Thoracic Spine Manipulation:

Manipulate and adjust thoracic spine and ribs for better range of motion and function. Use tilting for gravity assistance, flexion, and lateral bend for more specific and comfortable treatment. Utilize dynamic motion for soft tissue techniques and deeper tissue access.

Lumbar Spine:

Perform smooth flexion distraction with side bend, rotation, and decompression options for limitless 3D opportunities in treating lumbar, intervertebral disc, pelvic, and sacrum areas. Incorporate inversion for broader treatment angles and deeper tissue effects.


Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ):

Lumbar spine


