Kandao WL0308 All-In-One Conference Camera



Specifications:

- Parts: Lens module, Control unit, Ring lamp
- Switch modes: Vol-, Vol+, Built-in speaker, Microphone Mute
- Ports: DC port, Extended cable port, USB port

Product Usage Instructions


Connection Information:

- 1. Connect the camera with a V.A. adapter.
- 2. Press the lens module to start the camera. The blue light will flash quickly and then switch to slow flash when the camera is ready for work (approximately 5 seconds).
- 3. Connect the camera to a PC via USB.
- 4. Start your desired video conference platform (Teams, Skype, ZOOM, etc) and enter a distant conference. The instruction light will be steady blue.
- 5. Use the camera buttons to adjust voice volume, mute the microphone, and switch modes during the conference.
- 6. After the conference, press the lens module to turn off the camera.


Firmware Update:

- 1. Turn on the camera and connect it to a PC.
- 2. Press and hold the mode button for 5 seconds until the blue light flashes quickly. The camera enters USB mode when the instruction light turns red.
- 3. Copy the firmware to the camera's USB.
- 4. Restart the camera to initiate the system update. The blue light will flash slowly once the update is complete.

Parts Description



Connection Information



- 1. Get the camera connected with 12V 3.0A adapter.
- 2. Press the lens module to start the camera, when it's pop-up, the blue light flashes quickly then switch to slowly flash when the camera is ready for work. The whole process is about 30 seconds.
- 3. Connect PC with the camera via USB.
- 4. Start a video conference platform(Teams, Skype, ZOOM, etc), enter a distant conference, instruction light will be steady blue.
- 5. Click the camera buttons to turn down/up voice, mute microphone, and switch modes.
- 6. When a conference is dismissed, press lens module to turn off the camera.

Note: You may need to select the Kandao Meeting camera and microphone when using some video conferencing platforms.

Firmware update



- 1. Turn on the camera and get it connected with PC, long hold mode button for 5 seconds, The blue light flashes quickly, and the camera enter in USB mode when the instruction light stays red.
- 2. Copy firmware to camera USB.
- 3. Restart the camera to enter system update, when the update is done, blue light would turn to flashing slowly.



- 2. When using an external power supply connection, please observe all safety rules of third-party power supply equipment.
- 3. The lens of the Intelligent 360-degree panoramic camera is made of glass. If the lens is damaged, be sure to handle it carefully to avoid being scratched by the broken
- 4. The temperature of the camera may rise during operation, which is a normal phenomenon during use. In this case, turn off the camera and leave it to cool before trying to use it.
- 5. This product is not a toy and you are solely responsible for complying with all local laws, regulations, and restrictions.
- 6. Please do not use the Intelligent 360-degree panoramic camera for unauthorized monitoring, candid shooting or in any way that violates personal privacy regulations. Normally, the use of cameras for such purposes is strictly prohibited and can result in significant liability and criminal proceedings against the operator.
- 7. **Precautions**: do not put the camera in an extremely cold or hot environment. Extremely cold or hot conditions may cause the camera to temporarily not work properly.
- 8. **Warning**: there is no protection for the two lenses of the Intelligent 360-degree panoramic camera. If you do not pay attention, it is easy to form scratches. Avoid placing the lens on any surface. Lens scratches are not covered by the warranty.

FAQ

Q: How do I update the firmware of the camera?

A: To update the firmware, turn on the camera, connect it to a PC, and press and hold the mode button for 5 seconds until the blue light flashes quickly. Copy the firmware to the camera's USB and restart it for the update process.

Q: How do I start a video conference using the camera?

A: Connect the camera with a V.A. adapter, press the lens module to start it, connect it to a PC via USB, and join your desired video conference platform. Use the camera buttons to adjust settings during the conference.
