Induction Cooker - LU-3634

The Induction Cooker – LU-3634 is an electric cooktop that uses induction heating to cook food. It has a compact size and is lightweight, making it easy to move around the kitchen. It has multiple cooking functions such as cereals, fry, multicook, stew, soup/broth, boil, slow stew, and chef.

Product Important Safety Instructions

- Do not use near explosives and flammable materials.
- Do not move the appliance until it is completely cool.
- Do not touch the metal parts of the device, because they get very hot during operation.
- Do not use hot plate for drying clothes, papers or other objects. Only use it for cooking.
- Always check the temperature of prepared meals, especially if it is suggested for children. Allow the dish to cool down after cooking.

Cleaning and Maintenance

- Unplug the appliance from the power supply before cleaning.
- Let the unit cool down completely.
- Wipe external surfaces with a damp cloth with some washing-up liquid. Do not use abrasive detergents, any
 organic solvent or aggressive chemicals.

Product Usage Instructions

Before using the Induction Cooker – LU-3634, please read the user manual carefully and follow the safety instructions to avoid accidents or damage to the appliance. Here are the steps to use the induction cooker:

- 1. Place the induction cooker on a flat surface away from any flammable materials.
- 2. Plug in the power cord to an electrical socket.
- 3. Press the power button to turn on the induction cooker.
- 4. Select the cooking function from the control panel according to your recipe.
- 5. Set the temperature and cooking time using the control panel.
- 6. Place a suitable pan or pot with a flat bottom on the cooking hob.
- 7. The induction cooker will automatically detect the pan and start heating it. Once the cooking is done, turn off the induction cooker and unplug it from the power supply.
- 8. Let the induction cooker cool down before cleaning it.

Remember to always use suitable cookware with a flat bottom made of ferromagnetic material such as cast iron or stainless steel. Do not use cookware with a curved or concave bottom or made of glass, ceramic, or aluminum. This can damage the induction hob and affect its performance. Always check the user manual for detailed instructions on using the different cooking functions and settings.
