



- 6. Brackets




Instructions For Use

- 1. Short press to turn on the device. The lights will turn on and music will sound.
- 2. Press and hold. The device will turn off in 2 to 3 seconds.
- 3. If there is no operation for about 3 minutes after successful startup, the device will automatically shut down.
- 4. Turn on the phone and set up a Bluetooth connection device to play music on the phone. Bluetooth device name: device name starting with "GDBX"
- 5. "Shift" on the monitor "Keys: Counting, timing, calorie switching keys. "Gears" keys: 1-8 gears, gear increase and decrease.

Installation Notes

Installation Way1:

- 1. Hole No.1/2/3/4 are mounting holes for brackets.
- 2. First, fix the No. 2 and No. 3 holes of the bracket with the 2 holes on the back of the boxing target with flat head screws.
- 3. Draw the No. 1 and No. 4 holes of the bracket on the wall, drill the holes with an impact electric drill, and fix them on the wall with expansion screws.
- 4. Before using the product, please make sure the installation is firm.



Installation Way2:

- 1. First, tear off the double-sided tape on the upper half of the EVA.
- 2. The EVA paste is aligned on the back of the product.
- 3. Tear off the double-sided tape on the lower half of the EVA sticker.
- 4. Put it in place and stick it firmly on the wall.

Installation Way3:

- 1. Align and paste the Hook and Loop Fastener with glue on the back of the product.
- 2. Peel off the double-sided tape on thetop half.
- 3. Align the position with the wall and stick it firmly.

Precautions

- 1. Please fix this product on a strong and reliable wall. When hitting, please hit within the hitting area. It is strictly forbidden to hit the corner area to avoid hand injury or equipment damage.
- 2. This product is suitable for adults. Children should use it under adult supervision.
- 3. Beginners should not hit too hard to avoid hand injuries. Pay attention to safety first during exercise, and leg and knee strikes are strictly prohibited.
- 4. It is strictly prohibited to hit the speaker area.
- 5. If the device cannot be turned on or has abnormalities, please check whether the battery is too low and charge it in time. The charging time should not exceed 8 hours. If it is not used for a long time, it is recommended to charge it once every 1-2 months.
- 6. This product is not waterproof. When wiping the boxing target, use a dry cloth and do not get it wet.
- 7. Please keep the instructions properly for emergency use

FAQ

- · How do I connect my phone to play music on the device?
 - To play music from your phone on the Second Generation Smart Music Boxing Target, turn on your phone's Bluetooth and search for a device starting with GDBX. Connect to this device to stream music.

· What should I do if the lights flicker on the device?

 If you notice lights flickering, it may indicate low battery. Please ensure to charge the device to resolve this issue.

· How can I troubleshoot if there are no lights and no sound?

• If there are no lights or sound, first check if the product is powered on by pressing the switch. If it does not resolve, check for battery drain and charge accordingly.
