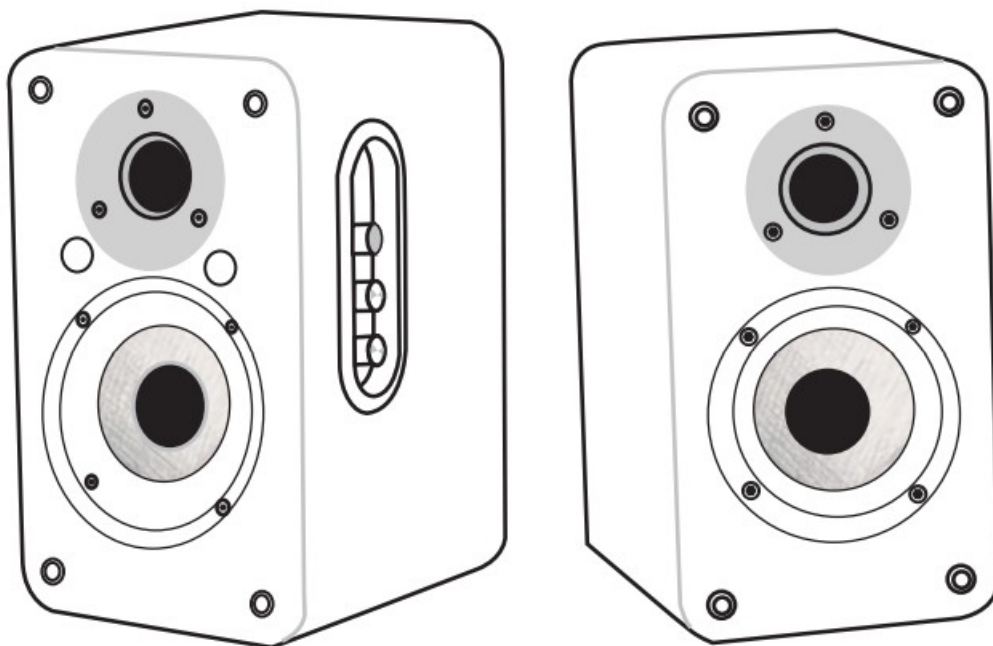

#### **Safety information**

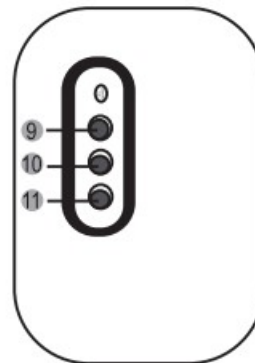

## **Connections**



1. Connect speakers with each other with supplied cable
2. Connect source – TV, Computer, Cell Phone, etc
3. Connect Source – Bluetooth
4. Connect AC mains

## Controls and Inputs/Outputs



1. AC in
2. Power ON/OFF
3. Speaker Output
4. USB Input
5. Coaxial Input
6. Optical Input
7. AUX input
8. HDMI (ARC) input
9. Volume+/-/MODE
10. Treble+/-
11. Bass+/-

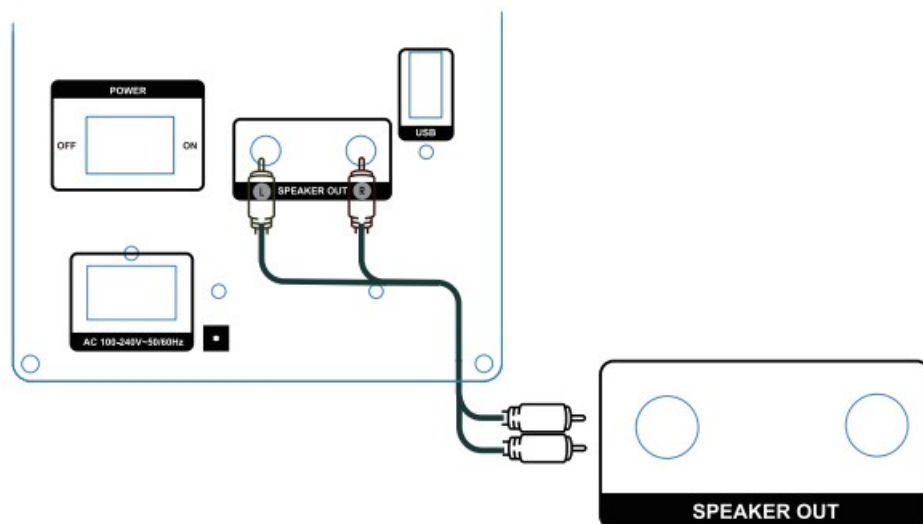
### Note

- The Volume knob can be used to adjust volume and change modes. Rotate: Rotating the knob to increase or decrease volume Press: Pressing the knob to change modes (Bluetooth/Optical 1/Coaxial 1/HDMI 1/USB/ AUX)

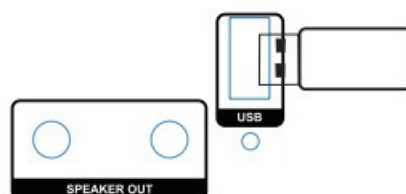
### Note

- Different LED colour correspond different modes [Red-Standby] [Blue-Bluetooth] [Green-Optical] [White-Coaxial/HDMI /USB/AUX]
- When the LED light is white, you only need to connect the Coaxial cable or HDMI cable or USB or AUX cable directly to play the audio source in the device, and the speaker will automatically switch modes among Coaxial/HDMI/USB/AUX

### Connection-Speaker Output



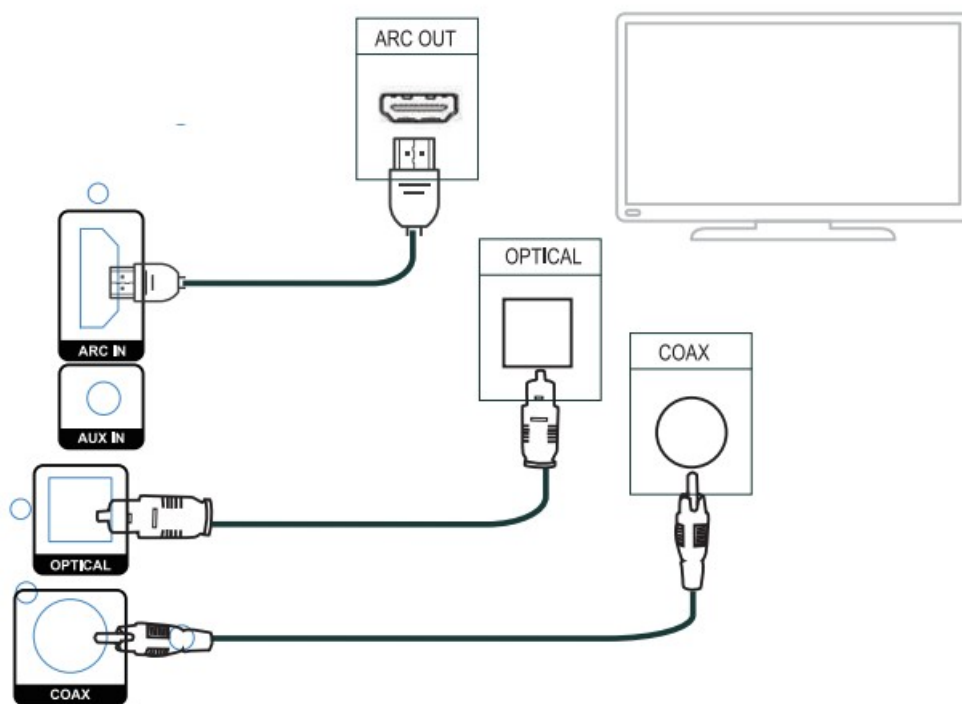
**Note:** The speaker cable is included, you can use it to connect to our speaker or other passive speaker



## USB Note

- The USB storage is up to 64GB, supported audio formats are MP3 and WMA
- Insert USB drive directly to play songs, no need to press “Mode” button

## Connection-Coaxial Input/Optical Input/HDMI (ARC) Input



## Note

- The jacks on your TV or other devices need to be output

- To use HDMI mode, only need to connect the HDMI cable to start, no need to press “Mode” button
- To use Coaxial/Optical mode, please press “Mode” button to turn the indicator to white color first

### Note

If there is no sound after connecting, e.g optical, please set up your TV

1. Enter to TV's setting menu
2. Select the “Sound” or “Audio” option
3. Select “S.PDIF” option

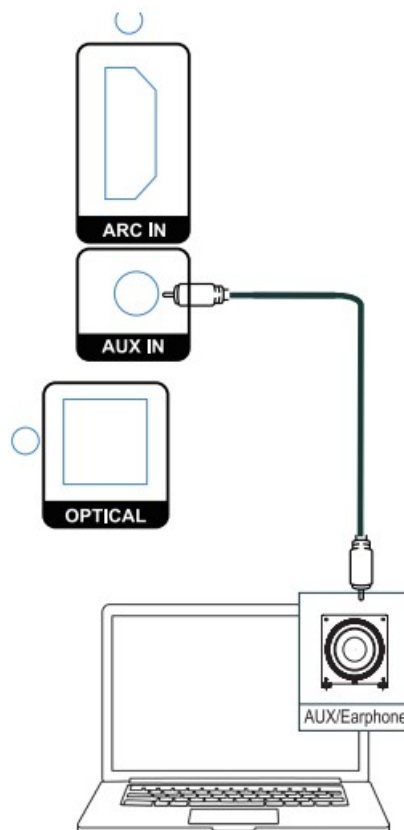
Most TVs have HDMI{ARC} out and S.PDIF options.

- If connect HDMI, please choose HDMI(ARC) out
- If connect optical or coaxial, please choose S.PDIF
- Different devices may have different setting options

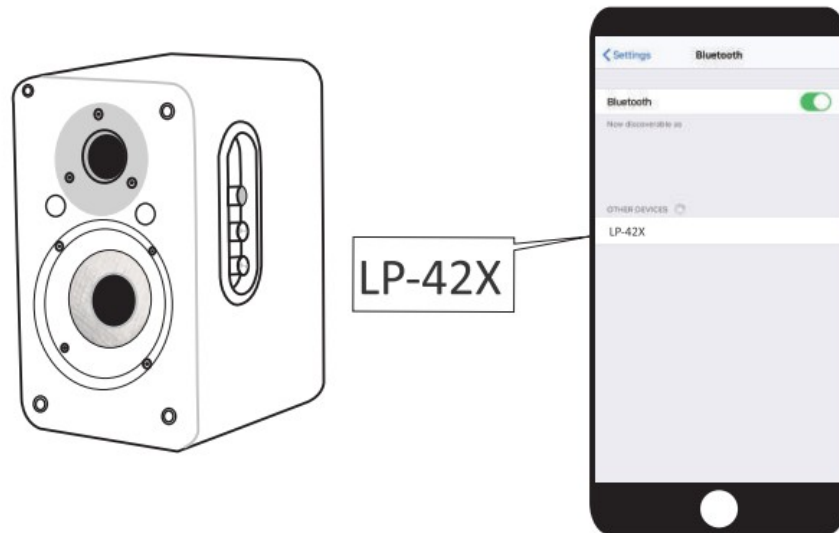
### Connection-AUX Input

#### Note

- Connect AUX cable to play songs in your device directly, no need to press “Mode” button
- The AUX cable is not included



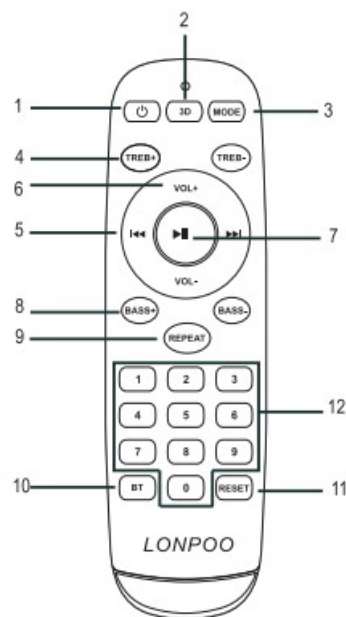
### Connection-Bluetooth



## Note

- when the LED is blue, you can connect your device via bluetooth, find “LP-42X” in your phone and connect it.
- Bluetooth headphone is not supported

## Remote Control



1. Power ON/OFF
2. 3D effect
3. MODES
4. Treble+/-
5. Previous/Next Works in bluetooth/USB mode
6. Volume+/-
7. Play/Pause/Mute In bluetooth/USB mode: play/pause In other modes: mute
8. Bass+/-
9. Repeat

Only in USB mode: one/random/ all repeatedly Long press to resume normal playback

## 11. Reset

In bluetooth mode, press “reset” to disconnect the current device and you can connect the second device to speakers via bluetooth.

If the second device fails to pair, long press “reset” button to connect the previous device directly

## 12. Numbers

In USB mode to choose the song track, to choose the 12nd track, press 1 “72
