- · After Use:
 - Switch OFF the receiver first, then the transmitter.
 - Perform routine maintenance tasks.

General Information:

- Keep the device away from children and pets.
- Avoid extreme temperatures, direct sunlight, and mechanical stress.
- Remove batteries if not in use for an extended period to prevent damage.
- Handle leaking or damaged batteries with protective gloves.

Disposal:

Follow proper disposal guidelines for electronic equipment and batteries to protect the environment and prevent hazards.

Before use

- Check the rigging and make sure compartments are sealed.
- The transmitter and receiver batteries should have sufficient charge to avoid losing control of the model.
- Switch ON the transmitter first, and then switch ON the receiver.

During use

- Do not operate the model:
- On waterways where there is recreational or commercial traffic. This can cause serious accidents, personal injury and/or property damage.
- Near people, small children, or animals.

After use

- Switch OFF the receiver first, and then switch OFF the transmitter. Perform routine maintenance such as checking for— Dirt and debris
- · Water ingress
- If the battery compartment is wet:
 - Immediately remove the batteries.
 - Tip the water out and allow the interior to completely dry.

General information

- The device is not a toy. Keep it out of the reach of children and pets.
- Do not leave packaging material lying around carelessly. This may become dangerous playing material for children.
- Protect the appliance from extreme temperatures, direct sunlight, strong jolts, flammable gases, steam and solvents.
- Do not place the product under any mechanical stress.
- If it is no longer possible to operate the product safely, take it out of operation and protect it from any accidental use. Safe operation can no longer be guaranteed if the product:

- · is visibly damaged,
- · is no longer working properly,
- has been stored for extended periods in poor ambient conditions or
- has been subjected to any serious transport-related stresses.
- Please handle the product carefully. Jolts, impacts or a fall even from a low height can damage the product.
- Consult an expert when in doubt about the operation, safety or connection of the appliance.
- Maintenance, modifications and repairs must only be completed by a technician or an authorised repair centre.
- If you have questions which remain unanswered by these operating instructions, contact our technical support service or other technical personnel.

(Rechargeable) batteries

Correct polarity must be observed while inserting the (rechargeable) battery.

- The (rechargeable) batteries should be removed from the device if it is not used for a long period of time to avoid damage through leaking. Leaking or damaged (rechargeable) batteries might cause acid burns when in contact with skin, therefore use suitable protective gloves to handle corrupted (rechargeable) batteries.
- (Rechargeable) batteries must be kept out of reach of children. Do not leave (rechargeable) batteries lying around, as there is risk, that children or pets swallow them.
- All (rechargeable) batteries should be replaced at the same time. Mixing old and new (re-chargeable) batteries
 in the device can lead to (rechargeable) battery leakage and device damage.
- (Rechargeable) batteries must not be dismantled, short-circuited or thrown into fire. Never recharge non-rechargeable batteries. There is a risk of explosion!

Disposal

Product
