## Product Usage Instructions

### Enabling 2-Step Verification on the G-Suite Admin Console

- Open [admin.google.com](https://admin.google.com) and sign in using an administrator account.
- Select Security > Authentication > 2-Step Verification.
- Select the checkbox labeled Allow Users to turn on 2-Step Verification.
- Select the radio button to turn Enforcement OFF, then Save.

## Update Authentication Settings for an Individual Email Address

- Access mail.google.com and sign in to the Gmail account designated for scanning at the machine.
- Select Profile > Manage Google Account.
- Select Security.
- Select 2-Step Verification / Get Started under the subsection How you sign in to Google.
- Enter the Gmail account password when prompted.
- Choose a sign-in method for 2-step Verification.
- Select Try It > Follow the Menu Prompts.
- After completing step 7, a confirmation screen will display it worked! Select TURN ON to enable 2-Step Verification.
- Return to the Security page. Select App Passwords under How you sign in to Google.
- Reauthenticate when prompted.
- Select App. Then, choose Mail as the app type and select Other.
- Name the scan device (ex: Canon MFP) and select generate.
- **IMPORTANT:** Make sure to write down the password before continuing to the next section!

## Updating the Password for a Xerox VersaLink Multi-Function Printer (MFP)

- Enter the IP Address of the machine in a web browser. Login as Admin (if prompted).
- Select Apps > Email > Setup.
- Select STARTTLS (If Available).
- Enter the Google-Generated App Password and Retype.
- Select Save.

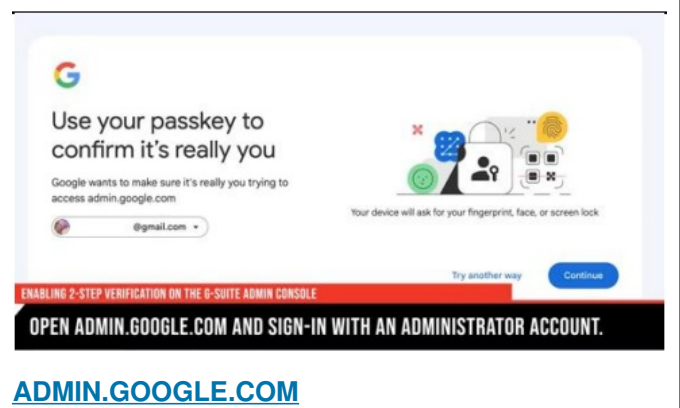

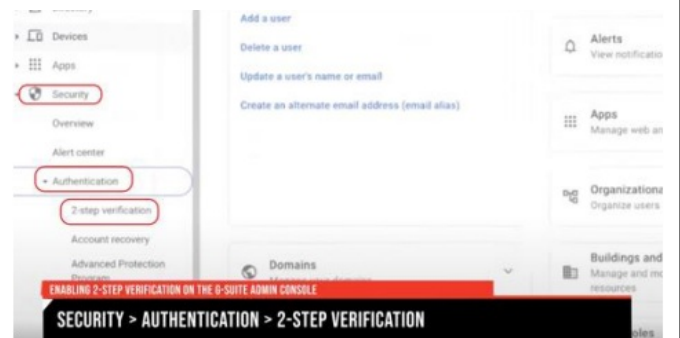

## Enabling 2-Step Verification on the G-Suite Admin Console

1. Open [admin.google.com](https://admin.google.com) and **sign-in** using an **administrator account**.

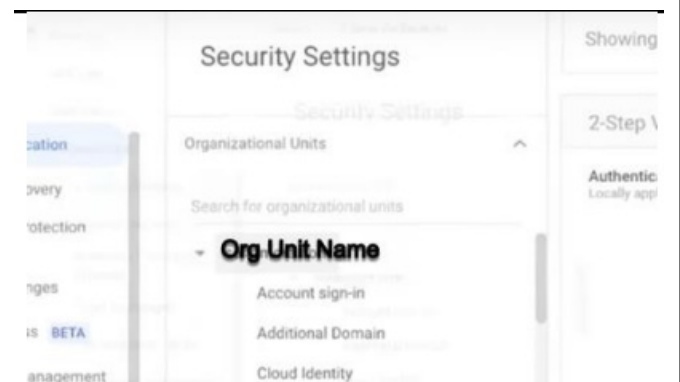


4. Select **Security** → **Authentication** → **2-Step Verification**.



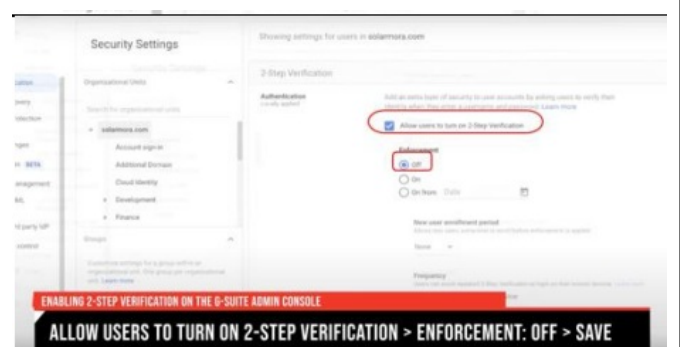
5. Select the **Configuration Group** to edit.

· **Optional:** To apply the setting to specific users, select an organizational unit instead. (Commonly used for departments.)



6. Select the **checkbox** labeled **Allow Users to turn on 2-Step Verification**.

7. Select the radio button to turn **Enforcement OFF**, then **Save**.

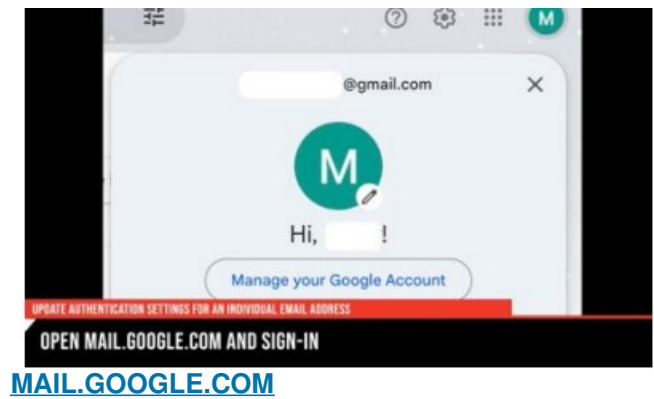


8. **Notify users** of the change and supply them with instructions for setting up 2-Step Verification on their accounts.

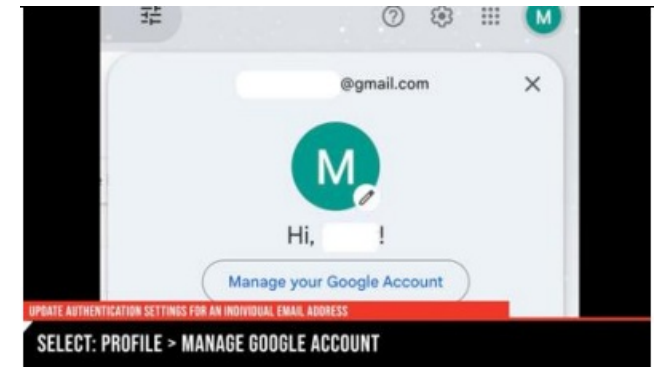

1. Access [mail.google.com](mailto:mail.google.com) and **sign-in** to the Gmail account designated for scanning at the machine.



2. Select **Profile** → **Manage Google Account**.

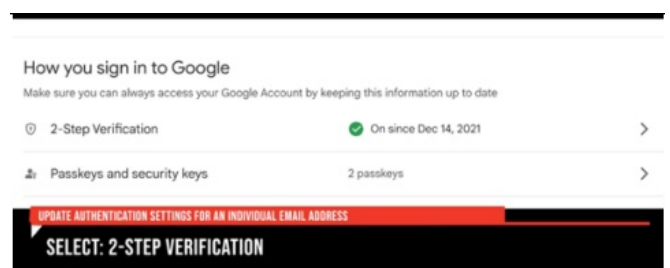


9. Select **Security**.

10. Select **2-Step Verification / Get Started**

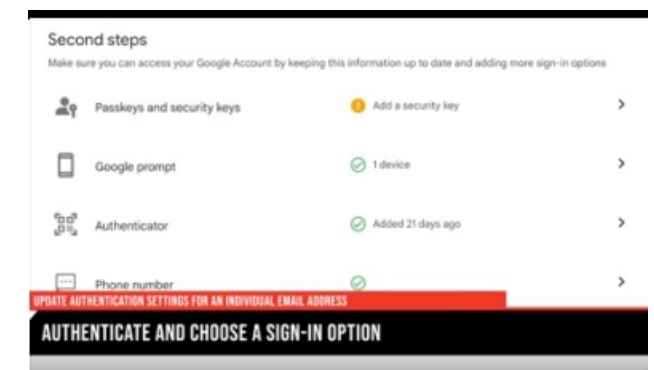
under subsection *How you sign in to Google*.

11. Enter the Gmail account **password** when prompted.

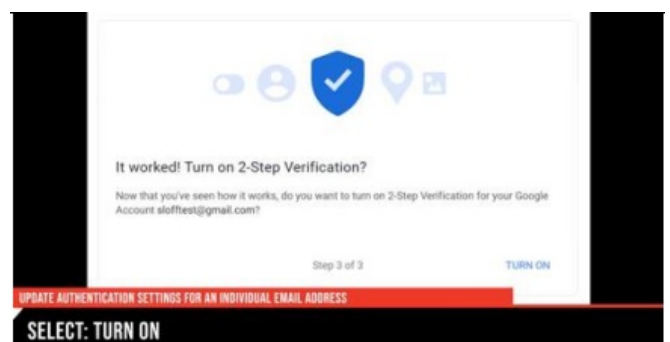


12. Choose a **sign-in method** for 2-Step Verification.

13. Select **Try It** → Follow the **Menu Prompts**.



14. After completing step 7, a confirmation screen will display "it worked!" Select **TURN ON** to enable 2-Step Verification.



15. Return to the Security page. Select **App Passwords** under *How you sign in to Google*.

16. Reauthenticate when prompted.



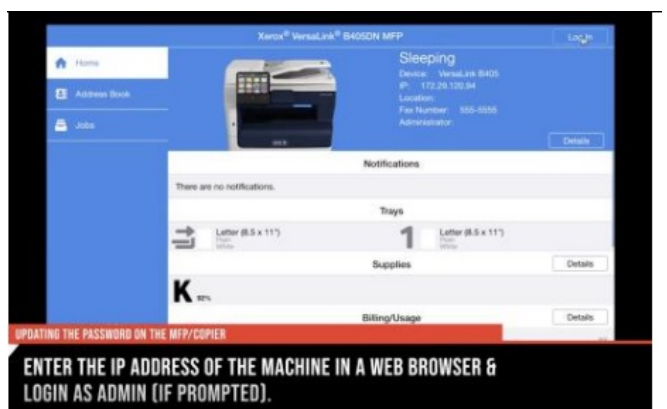
17. Select **App**. Then, choose **Mail** as the app type and select **Other**.

18. **Name** the scan device (ex: Canon MFP) and select **generate**.

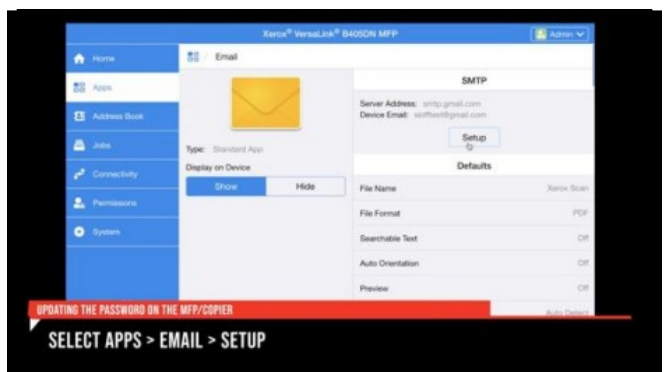
19. **IMPORTANT:** Make sure to write down the password before continuing to next section!



1. Enter the **IP Address** of the machine in a web browser. Login as Admin (if prompted).



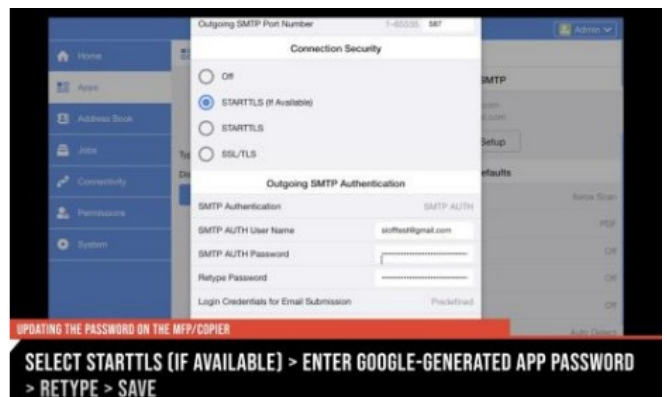
2. Select **Apps** → **Email** → **Setup**.



3. Select **STARTTLS (If Available)**.

4. Enter in the **Google-Generated App Password** → **Retype**.


5. Select **Save**.
