The following illustration shows the cable routing as well as the position of the individual components.

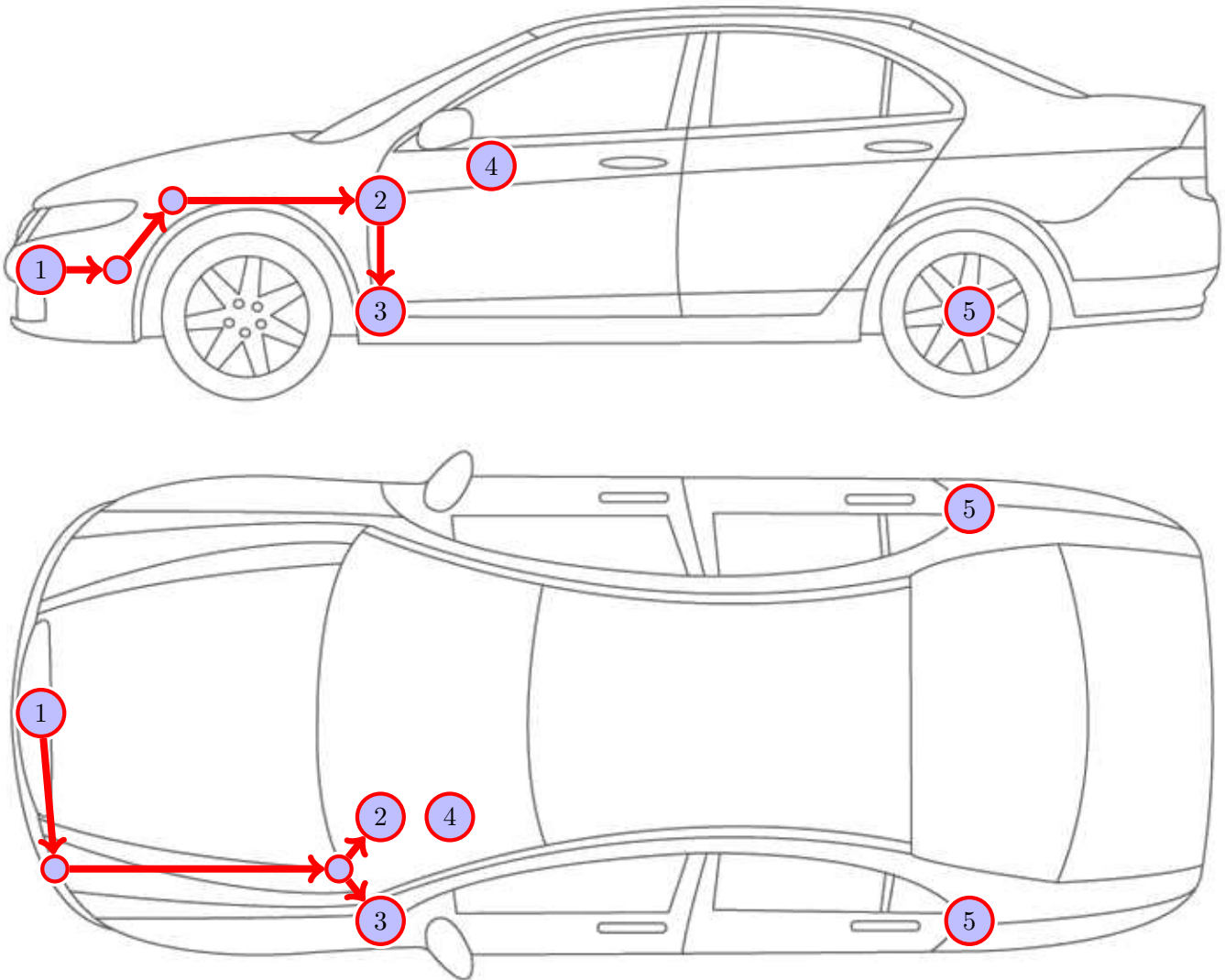


Figure 3: Vehicle Overview

- 1 Sensor
- 2 Connection CAN High & Low / ignition plus
- 3 Connection separation point / ground
- 4 Steering wheel button or steering column switch
- 5 Rotational speed sensor
