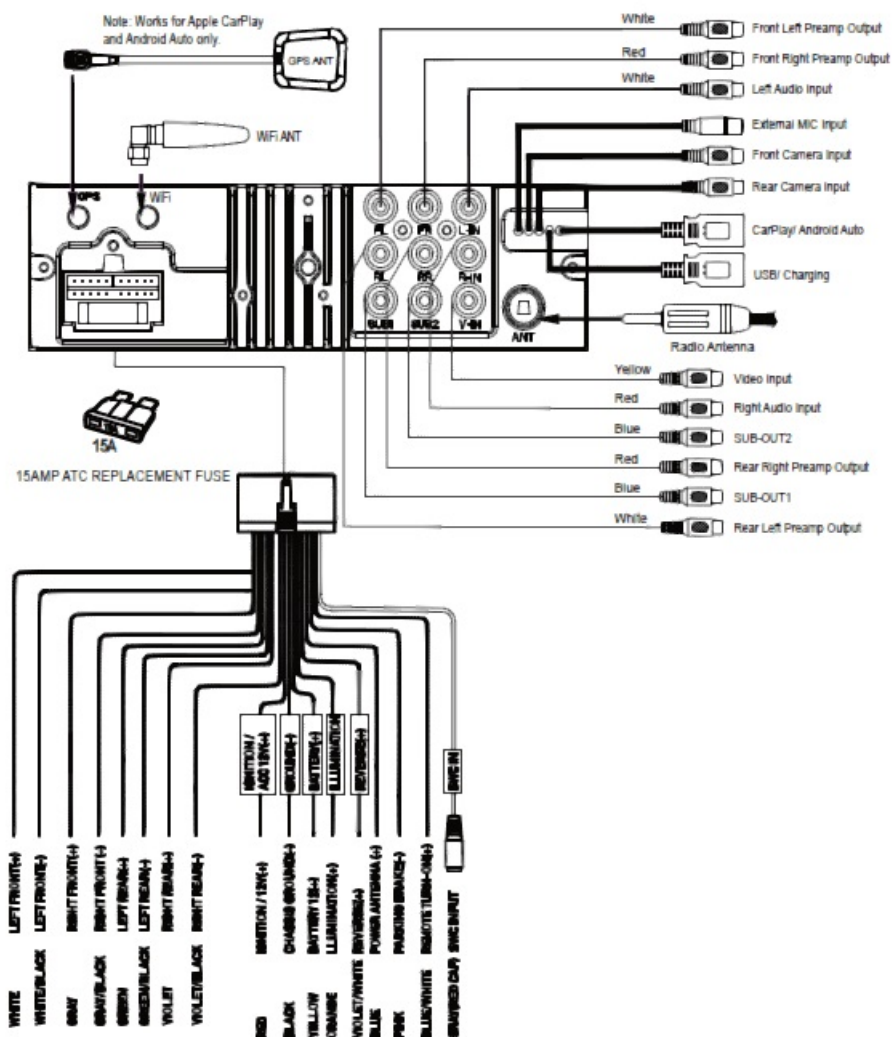
3. Step 3: USB Playback

To play music from a USB device, connect the USB device to the USB port on the CAR1013. The device will detect the USB and start playing the music files. Use the controls on the device to navigate through the files and control playback.

4. Step 4: Radio

To listen to the radio, press the "Radio" button on the device. Use the tuning knob to select your desired radio station. Use the volume control to adjust the volume.

Note: When replacing a fuse, make sure to use the correct type and amperage. Using an incorrect fuse could cause damage. The unit uses (1) 15 amp ATC mini style fuse located on the power connector.

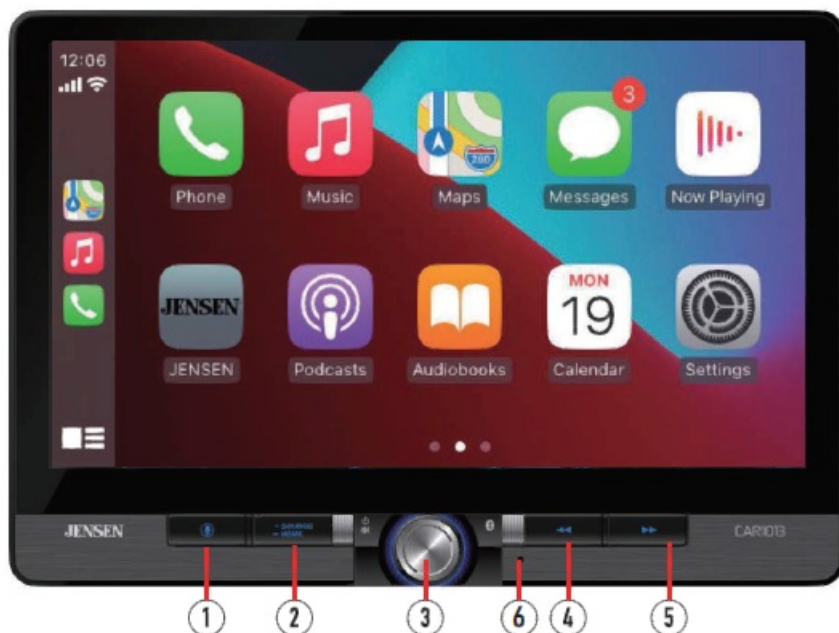

6. RESET

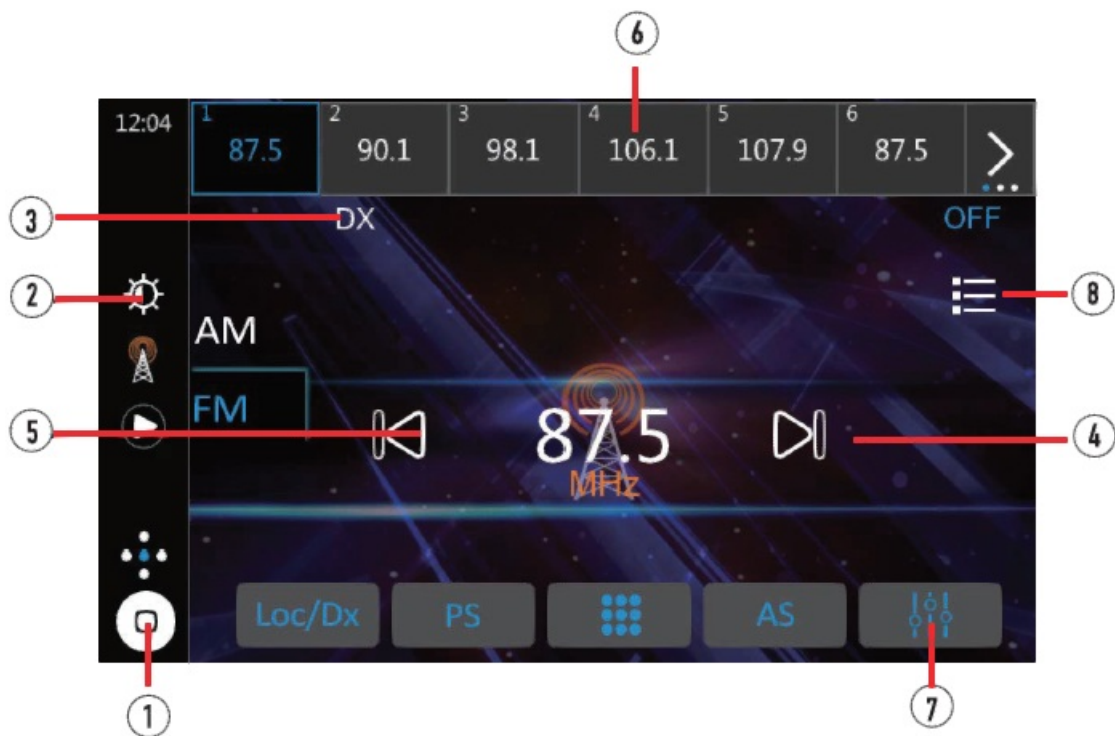


Main Menu

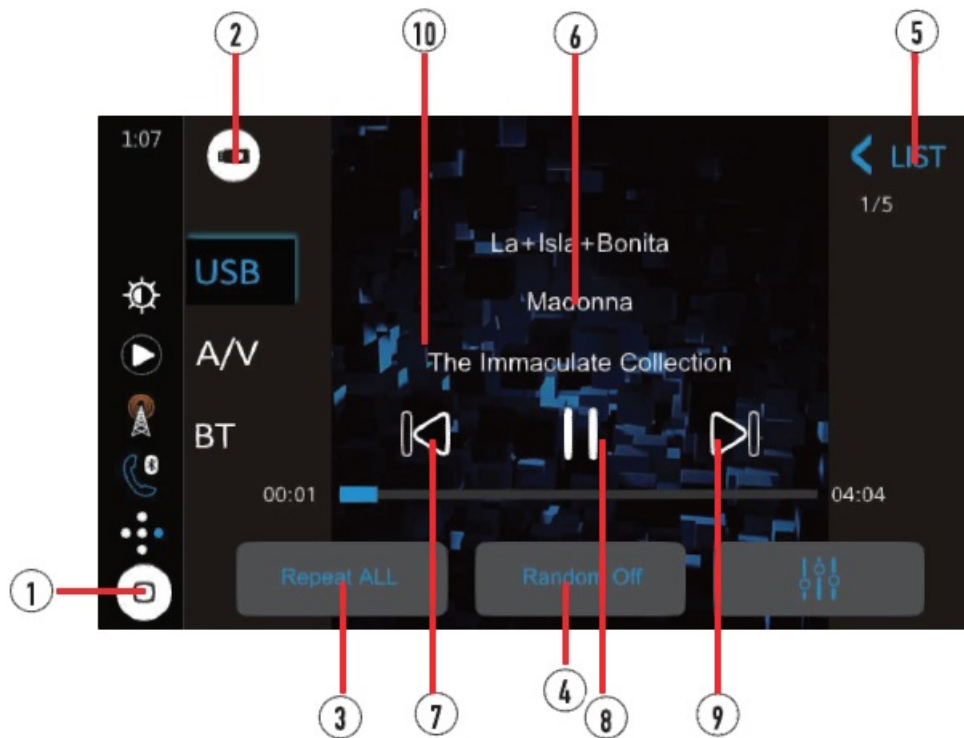

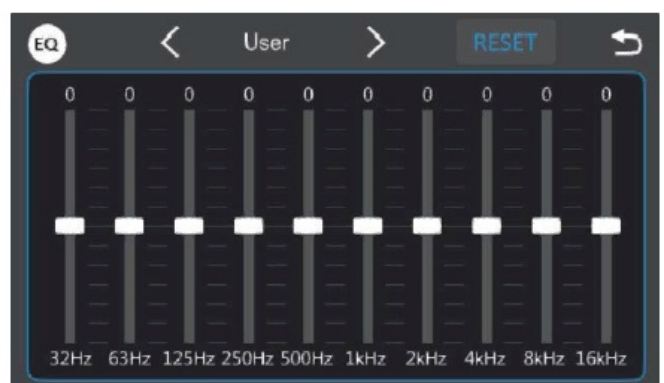

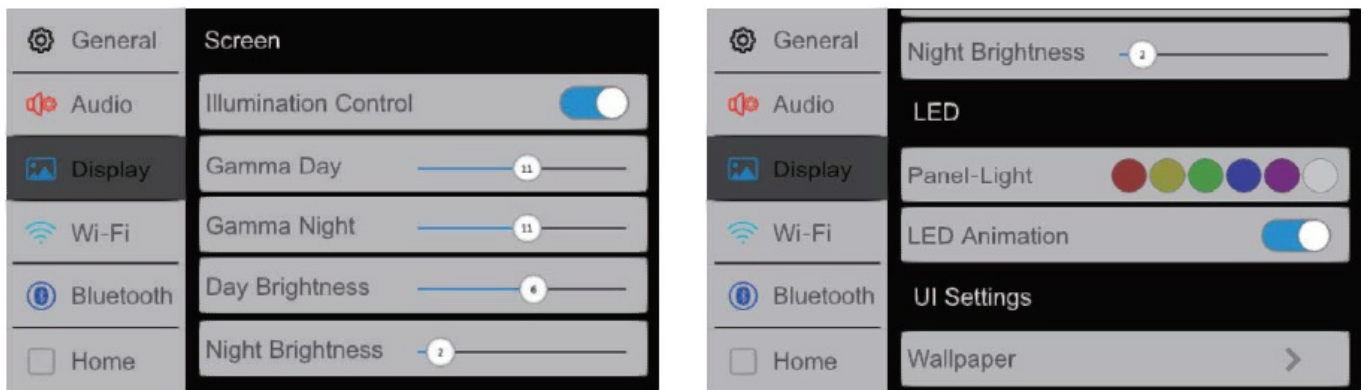
Audio Operation

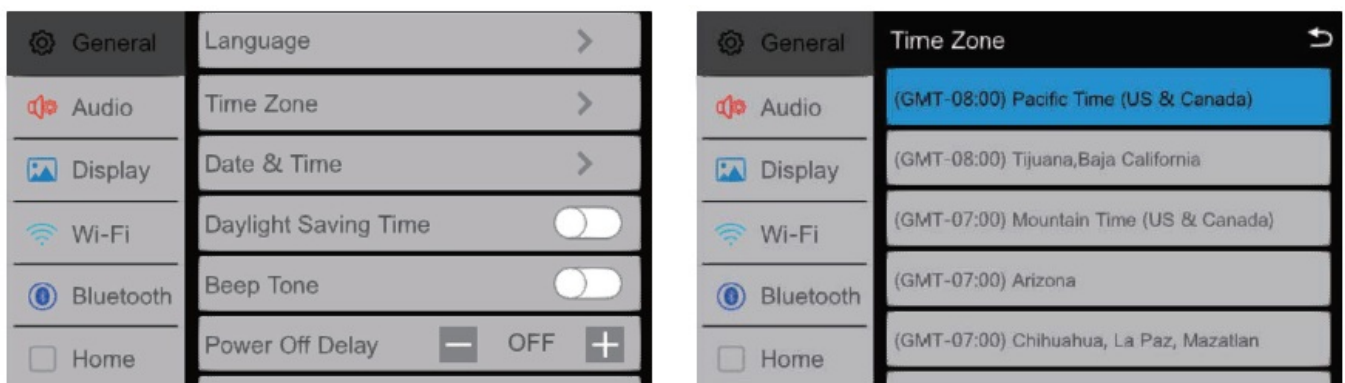
Screen Operation

Press the Function icon in the Settings menu to access the Time Zone, Date and Time and other radio Settings.

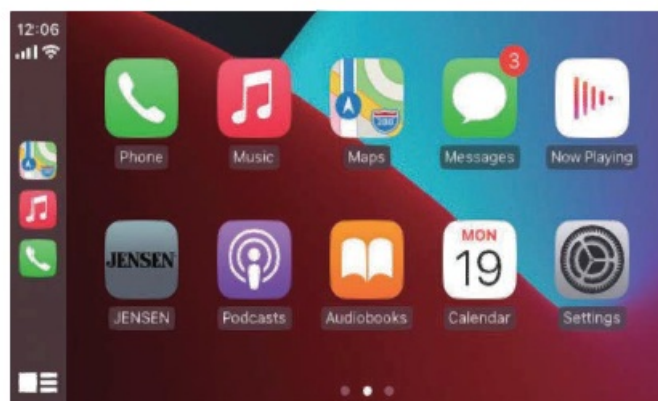


Wired & Wireless CarPlay Operation

Wired connedion

1. Connect an Apple CarPlay compatible device to this unit via USB.
2. Press the Apple CarPlay icon.

Wireless connedion

Before using Apple CarPlay wirelessly, tum on the Bluetooth/Wifi function on the Phone.



1. Press icon  on the main menu:
2. Press “” to confirm to use wireless CarPlay:

4. Find the desired device on the screen and press “Pair”:
5. A pass key will be displayed on the screen:

8. Press “Use CarPlay” on the iPhone. The unit configures the connection then starts the application.

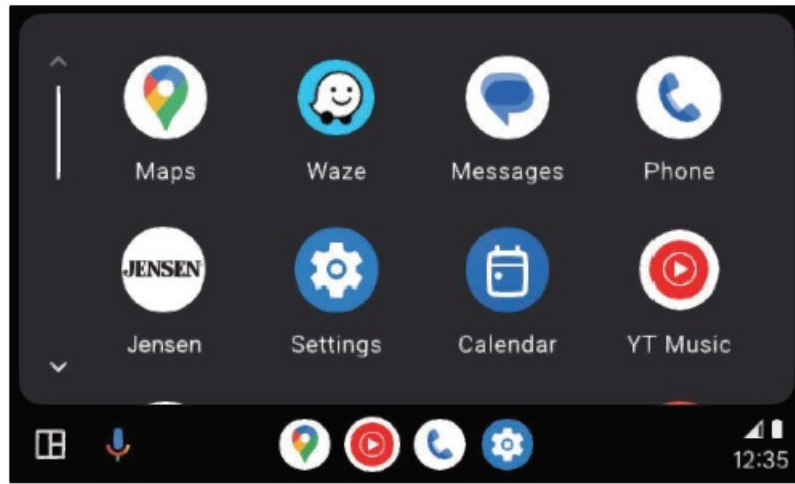

Wireless connection

Bluetooth Operation

Before using Bluetooth

Before you can use a Bluetooth device to make hands-free calls or stream audio, it must be authenticated. This is also referred to as “pairing” a device.

Pairing a New Device

The unit broadcasts the pairing signal constantly when no devices are currently connected. Complete the pairing sequence from your Bluetooth device. Refer to the owner’s manual for your device for more details. The device name is The unit can be in any mode of operation when pairing is performed.

On certain phones, pairing may need to be done more than once.

Connect

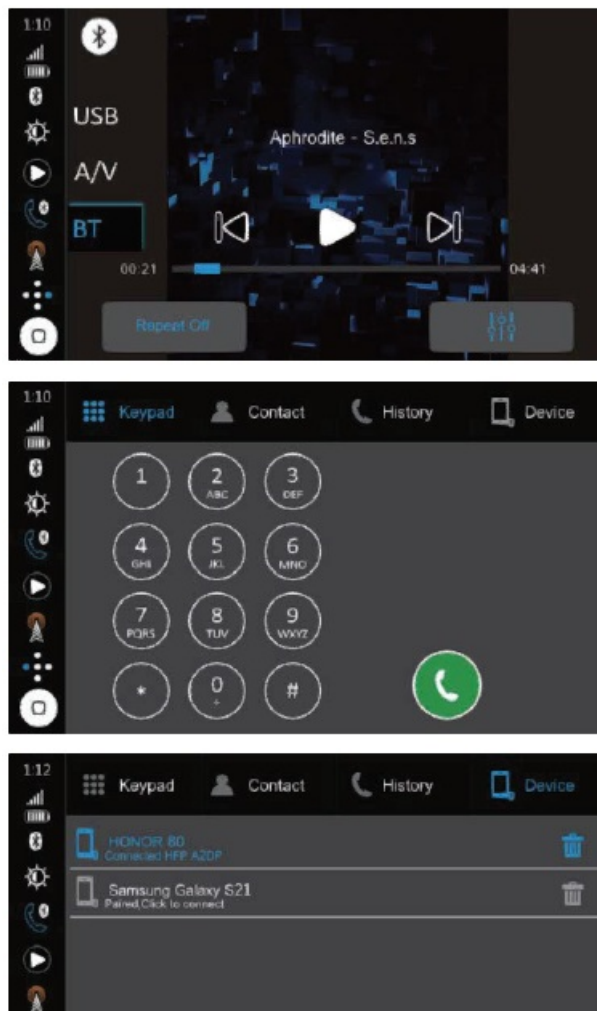
The head unit will automatically connect to the last connected device when the connect feature is set to Auto connect On.

If the connect feature is set to Auto Connect Off, the head unit will not automatically connect to any device.

Bluetooth Phone

From the main menu, touch the Bluetooth on the screen.



Bluetooth icon will appear anytime a Bluetooth device is connected.




Dialing a Number

Press  to display keypad and dial a number.




Making and Ending a Call

Press  to connect a call, and press  to end a call.

Transferring Audio

Press  to transfer audio between the head unit and mobile phone.

Streaming Audio

- Press  to play or pause the music.
- Press  to skip to the previous track.
- Press  to advance to the next track.

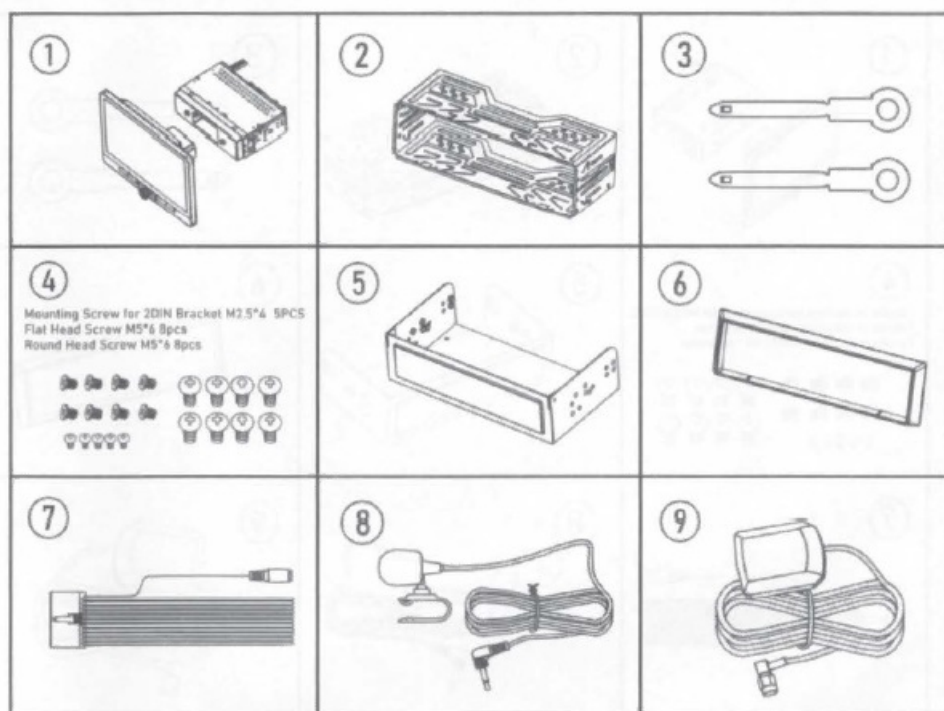

Preparing for Installation

Package Contents

1. Main Unit
2. Mounting Sleeve
3. Release Keys
4. Screw Kit
5. Bracket For 2 Din
6. Trim Ring
7. Wiring Harness
8. Microphone
9. GPS Antenna (for CarPlay and Android Auto only)



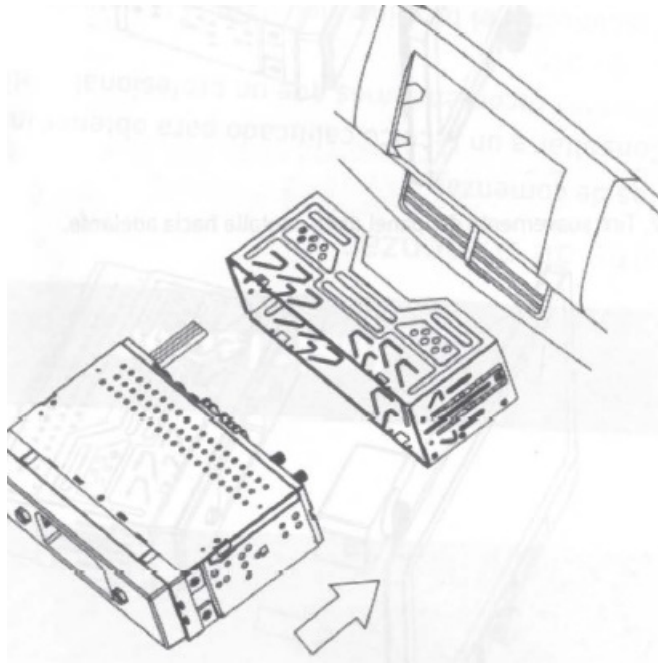
Before You Begin

- Consult a qualified technician for instructions.
- We always recommend professional installation.
- Disconnect the negative battery terminal.
- Remove trim ring from unit (if installed).
- Insert the removal keys, and remove the mounting sleeve from the receiver.

Note: Most vehicles require an installation kit, wiring harness and/or antenna adapter (all sold separately) to properly install the head unit in the vehicle.

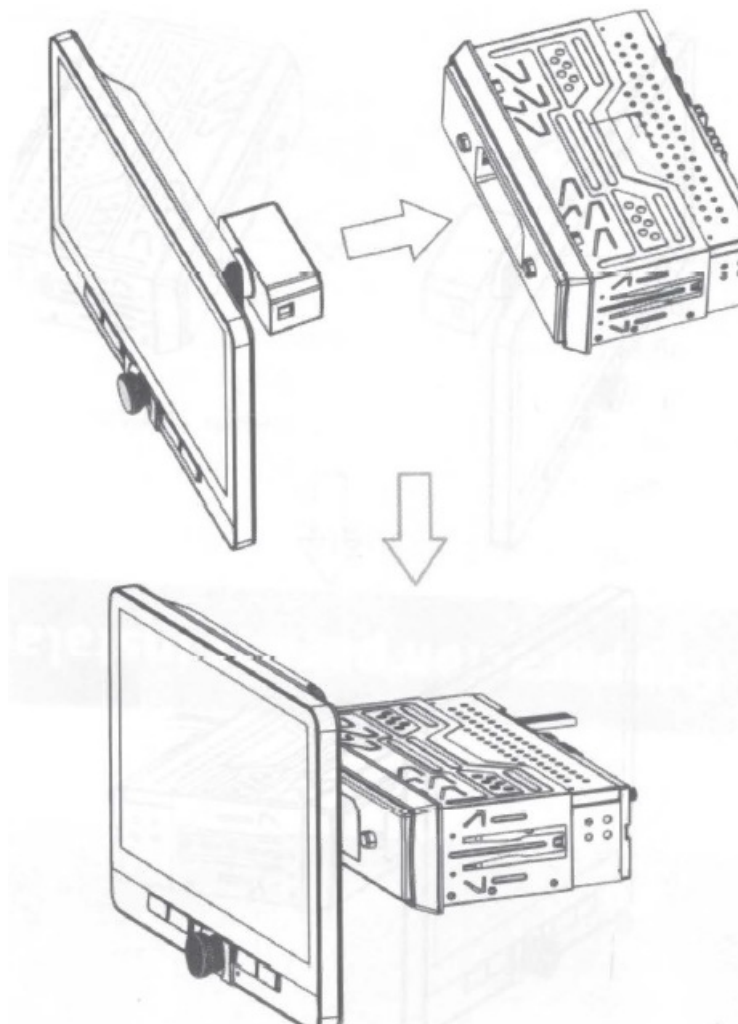
Install Mounting Sleeve and Trim Ring

1. Install the mounting sleeve into a dash kit (sold separately) or dash opening, bending the tabs to secure the mounting sleeve.
2. Connect the wiring harness, microphone and antenna to the chassis of the radio.
3. Snap trim ring into place making sure the notched area is on the bottom.
4. Slide the receiver into the mounting sleeve to secure.



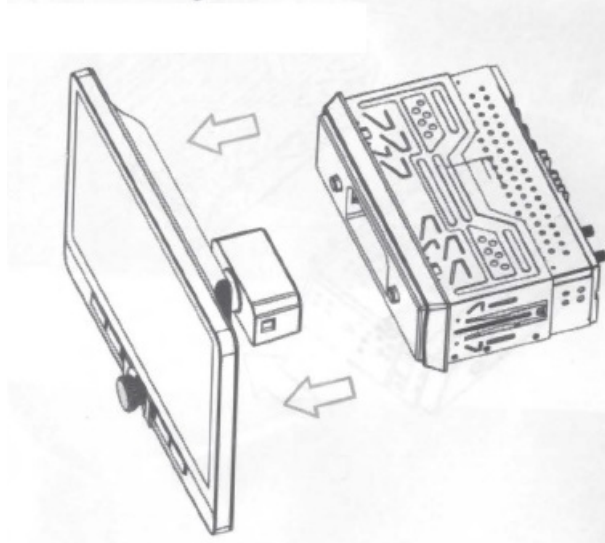
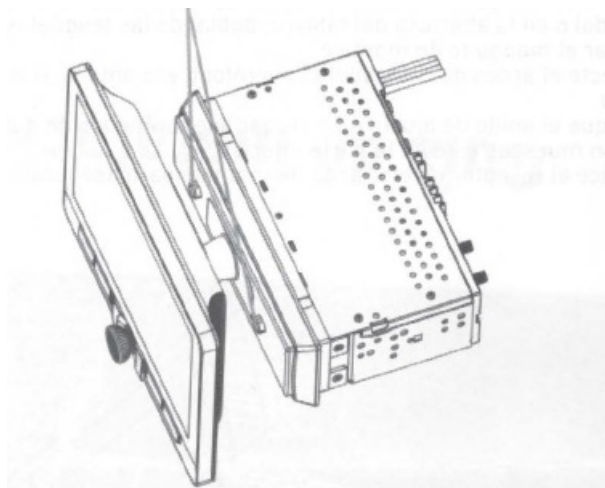
Connecting the LCD to the Chassis Kansall

To connect the LCD to the unit, carefully push the LCD connector into the receiver's chassis, until you hear a click as shown below.



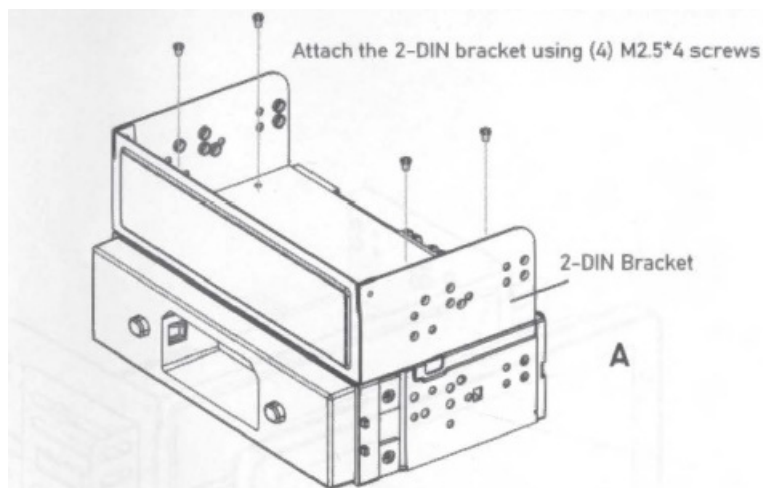
Removing the LCD from the Chassis

1. Hold down the two release buttons



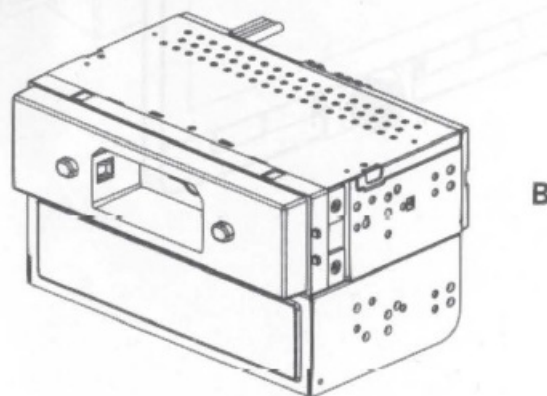
2. Gently pull the display panel forward

Installing the 2-DIN Bracket



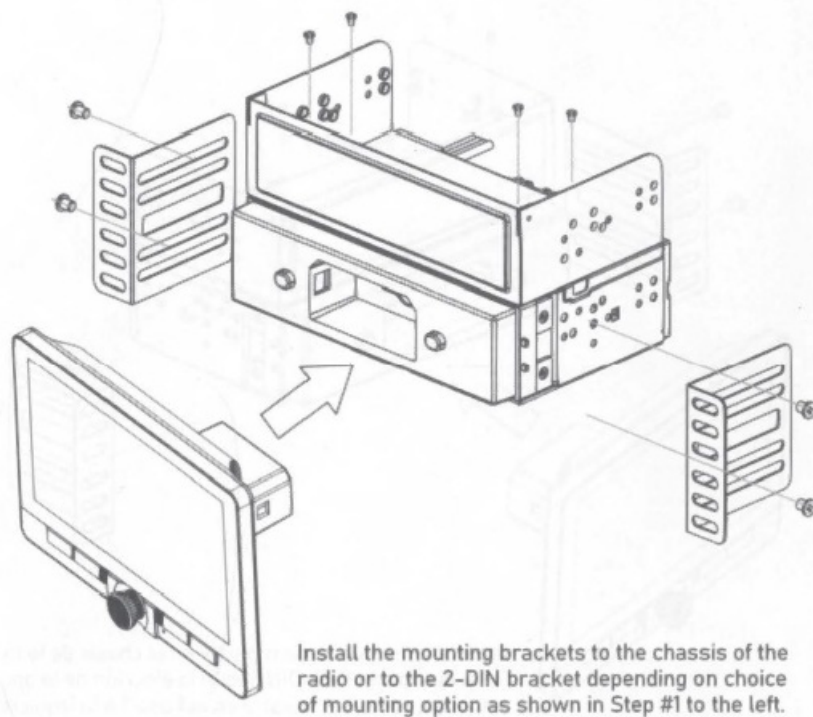
Install the 2-DIN mounting bracket to the top of the chassis (shown above) or to the bottom of the chassis (shown below).

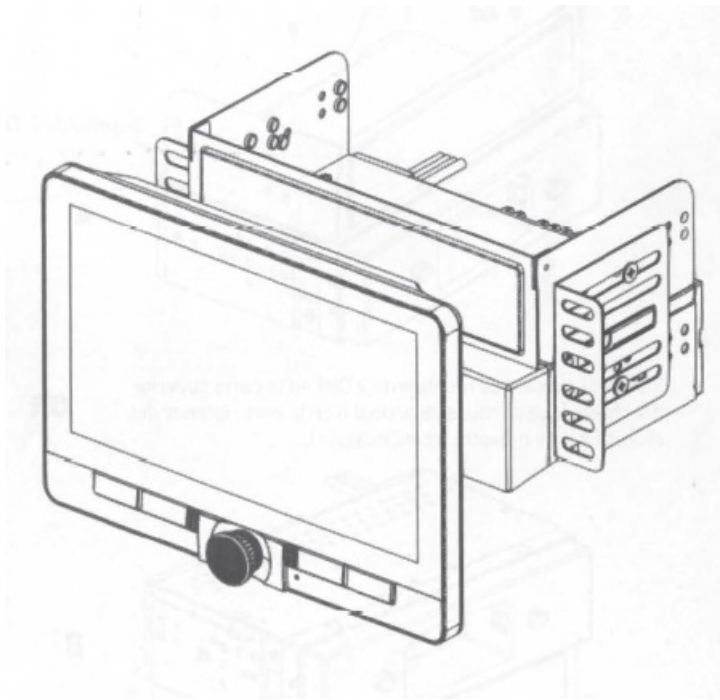


Install Mounting Brackets
