SETUP GUIDE

- Carefully take the toy out of its box and check that all of its parts are there, such as the USB charging cable and catnip bag.
- Charge the Toy: To charge the toy, use the USB cord that came with it. To get it ready to use, plug it into a power source that works with USB and let it charge all the way up.
- Add Catnip: To add more appeal, open the plush cover and put the catnip tea bag in the marked space.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

- Take Out the Battery Unit: To keep the plush cover from getting damaged, always take out the rechargeable mechanism before cleaning it.
- Check for Damage: Look for signs of wear and tear like loose threads or parts that have come off on a regular basis and replace them if needed.
- **Periodically Recharge**: To keep the toy working well, recharge it after a long game or when the battery runs out.
- Avoid Contact with Water: Keep the battery and other electrical parts inside dry and away from water.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Solution
Toy does not turn on	Ensure the toy is fully charged before use.
Flopping motion is too slow	Check if the battery charge is low; recharge as needed.
Plush fabric gets dirty	Gently spot clean with a damp cloth and mild detergent.
Charging port not working	Inspect the charging cable for damage or try a different charger.
Toy stops flopping suddenly	Ensure the toy is charged and restart by pressing the button.
Noise is too loud	Check if the toy is damaged; contact manufacturer if necessary.
Flopping motion is erratic	Recharge the toy fully and reset by turning it off and on again.
Toy feels warm during use	This may be normal; ensure it is not overheating.
Battery drains too quickly	Recharge after each use for optimal battery performance.
Charging light does not turn on	Ensure the charger is properly connected to the toy.
Toy is not responsive to touch	Reset the toy by turning it off, then on again.
The fabric is shedding	Check the toy for damage and handle gently during use.
Toy gets stuck in one position	Try manually moving the toy to reset the mechanism.
Charging time is longer than expected	Ensure the charger is functioning correctly.
Motion stops after extended play	Allow the toy to cool down before using it again.
