


KODAK P210R Portable Photo Printer

- 1. This Printer has a built-in battery. Charge the printer before using it.
- 2. How to Change Cartridge

Smartphone App Installation

ANDROID


- 1. Go to the GOOGLE Play Store on your smartphone.
- 2. Search "KODAK Instant Printer"
- 3. Install "KODAK Instant Printer". Into your smartphone

APPLE Device

- 1. Go to APP STORE on your iPhone, IPOD TOUCH, or IPAD.
- 2. Search "KODAK Instant Printer"
- 3. Install "KODAK Instant Printer". Application into your device.

BLUETOOTH Connection

- 1. Turn on BLUETOOTH on your smartphone
- 2. Turn on the printer.
- 3. Go to the BLUETOOTH setting in your smartphone and you can find "KODAK Instant-XXXX" ('XXXX' are 4 4-digit combinations of numbers and letters.)
- 4. Select it for connection.



Power and Active Status

- Power ON: White / Power OFF(2Sec): Off / Printing: White Flickering F.W Upgrade: Pink Flickering / No Cartridge, Error: Red Flickering Waiting, Cooling: White
- Charge

- Charging: Red
- Charging Complete: Green
- Connecting: Green Blink / Bluetooth Complete: Green

Printing in the App

- 1. KODAK Instant Printer app launch
- 2. "Gallery" to load your device's photos.
- 3. Choose Photo
- 4. Select Print Number
- 5. Select Printer Icon









Select SNS if you want to print the photo from it.

FEATURES

- Compact Design: It's small, light, and movable, so you can print on the go.
- Wireless Connectivity: It connects via Bluetooth so you can print easily from your phone or computer.
- Fits a lot of devices: It works with both iOS and Android, so it fits a lot of devices.
- Printing Method: For good picture prints, it uses dye-sublimation technology.
- Size of Print: It prints 2×3-inch pictures, which are great for quick prints.
- **High Resolution:** Prints at a high resolution, usually up to 300 dpi, so pictures are clear and bright.
- Instant Printing: Prints are sent out right away, giving you quick results.
- Recharging Battery: It has a built-in recharging battery that lets you print on the go without an extra power source.
- No Ink Refills: It uses ZINK (Zero Ink) paper, so you don't need regular ink refills.
- Self-Adhesive Backing: Photos can be used as stickers because the back of them sticks to itself.
- Easy to Use App: The KODAK app makes it simple to change printer settings, make changes, and edit photos.
- LED Indicator Lights: Make it easy to see what the printer is doing (printing, charging, etc.).
- Simple Setup: It's easy to set up, and you only need to do a few things to get Bluetooth to work.

- Lightweight: It only weighs a few ounces, so it's great for traveling and using outside.
- KODAK Photo Paper: It comes with KODAK 2×3-inch ZINK picture paper, which is small and easy to carry.
- Color Print Mode: Full-color printing lets you make photos that look bright and clear.
- **Durable Prints:** Photos won't get wet, smudged, or torn, so your memories will last a lifetime.
- Multiple Print Options: You can print several pictures at once or make layouts right in the app.
- Stylish Design: The design is modern and sleek, and it comes in different colors so that everyone can find something they like.
- Affordable: It's a cheap way to print because you don't have to buy expensive ink refills.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- Use a Soft, Dry Cloth: Wipe down the outside of the printer regularly to get rid of dust and other dirt.
- Clean the Print Head: To keep ink from building up, clean the print head gently with a cotton swab or soft cloth.
- Use the Right Paper: For the best print quality and performance, always use KODAK 2×3-inch ZINK picture paper.
- Store in a Dry Place: Keep the printer away from extreme temperatures or high humidity, which can damage internal parts.
- Avoid Direct Sunlight: Don't store the printer in direct sunlight, as it could overheat or break down.
- Regularly Charge: To keep the battery from dying, keep the printer charged when it's not in use.
- **Do Not Overcharge**: Disconnect the charger once the battery is fully charged to make it last longer.
- Turn Off After Use: Always turn off the printer when you're done using it to save battery life and reduce wear.
- Use the Original Charger: Always use the USB wire and adapter that came with the printer for charging.
- Handle Carefully: Avoid dropping or handling the printer roughly, as this can damage internal components.
- Check for Code Updates: Update the printer's code regularly for better performance and bug fixes.
- **Keep Bluetooth Up to Date**: Ensure your device's Bluetooth is up to date and properly paired for seamless connectivity.
- Keep the Paper Tray Clean: Remove dust or dirt from the paper tray to prevent clogs.
- Store in a Cool, Well-Ventilated Area: Avoid storing the printer in hot places or cramped spaces with poor airflow.
- Do Not Use Non-Kodak Paper: Using incompatible paper can damage the printer and produce poor-quality prints.
- Check the Health of the Battery: If battery life drops significantly, consider replacing the battery or seeking expert help.
- Replace Broken Parts: Replace damaged parts like the paper tray or cover promptly to ensure smooth operation.
- Use Compatible Apps Only: Stick to apps designed for the printer and avoid third-party apps that might not work properly.
- **Test the Printer Often**: Print a test picture periodically, even when the printer isn't in use, to ensure it's in good condition.

Troubleshooting

Symptom	cause/Solution
Paper Jam	Power off and Power On again. Paper will be automatically ejected If not, please contact customer service.
The image quality is not g ood.	Print quality could be less if your photo source has low resolution.
	Over 1280 x 2448 pixels is recommended for best image quality.
The printer is not responding	Press the reset button with a sharp tool like a pin. RESET
