

## Set up your mouse


1. **Plug in the receiver** Plug the Unifying receiver into a USB port.
2. **Power on the mouse** Move the power switch to the On position. Check the battery status light. Red means it's time to change the battery.

### Using the mouse

#### One finger scrolling

Swipe up, down, or sideways on the touch strip.



### Clicking

The Touch Mouse provides full 3-button operation. Click the left, right, or middle area of the mouse surface.



Click the top 2/3 of the touch strip to go to the Windows Start screen.

### Replace batteries

Remove the battery cover and insert new batteries into the compartment.

## Troubleshooting

### Touch Mouse not working?

- Restart the mouse by turning it off and then back on.
- Check if your Unifying receiver is properly connected to a USB Port.
- Move the Unifying receiver to another USB port on your computer. (Try connecting directly to your computer instead of using a USB hub.)
- Remove any metallic objects near the mouse.
- If the status light blinks red, replace the battery.




