

NOTE



NOTE

Do not place any object into the ice cream maker other than the swirl pieces provided with the Count & Swirl Ice Cream Maker™. Wash the sundae cup thoroughly before and after use.

Unlock the Packaging Locks


- 1. Rotate the packaging locks 90 degrees counterclockwise.
- 2. Pull out the packaging locks and discard



GETTING STARTED

BATTERY REMOVAL AND INSTALLATION

- 1. Make sure the unit is turned OFF.
- 2. Find the battery cover located on the back of the unit, use a screwdriver to loosen the screw, and then open the battery cover.
- 3. Remove old batteries by pulling up on one end of each battery.
- 4. Install 3 new AA (AM-3/LR6) batteries following the diagram inside the battery box. (For best performance, alkaline batteries or fully charged Ni-MH rechargeable batteries are recommended).
- 5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw to secure.



WARNING:

Adult assembly required for battery installation. Keep batteries out of reach of children.

IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION

- Insert batteries with the correct polarity (+ and -).
- · Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- Remove batteries during long periods of non-use.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Dispose of batteries safely. Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES

- Remove rechargeable batteries (if removable) from the toy before charging.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Do not charge non-rechargeable batteries.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- 1. Keep the unit clean by wiping it with a slightly damp cloth.
- 2. Keep the unit out of direct sunlight and away from any direct heat sources.
- 3. Remove the batteries if the unit will not be in use for an extended period of time.
- 4. Do not drop the unit on hard surfaces and do not expose the unit to moisture or water.
- 5. If the unit stops working or malfunctions, install a new set of batteries.

NOTE
