1.2 Key Features and Functions

Note: This manual covers a series of products. Specific features may vary depending on the model purchased.

CarPlay: Compatible with iPhone, offering advanced in-car functionality.

Android Auto: Compatible with Android phones, providing enhanced

in-car features.

AirPlay: Wireless screen mirroring for iPhone.

Android Cast: Wireless screen mirroring for Android devices.

Bluetooth Music: Wireless audio playback via Bluetooth.

TF Card Slot: Insert a TF card to play music, videos, and view pictures.

Reversing Camera: Supports reversing images.

Four Audio Output Options: Flexible audio output methods.

Built-in FM Transmitter Antenna: Easily transmit audio via FM frequency.

1.3 Applicable Vehicle Models

The universal car player is compatible with most vehicle models.

2. Installation

2.1 Suction Cup Mount

Attach the suction cup mount to the windshield and secure it using the suction mechanism

Install the stand mount on a flat surface of the dashboard for easy operation and viewing.

2.3 Cigarette Lighter Power Plug

This device is powered via a cigarette lighter plug. Once installed, insert the power plug into the vehicle's cigarette lighter socket to activate the device.

3.User Guide

3.1 CarPlay (for iPhone)

Connection Method: Turn on Bluetooth and Wi-Fi on your iPhone. Connect to the player's Bluetooth and follow the on-screen instructions to connect.

3.2 Android Auto (for Android Phones)

 Connection Method: Enable Bluetooth and Wi-Fi on your Android phone. Connect to the player's Bluetooth and follow the on-screen instructions to connect.

3.3 iPhone Screen Mirroring (AirPlay)

Wireless connection only

Connection Method: Connect your iPhone to the player's Wi-Fi. Once connected, select the "Screen Mirroring" option on your phone and choose the corresponding player Wi-Fi name to mirror your phone's content onto the player.

3.4 Android Screen Mirroring (Android Cast) Wireless connection only

Connection Method: Enter the Android Cast interface, scan the QR code to download and install the APK, turn on the phone's hotspot, set the hotspot name to "Car" and the password to "12345678," open the phone mirroring APK, and follow the on-screen instructions to connect.

3.5 Four Audio Output Options

The player has a built-in speaker, but for better sound quality, it is recommended to use the car's original audio system

- 3.5.1 Built-in Speaker Output: Play audio directly through the player's speaker..
- 3.5.2 Bluetooth Output: When using CarPlay or Android Auto, you
 can transmit audio to the car's original audio system via Bluetooth
 (requires a Bluetooth-enabled car).
- 3.5.3 FM Transmission: Transmit audio to the car's original audio system via FM frequency (requires a car with FM radio functionality).
- 3.5.4 AUX Output: Use an AUX cable to connect the player to the car's original audio system (requires an AUX input port).
- Recommendation: For optimal sound quality, prioritize using AUX or Bluetooth output.

3.6 Reversing Camera (CVBS)

 3.6.1 Universal Camera Connection: Connect a universal reversing camera to the player using an adapter cable. Some setups may require an additional trigger signal; this device does not need such a connection. (Reverse camera adapter cable needs to be purchased separately)



4. Frequently Asked Questions

4.1 Audio Noise with AUX Transmission?

Ensure the AUX cable is fully inserted. If the noise persists, the cable might be incompatible with your car stereo. Try using a different audio transmission method.

4.2 Noise in FM Audio Transmission?

The current FM frequency may be interfered with by local radio stations.
 Adjust to a different frequency to resolve the issue.

4.3 Bluetooth Connection Issues or Limited Functionality?

- Bluetooth connectivity problems may occur due to interference from multiple paired devices:
 - 1. Remove all paired Bluetooth devices from your phone.
 - 2. Restart your phone's Bluetooth and reconnect to the player.

4.4 Can't read or play videos from the TF card?

- 1. Low-quality TF cards may cause these errors. Use a high-quality TF card.
- 2. The device supports TF cards up to 256GB. Some high-capacity cards may not be compatible.
- 3. Format the TF card to FAT32 before use to ensure proper functionality.
- 4.It's possible that partially encoded video or audio files may not be recognized by the device. In such cases, please use media files in common formats.

4.5 Delayed or Sluggish CarPlay/Android Auto Performance?

These features rely on protocols to connect your phone to the player, with apps running on the phone. Delays may occur due to outdated phone hardware or a sluggish operating system. Optimize your phone's system, update the software, or use a newer phone model for better performance.
