Product Usage Instructions

DC Input:

Use a 5V 4A adapter to power the device.

Type-C Connection:

The Type-C port can be used to connect to Type-C devices for data transfer or charging.

HDMI Output:

The HDMI output supports resolutions up to 4K at 60fps. Connect to a compatible display for high-quality video output.

LAN Interface:

The LAN interface supports a 1000M wired network connection. Use an Ethernet cable to connect to your network for faster data transfer.

Switch Functionality:

• Press the switch once to restart the device if needed.

TF Card Slot:


The device supports MicroSD cards for additional storage capacity. Insert a MicroSD card into the TF card slot as needed.

USB Ports:

The USB 2.0 and USB 3.0 ports support devices that comply with the respective USB protocols. Connect compatible devices to these ports for data transfer or charging.

- 1. DC input: Please use a 5V 4A adapter
- 2. Type-C: Can connect to type-C devices
- 3. HDMI OUT: HDMI output supports up to 4K 60fps
- 4. LAN interface: Supports 1000M wired network
- 5. Switch: Press once to restart the machine
- 6. TF card: Supports MicroSD card
- 7. USB2.0: Devices that support USB2.0 protocol
- 8. USB3.0: Devices that support USB3.0 protocol

Usage

- 1. First fix the device in the designated place (please refer to the installation manual for fixing the device)
- 2. Plug the HDMI cable into the display device
- 3. Plug the type-c cable into the control device
- 4. Plug the network cable into the router or switch (if you don't plug the network cable, you need to enter the system to connect to WIFI)
- 5. Plug the adapter into the socket


- 6. At this time, there should be an image on the display device, and you can operate the machine after the digital tube has time display.
- 7. You can connect the Bluetooth device and the router's WiFi in the settings interface, and then you can go online.






Installation INSTRUCTION

1. Install the media player within 2 meters from the ground.



2. Drill 4 holes for the media player on the wall.



3. Screw tight the player on the wall with 4 screws provided.
