


• Ensure the headphone and microphone plugs are inserted in the respective headphone and microphone jacks on your computer's sound card.



• Increase the input and output audio volumes in the operating system and application.



- Unplug USB audio devices from your computer.
- Set your computer's sound card as the default audio device in the Sounds Control Panel, and then restart the application you wish to use with the headset.

Listening advice to avoid hearing damage

Listening via headphones, earbuds, or headsets at a high volume may cause permanent hearing loss to occur. The louder the volume, the less time is required before your hearing could be affected.

To establish a safe volume level:

- Start your equipment with the volume control at its lowest setting.
- Slowly increase the sound until you can hear it comfortably and clearly, and without distortion.
- Avoid setting the volume at a level that prevents you from hearing conversations and other similar noises around you.

Once you have established a comfortable sound level, leave it there. If you experience a ringing in your ears, discomfort, or muffled speech, reduce the volume or stop listening and have your hearing checked.

FAQ's

Is Logitech H110 noise Cancelling headset?

The Logitech H110 Stereo Headset is a stereo headset that can be used for internet phone calls, movies, music, and gaming. It features a noise-canceling microphone that eliminates background noise and rotates out of the way when you're not using it.

How long is the Logitech H110 headphone cable?

Logitech H110 Headset (1.8m cable length, 3.5mm audio out) 981-000271.

How do I use my Logitech stereo headset?

Simply plug the 3.5mm jack into your computer, smartphone, or tablet and you're ready to talk.

Why are my Logitech headphones not working?

Make sure the headset is not on mute. The mute light flashes when the mute has been activated. Try a different USB port on your computer. In your application and operating system, check the volume and microphone settings.

Do Logitech headsets have good mic quality?

Overall, Logitech makes very good comfortable gaming headsets that are customizable and generally have well-performing microphones. They make a good mix of wired or wireless offerings, ranging from budget to premium headphones.

How much do Logitech headphones weigh?

Logitech H110 Headphones, Weight: 0.08 kg.

How do wired headphones get power?

Wired headphones get power from the device they are plugged into. Headphones are in fact, small speakers. When they are plugged into a device, they are powered through their audio jack that has an amplifier that transforms audio waves into electricity that powers headphones.

How do I sync my Logitech headset?

Initiate pairing for the headset by pressing and holding for five seconds the Volume + and Next track/ Fast forward buttons on the headset. Next, initiate paring for your Bluetooth device. (Consult the documentation that comes with your Bluetooth device.)

Do Logitech headphones need drivers?

But your headset doesn't just need to have high-quality hardware, reliable cables, and connectors, or even the brand name of Logitech – to make sure your headset works properly, you need to have the right drivers.

What is the difference between a headset and a stereo headset?

Mono vs. Stereo: Mono headsets have a single earpiece and cover only one ear. They are ideal for having a conversation while listening to your surroundings and communicating with others around you. Stereo headsets have two earpieces and cover both ears.

Do wired headsets sound better?

Generally speaking, most wired headphones provide better sound quality than wireless. But with the latest advances in wireless technology, sound quality has improved quite a bit with wireless headphones.

How do you know if headphones are stereo?

Generally, if a device has an output jack labeled EARPHONE it will be mono, while an output jack labeled HEADPHONE will be stereo.

Are stereo headphones good for gaming?

Players of MOBA games like League of Legends and DOTA 2, or character action games, or really just about any single-player game will have no issue at all with a stereo headset. Just know you've got options, even if the headset you buy doesn't come with DTS or Dolby Atmos support.

Do wired headphones need to be charged?

No Batteries/Charging: Except for active noise-canceling headphones, wired headphones don't need batteries. Simply plug your headphones or earphones into your audio source, and you're ready to rock.

How long do wired headphones last?

There's no exact expiration date for headphones. How long headphones can last can range from a few months to decades, depending on many different factors including the brand, model, type of headphones, their usage,

maintenance, and storage.
