Risk Assessment

Janser Gigant Stirring Station

Identify Hazards / Risky Activities

Step 1:

Hazard	Description
Electrical hazard	Risk of electric shock from damaged cords or contact wi th wet surfaces
Manual handling strain	Injury risk when lifting heavy buckets, moving the unit, o r handling material
Entanglement	Risk of clothing, hair, or fingers caught in the mixing pad dle

Slips, trips, and falls	Wet or spilled material can create slippery surfaces
Dust inhalation	When pouring in dry compounds or during cleaning
Noise exposure	Potential hearing damage during prolonged use in enclo sed spaces
Overexertion	Risk of fatigue or strain from repetitive use or prolonged operation

Who Might Be Harmed and How

Step 2

Person at Risk	How They Might Be Harmed
Operator	Electrical shock, strain, entanglement, hearing damage, du st exposure
Co-workers	Exposure to dust, slips from spilled material, tripping over c ables
Maintenance crew	Exposure during cleaning or disassembly; potential for elec tric shock
Clean-up personnel	Risk of handling spills or waste without adequate protection

Risk Evaluation & Precautions

Step 3

Hazard	Risk Level	Precautions / Controls
Electrical hazard	Medium	Use RCD-protected outlets; inspect I eads before use; avoid wet areas

Manual handling strain	Medium	Use lifting aids or team lift; avoid ov erfilling buckets; train on manual ha ndling	
Entanglement	High	Fit paddle guard; tie back hair; wear tight-fitting clothing; never reach insi de when operating	
Slips, trips, and falls	Medium	Keep work area clean; clean spills i mmediately; use non-slip mats if needed	
Dust inhalation	Medium	Wear P2 mask when adding dry mix ; operate in well ventilated area	
Noise exposure	Low– Medium	Use hearing protection when in enclosed or echo-prone spaces	
Overexertion	Medium	Rotate tasks to avoid fatigue; provi	

Risk Management Plan

Step 4

Controls in Place:

- PPE Required: Safety boots, gloves, hearing protection, P2 mask, eye protection
- Pre-use Inspection: Check cables, plug, mixer arm, and paddle guard
- Training: All operators must be trained on setup, safe use, and emergency shut-off
- Operating Guidelines: Never leave unit running unattended; use only for intended materials
- **Spill Response**: Keep mop, bucket, and absorbent materials nearby for rapid cleanup
- Storage & Transport: Lock wheels when stationary; transport using proper lifting technique

Review and Update

Step 5

Review Triggers:

- Every 6 months or after a near miss/incident
- When the unit is replaced or upgraded
- If job site conditions change significantly
