

FAQ's

How do I connect my Logitech Wireless Presenter?

Using the Presentation Buttons: Remove the USB receiver from the bottom of the Presenter. Plug the USB receiver into your computer. If your Mac asks you to configure a new keyboard, just close the window. Turn on the Presenter using the on/Off sliding switch on its left side.

How do I connect my Logitech Spotlight presenter?

Plug the USB receiver into your computer, or connect via Bluetooth. Press and hold the top and bottom buttons at the same time for 3 seconds. The remote should vibrate and then be available for Bluetooth pairing for three minutes. Complete the Bluetooth pairing on your computer.

Can I use Logitech Spotlight without the software?

If you plug the dongle of your Spotlight into another computer, and if that computer does not have the Logitech Spotlight software installed, you will have limited functionality. The Advance and Back buttons will work, but the pointer functions and all secondary functions will be gone.

Does Logitech spotlight work on zoom?

This will only work if the computer recognizes the pointer as a mouse. As a workaround, I suggest doing a Share Screen > Desktop, then all the Logitech effects will be visible to you and your participants. If you use Zoom to share the Keynote or Powerpoint, then highlighting will not be visible to the audience.

Does Logitech spotlight work on the projector?

Spotlight has three advanced pointing modes 3 Enabled via Logitech Presentation App that works on various presentation environments: projectors, TV screens, video conferencing, and setups with multiple screens.

How does Logitech Spotlight presentation remote work?

The Logitech Spotlight Presentation Remote uses sensor fusion to convert the hand/wrist motion to the motion of the screens. We can digitally stabilize the motion by removing all motion below 1 inch/s. The result visible on the screen is much more stable than a handheld laser or stick.

How do I use the Logitech Spotlight presenter?

Activate the Spotlight on-screen pointer effects and customize their size, contrast, and color. TIP: Double press the highlight button on your Spotlight to toggle between pointer effects. Press and hold the next button to start your presentation. You can customize the long press on this button.

How long does Logitech spotlight take to charge?

Use the included USB-C charging cable and get 3 hours of presenting after a 1-minute charge. Spotlight fully charges in as little as 60 minutes. The device will vibrate and the battery indicator glows red when it's time to recharge.

How long should Logitech battery last?

The average battery life specified for the Logitech POP Mouse is 24 months. It uses one AA battery.

How does a presentation remote work?

Presentation remotes operate on 2 different technologies: Bluetooth and RF (wireless radio frequency). Once connected to your presentation device, a Bluetooth remote can wander to about 30 feet without losing its connection, while an RF remote can manage a range of 50 to 100 feet.

How does Logitech Spotlight presentation remote work?

The Logitech Spotlight Presentation Remote uses sensor fusion to convert the hand/wrist motion to the motion of the screens. We can digitally stabilize the motion by removing all motion below 1 inch/s. The result visible on the

screen is much more stable than a handheld laser or stick.

How do you spotlight with a mouse?

Double press the left Ctrl key or shake the mouse to activate a spotlight that focuses on the cursor's position. Click the mouse or press any keyboard key to dismiss it.
