





#### Step 1: Wired Camera


- 1. Connect the BNC and male power end of the extension cable to your camera.
- 2. Connect the other BNC end of the extension cable to a video input on your recorder.
- 3. Connect the female power end of the extension cable to the camera's power adapter.

**Note:** The extension cable must be a single stretch of cable between your recorder and camera. You cannot connect multiple extension cables to each other.




Test your cameras prior to selecting a permanent mounting location.


Step 2: Connect to your network: Connect your recorder to your Wi-Fi router using the included Ethernet cable.




Step 3: Connect your mouse: Connect the included USB mouse to the USB port on your recorder. To copy events or to perform a firmware update, connect a USB flash drive.



Step 4: Connect to your TV: Connect your recorder to your TV using the included HDMI cable. The HDMI supports up to 4K resolution and VGA supports up to 1080p.




Step 5: Connect your power adapter: Connect the included power adapter to your recorder and a power outlet. Flip the power switch ON and complete the Lorex Setup Wizard.



#### **Download the Lorex Home App**

To enable remote viewing with mobile apps, you will need to:

- · Have high-speed Internet
- Have an upload speed of 6Mbps for one 4K channel and at least 20Mbps for the whole system
- Find your recorder's Device ID



#### To connect your recorder to the app:

1. Download Lorex Home app.





- 2. In the app tap + to add your recorder.
- 3. Follow the in-app steps to complete the setup.

#### **Fusion Setup**

Connect your Wi-Fi device to your recorder: Set up your recorder and wired cameras. Next, download the Lorex Home app and add your recorder and Wi-Fi device.
