#### **About This Guide**

#### **Purpose**

This guide explains the setup and operation of the TouchTunes 27 MHz frequency wireless remote control, P/N 700842-001 (which should be ordered as P/N 600330-001) and the 433 MHz frequency wireless remote control, P/N 700841-001 (which should be ordered as P/N 600329-001).

#### **Package Contents**

- · Remote control;
- Two (2) AAA alkaline batteries;
- This guide (901214-001).

#### Overview

The TouchTunes single-frequency wireless remote control has integrated flash memory to help prevent it from losing its ID when the batteries drain.

It is RF-based, which eliminates the need to point it directly at the jukebox and is powered by two (2) 1.5V AAA batteries (included with the remote).


Figure 1 27 MHz Remote (Black)

The black remote transmits a 27 MHz signal [ Figure 1 – 27 MHz Remote (Black) ]

### **Installing the Batteries**


- 1. Using a cross-head screwdriver, remove the battery cover plate;
- 2. Install the batteries in the remote;



3. Close the battery cover plate and fasten the screw.

### **Setting the Remote Control ID**

1. Press and hold the POWER and F4 keys at the same time for approximately five (5) seconds. The remote will switch into a state where it is ready to set a new Control ID and the indicator LED lights up and stays on.




2. Press one of the 28 keys corresponding to the HEX code desired to select a unique Control ID (refer to section [4] – Remote Functions).

The remote is now ready to be synced to the jukebox.


NOTE: Jukes using Gen3 cannot use Control-ID 000.

NOTE: The QR Code on the remote enables quick access to the online Quick Refence Guide (QRG).


### Learning the Remote ID

On the Operator Menu, open the Hardware Options screen.

1. Press the LEARN button.



2. Watch the display. When prompted, press the MIC VOL UP key on the remote control.



The display will show a success message and return to the Options screen.

3. Test the remote by raising and lowering the jukebox volume as it is playing.

### **Key Assignments and Functionality**

Key		Function
Power On/Off	P2	Press to turn the jukebox monitor and audio subsystem on or off. The jukebox computer remains on. Equivalent to pressing the Night Mode button on the jukebox (not available on all models).
Bar Rewards (P2)	P2 F1 F2 + F3 F4	Press to display an activation code used to register for TouchTunes' staff loyalty program.
Promo Credits	P2 F1 F2 + F3 F4 O D	Adds a free credit to the jukebox if the Promo Credit Setting is enabled, and there are available credits to add.
Background Music Channels	P2 (b) F1 F2 (+ F3 F4) (4 O D)	Left and right arrows navigate through the background music channels (if applicable). Pressing "o" selects the channel.

### Pause/Play



Pressing this button will pause or unpause (play) the jukebox music.

If an aux source is set-up and enabled, pausing the jukebox will begin playing sound from the aux source.

## Skip Song Clear Play Queue



Skip song: Quickly press and release this button to stop playing the current song and immediately skip forward to the next song in the queue.

Clear Play Queue: Press and hold this button for four (4) seconds to flush the entire play queue.

NOTE: Background music songs

cannot be skipped.


NOTE: The Skip Song feature can be

enabled/disable on the jukebox System Settings screen or through Tempo > Location > Settings > Jukebox > Remote.

#### Master volume



Increases or decreases the volume in all zones (except those which are locked).



NOTE: Only the volumes of activated zones can be controlled; volume buttons for zones that are not activated will have no effect
