## GETTING STARTED

1. Remove the battery cover from the keyboard and install a single AAA battery. Put the battery cover back on the keyboard.
2. Remove the battery cover from the mouse and install a single AA battery.
3. Remove the USB Nano receiver from the compartment in the mouse and plug it into a free USB port on your computer/laptop.

Put the battery cover back on the mouse.

4. Your wireless keyboard and mouse should automatically connect to your computer/laptop.

- FN + F9 – Home Page
- FN + F10 – Open Default Email Program
- FN + F11 – My Computer
- FN + F12 – Open Favourites

## TROUBLESHOOTING


1. If the computer is not detecting unplug the device and plug in again
2. Test the device on another USB port
3. Update Windows to the latest version
4. Update USB drivers to the latest version
