

Usage

- 1. Insert 6 AA batteries into the Powerman Robot and the remote control.
- 2. Use the remote to command movements, play games, or activate features like music or storytelling.
- 3. To program, press the designated button on the remote, input a sequence, and watch Powerman execute the commands.
- 4. Load discs into the robot's launcher for action-packed play, and press the shooting button on the remote.
- 5. Use the recording function to create personalized messages.

Care and Maintenance

- Wipe the robot with a clean, dry cloth to remove dirt and dust.
- Avoid using water or cleaning agents to prevent damage to electronic components.
- Store Powerman in a dry and safe place when not in use.
- Regularly check and replace batteries to ensure optimal performance.
- Keep the remote control and robot's components away from small children to avoid accidental damage.

Troubleshooting

1. Robot not responding to commands:

- Ensure the batteries in both the robot and remote are fresh and correctly installed.
- Check for obstacles between the robot and the remote that may block the signal.

2. Disc shooter not working:

- Confirm that the discs are loaded correctly.
- Clean the shooter mechanism to remove dust or debris.

3. Robot stops mid-function:

- Turn the robot off and on to reset.
- Replace the batteries if the issue persists.

4. Voice recording not playing back:

• Check if the recording feature is activated. Re-record and try playing the message again.

5. Remote control not working:

• Make sure the remote is within the effective range of the robot (approximately 5-10 feet).
