




Also, it has built-in microphone to support hands-free talking and satisfy you with excellent user experience. Please read this manual carefully and completely before using the device. Please keep this manual for future reference.

Safety Notes

- 1.Please adjust the volume properly to avoid excessive output power, which may impair your hearing.
- 2. Please keep the device away from moisture, rain water, sand, heat source and any container with liquid.
- 3. Please clean this device with slightly wet cloth instead of alcohol or benzene containing solvent.
- *Please charge the speaker every three months if the speaker doesn't play for long time.

Description of Parts





Charging the Speaker

The speaker has built-in rechargeable battery. When the battery is drained out, speaker would turn OFF automatically. Please recharge the battery every time it drains out.

Plug the Micro USB end of the included USB rechargeable cable into the charging port. Plug the other end into a USB port on your computer or other devices made for USB charging. Red LED Light illuminates indicating that the device is being charged.

It takes 8 hours to fully charge the speaker. Once the speaker is fully charged, LED Light would turn OFF.

Turning ON/OFF the Speaker

Before Turning ON the speaker, please ensure that it is fully charged.

To Turn ON the device –Long Press the ON/OFF switch to turn on the speaker. To Turn OFF the device – Long Press the ON/OFF switch to turn off the speaker.

Connect using Wireless Technology

Long Press the ON/OFF switch to open the power, you would hear an indication tone showing the device is turned on, and you will hear another indication tone, showing that you are now in Wireless Pairing Mode. Activate the Bluetooth function on your source device (Mobile Phone, Tablet or other devices). Please refer to manufacturer's instructions for instructions on enabling Bluetooth wireless connetion on your device.

Search for available Bluetooth Wireless devices and you would find "LINSAY SLP-500CL" – Pair it with this device. If required, enter the password "0000" to pair with the device. Once paired successfully, another indication tone would be heard.

You can now stream wireless music on your speaker through your source device.

Listening to Music Connecting Bluetooth

Please ensure that your device (Mobile Phone, Tablet or other devices) is paired with the Wireless Speaker to stream music wirelessly. Once it is paired, play music from your device.

1+1 Connection

To enrich your listening expenience please you can build your own party by wirelessly connecting 2 speakers.

- 1. Turn ON the Speaker
- 2. Long press the light button and you will hear "dingdong" sound and means 2 speakers are connected successfully.
- 3. Activate the Bluetooth Wireless function on your source device (Mobile Phone, Tablet or other devices). Please refer to manufacturer's instructions for instructions on enabling wireless connetion on your device.
- 4. Search for available Wireless devices and you would find LINSAY SLP-500CL Pair it with this device.
- 5. Enjoy your connecting music time.

Listening to FM Radio

Insert the Micro USB end of the included USB rechargeable cable into the charging port, and leave the other end of the cable open. USB rechargeable cable serves as FM Antenna while in FM Radio mode.

Long Press the ON/OFF switch to open the power, you would hear an indication tone then short press button then the speaker is in FM mode.

To AUTO SCAN the station, Press Power button once.

It will take few minutes to search all the stations. Once all the stations are scanned, they get registered in memory, automatically.

Press + or - to skip selected station.

Long press + to increase the volume or press - to decrease the volum

Play Music through "Auxiliary" Mode

Turn ON the speaker.

Insert one end of the Auxiliary cable (included) into the Auxiliary port,

Plug the other end to the audio device (such as phone / MP3 Player / computer / tabletetc). Select your

favourite song at the source device to play.

Long press + to increase the volume or press – to decrease the volume.

The LED Light Settings

Short Press the button to change the LED Light you like or turn off the light. Stream music from USB Flash Drive

Turn ON the speaker.

Insert the USB Drive preloaded with songs, into the USB Card Slot of the speaker correspondingly. Speaker would automatically start playing songs from the USB Drive.
