1. Download "Milesight ToolBox" App on an NFC-supported or Bluetooth-supported smartphone.



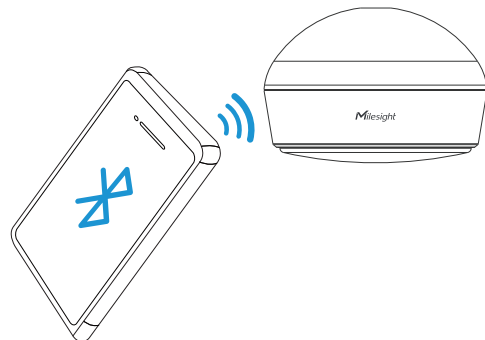

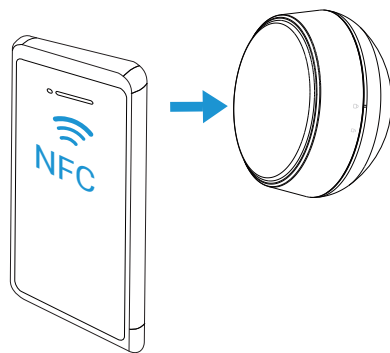

2. Enable Bluetooth and location function on the smart phone.
3. Open "Milesight ToolBox" App, select Bluetooth method and search for the target device to connect, and then enter the Bluetooth password to read/write the device until App shows a successful prompt. It's suggested to configure a device password for security. (Default password: 123456)



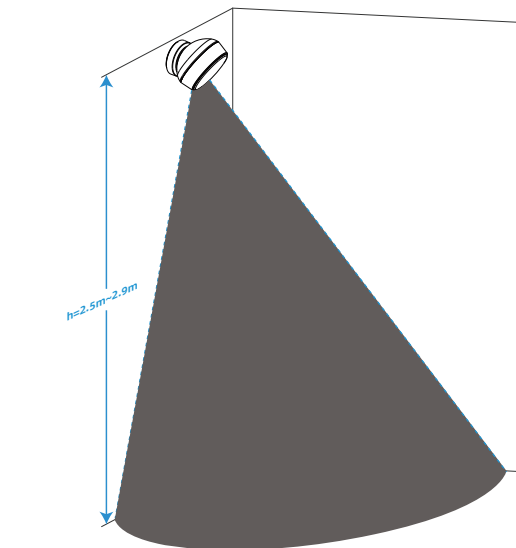
NFC Configuration

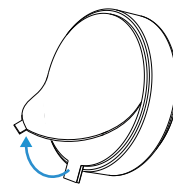

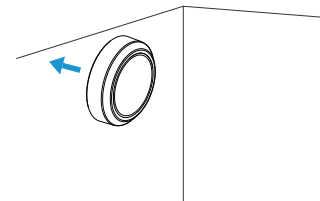
Location: On a wall at a height of 2.5 to 2.9 meters. Ceiling installation is not supported.



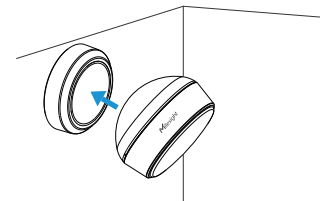

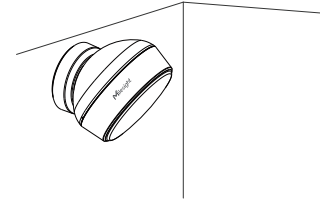

Installation Note:

- It is recommended to install the device at a higher position and tilt it downward. Adjust the tilt angle according to the actual situation to ensure the target is within the detection range.
- Do not face the device directly towards smooth surfaces (such as walls, metal, glass, etc.) at close range to avoid reflection interference. Avoid placing multiple devices too close to each other and overlapping
