Follow the instructions provided by the Kaptia Key Management application to read and write data on the cards/tags.

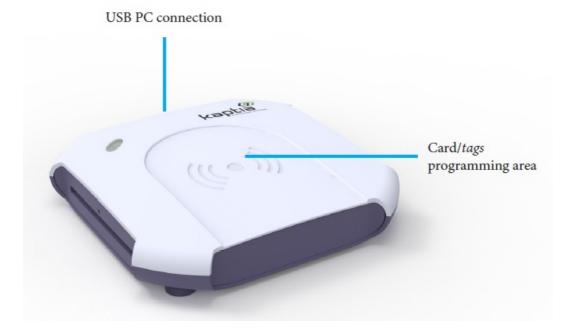
# • Powering the Device
