Product Usage Instructions

1. Long press for 3 seconds: Power on/off

2. Incoming call: Press to answer/hang up

3. In the playing state: Press to play/pause

4. Wireless status: the pairing status indicator blinks quickly, and after the pairing is successful, the indicator blinks slowly or is steady on

5. Charging state: the indicator light is steady on or blinking when charging, and the indicator light is off when charging is completed

6. Before use, please read the instructions on the product packaging (carton or label) carefully (see the detailed operation method of the product).

7. If not used for a long time, please fully power off and save

Power On/Off:

To power on the device, press and hold the power button for 3 seconds. To power off, repeat the same process.

Charging:

Connect the device to a power source using the provided cable. The LED indicator will show the charging status.

Functionality:

Use the control buttons to navigate through different modes and settings. Refer to the user manual for detailed instructions on each function.

FCC STATEMENT

Caution:

This device complies with part 15 of the FCC Rules.

Operation is subject to the following two conditions:

FAQ

Q: How do I reset the device?

A: To reset the device, locate the reset button on the back and press it for 5 seconds.

Q: Can I use the device while charging?

A: Yes, you can use the device while it is charging. However, it is recommended to let it fully charge before extended use.

Q: How do I clean the product?

A: Wipe the product with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or solvents.
