


- Download and install the Logitech Presentation Software.
- Remove the USB receiver and plug in the charging cable to charge your Spotlight for 1 minute.

• Plug the USB receiver into your computer, or connect via Bluetooth.

• CONNECT WITH THE USB RECEIVER



• CONNECT USING BLUETOOTH




Press and hold the top and bottom buttons at the same time for 3 seconds.

The remote should vibrate and then be available for Bluetooth pairing for three minutes.

Product Overview



1. LED INDICATOR

Instant feedback on battery and connectivity status

2. POINTER EFFECTS

- Press and hold the button while moving your hand to highlight on your screen and control the on-screen cursor
- Simple press to click on links and videos
- Double press to toggle between pointer modes
- Press and hold to use custom functions like 'Start presentation'

3. **BACK**

Simple press to navigate backward

Press and hold to use custom functions like 'Blank Screen'

4. HAPTIC FEEDBACK

Receive silent vibration alerts when using the timers and when the battery is low.

5. RECHARGEABLE USB-C

Up to 3 months of battery life on a single charge via the USB Type-C charging cable.


LOGITECH PRESENTATION SOFTWARE OVERVIEW

The Logitech Presentation Software allows you to use the Spotlight pointer effects, to set timers and vibration alerts, to start and go back to your presentation, to customize button functions, and monitor battery life.

When the software is not installed you will only have the following plug-and-play functionality:

- Next/Back to navigate your slides
- · Mouse cursor control to click on links and videos

The software works on Windows and Mac and can be downloaded here.



1. TIMER

Track presentation time and set vibration alerts.

NOTE: To make sure your audience does not see the timer window, it will only be visible on your laptop presenter screen when connected to an external screen or projector with an extended display (not visible when mirroring or duplicating screens). The window appears when you start your presentation.

2. POINTER

Activate the Spotlight on-screen pointer effects and customize their size, contrast, and color.

TIP: Double press the highlight button on your Spotlight to toggle between pointer effects.

3. HOLD NEXT BUTTON

Press and hold the next button to start your presentation.

4. HOLD BACK BUTTON

You can customize the long-press on this button. For instance, you can use this to show a blank screen when you want your audience.

You will receive an on-screen notification to let you know when the battery is running low.

Gone are those days when you have to install the Logitech Presentation software with admin rights. This Lite software can be exported to your favorite external flash or storage devices.

Download/Install

Logitech Presentation Lite can be downloaded directly from the website or you can export it from your existing Logitech Presentation software.

To export an existing installation:

- 1. Open the app.
- 2. Click Present anywhere.
- 3. Follow the on-screen instructions.

NOTE: When you choose the export option, the settings and customizations you have already made will also be migrated into the external storage device.

To download and install from the website:

- 1. Download the lite version software.
- 2. Make sure you have a flash drive plugged in with a minimum of 50 MB of storage.
- 3. Install the software and select the flash drive if there is more than one plugged in.

Highlight and Magnify: Move beyond traditional laser pointers with the Spotlight remote's advanced pointer
system. You can precisely highlight or magnify specific areas of your presentation, making it easier for your
audience to focus on key details. This feature is visible both in-person and during video conferences.

Care and Maintenance

• Cleaning: Wipe the remote with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or immersing the device in water.

- Battery Care: Charge the remote regularly and avoid overcharging. Store it in a cool, dry place when not in use.
- Storage: Keep the remote in its carrying pouch to protect it from dust and damage.

Troubleshooting

Issue	Solution				
Remote Not Responding	Ensure the USB receiver is properly connected or Bluetooth is enabled. Check batte ry charge and replace if necessary.				
Pointer Not Visible	Verify that the pointer mode is enabled in the Logitech Presentation app. Ensure the remote is in range of the receiver.				
Connectivity Problems	Re-pair the remote with the USB receiver or Bluetooth. Make sure no other devices a re interfering with the signal.				
Vibration Alerts Not W orking	Check the settings in the Logitech Presentation app to ensure vibration alerts are en abled and configured.				
Battery Issues	Charge the remote using the provided cable. If issues persist, replace the battery or contact customer support.				
Custom Buttons Not R esponding	Reconfigure button settings through the Logitech Presentation app. Ensure the app i s updated to the latest version.				
Cursor Control Issues	Restart the remote and the computer. Check for software updates and ensure that cursor control is activated in the app.				
App Not Detecting Re mote	Reinstall the Logitech Presentation app. Ensure your device's Bluetooth is enabled a nd functioning properly.
