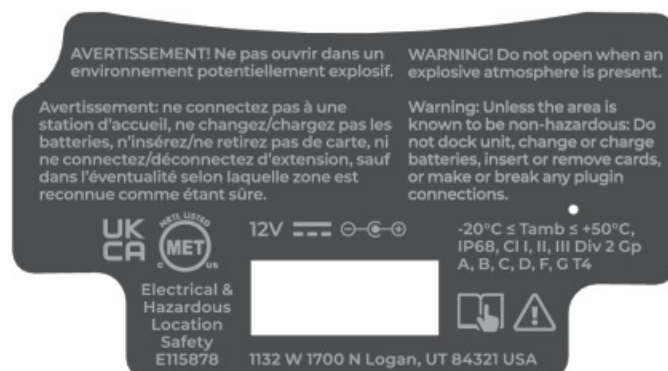

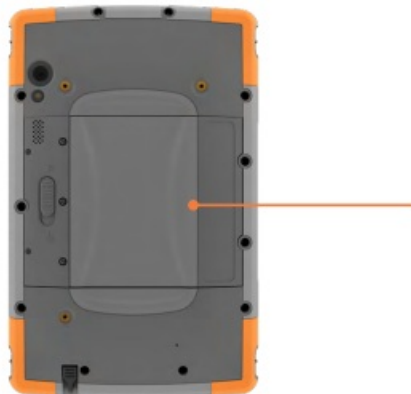
Using the Mesa 4 Rugged Tablet in a Hazardous Location
