## **Quick Start Guide**

1. The keyboard's default layout is configured for Windows. To use it with MacOS, please remap it using VIA.



2. The VIA Key Remapping Software

Please visit usevia.app to use the online


VIA software to remap the keys.

If the VIA cannot recognize your keyboard, please reach our support to get the instruction.




- \*The online VIA software can only run on the latest version of Chrome, Edge, and Opera browsers yet.
- \*VIA only works when the keyboard is connected by wire to the computer.
- 3. The Backlight

Press Fn + Q to change the lighting effect




Press Fn+ Tab to turn the backlight on/off




# 4. Adjust The Backlight Brightness

Press Fn + W to increase the backlight brightness




Press Fn + S to decrease the backlight brightness



# 5. The Key Rollover

Press Fn + N to switch 6-key rollover/N-key rollover



6-key rollover: the keyboard can detect up to 6 simultaneous key inputs.

N-key rollover: the keyboard can detect all key inputs without limit to the number of key presses.

\*The keyboard turns on the N-key rollover by default.

# 6. Factory Reset



# Troubleshooting? Don't know what's going on with the keyboard?

- 1. Download the right firmware and QMK Toolbox from our website.
- 2. Unplug the power cable and remove the space bar keycap to find the reset button on the PCB.
- 3. Hold the reset key first, then plug in the power cable. Release the reset key, and the keyboard will now enter DFU mode.
- 4. Flash the firmware with the QMK Toolbox.
- 5. Factory reset the keyboard by pressing Fn + J + Z (for 4 seconds).



# **DEFAULT KEY LAYOUT:**

LAYER 0: This is the default layer.



LWin=Left Windows LAlt=Left Alt RAlt=Right Alt RCtl=Right Ctrl

LAYER 1: This layer will be activated when you press the Fn/MO(1) key.



LAYER 2 / LAYER 3: This is a blank layer.
