Initial Setup

- Read all important safeguards in the *Safety, Maintenance and Warranty* booklet before use. Failure to do so may result in property damage and/or personal injury.
- **ONLY** use Air Fryer Lid with a compatible Instant Pot multi-use pressure cooker. You must use an Instant Pot stainless steel inner pot.
- Remove all packaging material from the appliance and ensure all parts and accessories are accounted for.
- Follow Care and Cleaning instructions in the *Safety, Maintenance and Warranty* booklet to clean the appliance before first use.
- Leave at least 5" / 13 cm of space around the appliance, and do not block the air vents.
- Do not remove safety warning stickers from the appliance.



⚠ WARNING

Overloading electrical circuits can lead to fire, burns and injury. Do NOT plug in Air Fryer Lid and the Instant Pot Multi-Use Pressure Cooker base at the same time. Always unplug Instant Pot Multi-Use Pressure Cooker base BEFORE plugging in Air Fryer Lid.

Pressure Cook Your Food First

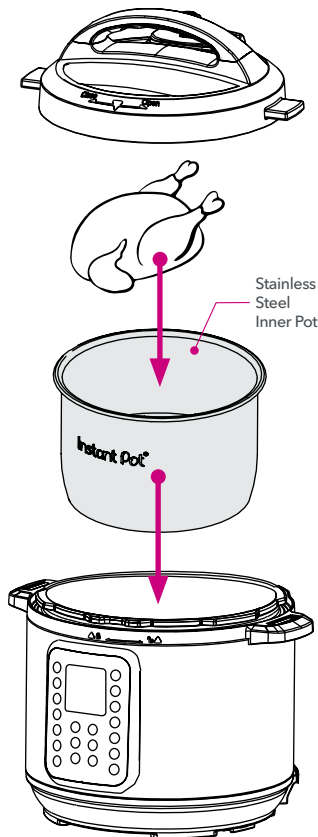
Place food into the stainless steel inner pot then insert inner pot into Instant Pot cooker base. Follow cooking instructions from your **Instant Pot Multi-Use Pressure Cooker** manual.

When pressure cooking is complete and you have released all pressure, remove the pressure cooker lid.

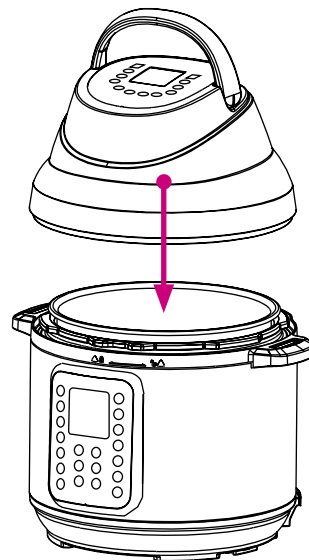
Always unplug Instant Pot multi-use pressure cooker base BEFORE plugging in Air Fryer Lid.

Place the Air Fryer Lid on the Instant Pot cooker base.

Note: Only use an Instant Pot stainless steel inner pot when using the Air Fryer Lid. **Do not use a ceramic coated inner pot.**



Follow the steps starting on Page 10 to finish off your recipe with the Air Fryer Lid.

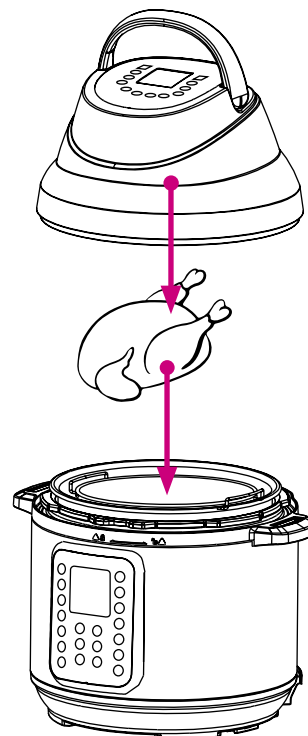
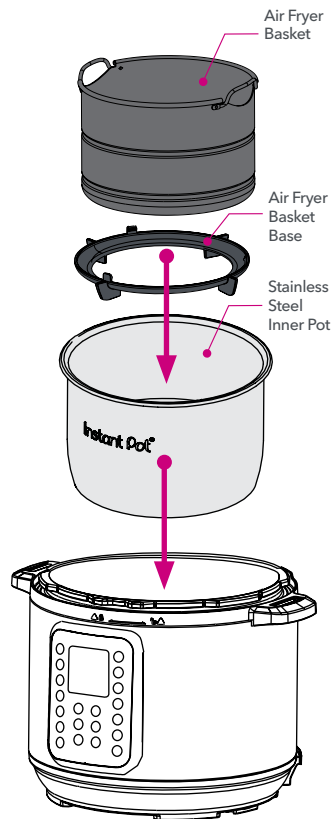

Air Fry Only

If not pressure cooking first, attach the air fryer basket to the air fryer basket base and insert them (or other oven-safe cookware) into the stainless steel inner pot, then add your food.

Always unplug Instant Pot multi-use pressure cooker base BEFORE plugging in Air Fryer Lid.

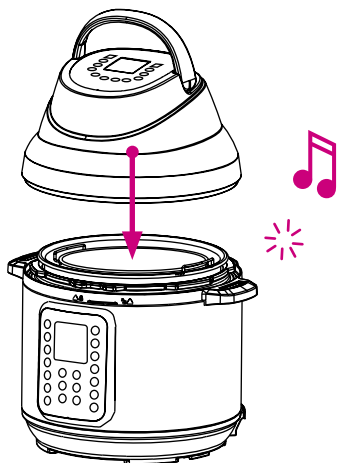

Place the Air Fryer Lid on the Instant Pot cooker base.

Note: A jingle plays when the Air Fryer Lid is placed correctly.



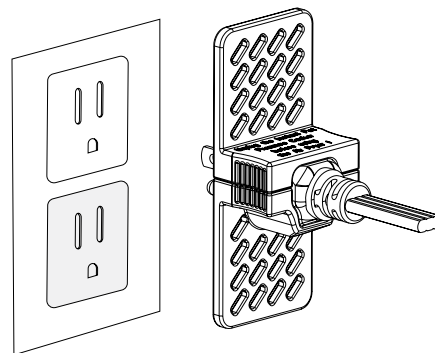
⚠ WARNING

Connect Air Fryer Lid power cord to a 120 V power source.

Display indicates **OFF** and the lid will beep once.



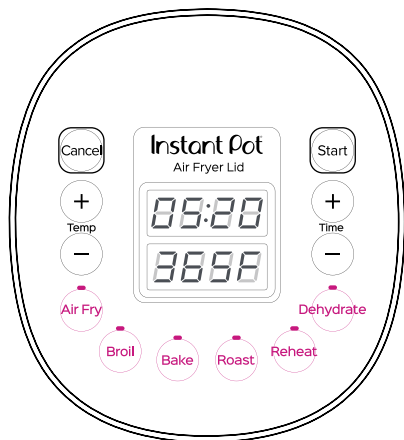
⚠ WARNING

Do not remove plug cover. Pressure Cooker must be unplugged and only the Air Fryer Lid should be plugged in.

Select a Smart Program:

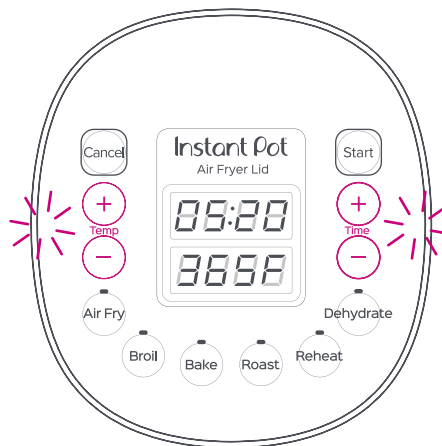
Air Fry, Broil, Bake, Roast, Reheat
or Dehydrate.

Use the **+** / **-** keys to adjust the **Time**
and **Temperature**.

Note: The Air Fryer Lid will save any customization made to the cook time or temperature once you selected **Start**.

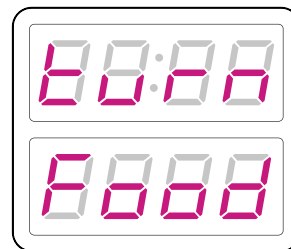
Press **Start**.

The display indicates **On** as the Air Fryer Lid **Preheats**.

Part way through the cooking cycle the lid beeps and the display indicates **turn Food**.



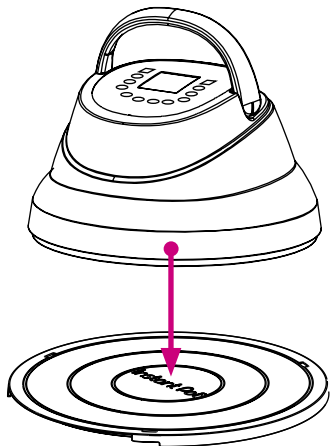
⚠ CAUTION

The inner pot and accessories will be hot. Exercise caution when placing food in a preheated air fryer basket.

Lift the Air Fryer Lid off the Instant Pot cooker base and place it on the protection pad provided.

Lifting the lid automatically pauses cooking. Cooking will resume if the lid is put back on the cooker base within 3 minutes. If not, the lid will go into standby mode and display **OFF**.

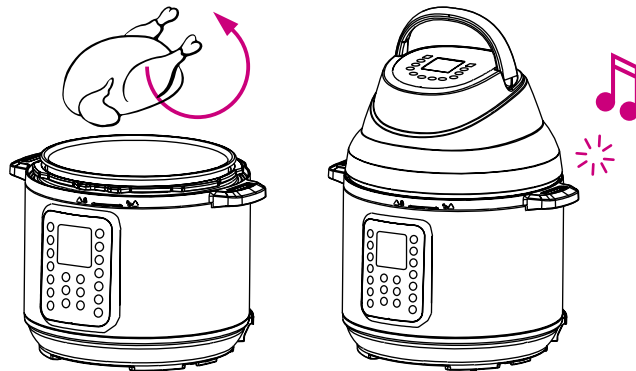

Turn, flip, or rotate your food, then place the Air Fryer Lid on the Instant Pot cooker base to resume cooking.

A jingle plays when the Air Fryer Lid is placed correctly, and cooking will continue.

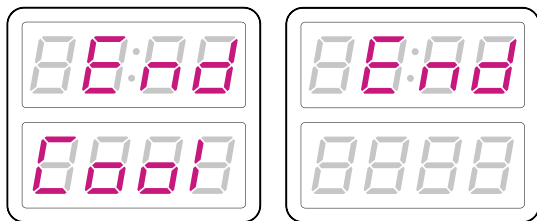
***Note:** Some food does not require turning. If the lid is not removed after the **turn Food** indicator appears, cooking will proceed after 10 seconds.*

When the Smart Program (**Air Fry**, **Bake**, **Roast**, and **Broil**) completes, the lid beeps and the display indicates **End** and **Cool**. The fan will continue to run for 5 minutes or stop immediately when you lift the lid off. The display will indicate **OFF**.

For **Reheat** and **Dehydrate** Smart Programs, when the program finishes, the lid beeps and the display indicates **End**.

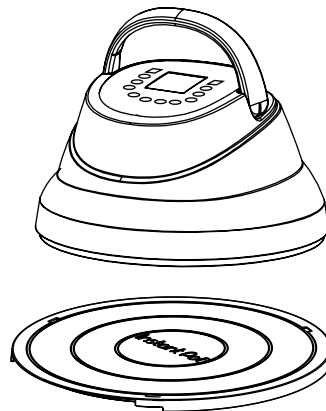


Note: If **Cancel** is pressed during the cooking program, the display will indicate **OFF** and you can select another program. The display will also indicate **Cool** and the fan will run for 5 minutes or until you change the program.

Lift the Air Fryer Lid off the Instant Pot cooker base and place it on the protective pad, or let the Air Fryer Lid keep your food warm for up to 1 hour.

Note: The Air Fryer Lid will beep to remind you that cooking has ended 5 minutes, 20 minutes and 60 minutes after cooking has completed.



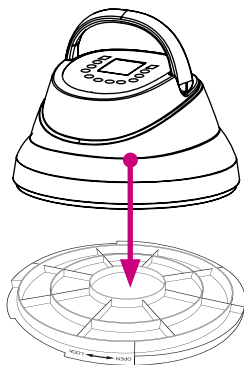
CAUTION

Carefully remove your food, serve and enjoy!

To store your Air Fryer Lid, flip the protective pad so the grooved side is up and attach it to the Air Fryer Lid.

More Controls

More Controls

Cancel	Press to stop a Smart Program at any time. Display returns to Standby and indicates OFF .
Sound On/Off	Press and hold + over Time until the display indicates S On (Sound On) or SOFF (Sound Off). <i>Note: Error alerts cannot be silenced.</i>
Temp. Display °F/ °C	When in Standby (OFF), press and hold + above Temp until the display indicates F or C . The unit indicated is the current selection.
Smart Program Functional Reset	When in Standby, press and hold one of the Smart Program functional keys (Air Fry, Broil, Roast, Reheat, Dehydrate) until the Air Fryer Lid beeps. The desired function is reset to default setting.
Full Reset	When in Standby (OFF), press and hold Cancel until the Air Fryer Lid beeps. All Smart Programs are reset to default settings.

Smart Programs

Depending on your recipe, food may be placed in the multi-level air fryer basket, or directly in the inner pot. Smart Programs are preset to specific times and temperatures. These can be changed by pressing **+** / **-** of **Temp** and **Time**. The default setting and change range of each Smart Program function is as follows:

Smart Programs	Time Default	Time Range	Temp Default	Temp Range	Recommended Accessory
Air Fry	20 mins	1-45 mins	400°F / 204°C	300-400°F / 149-204°C	Air Fryer Basket
Roast	40 mins	1-45 mins	380°F / 193°C	250-380°F / 121-193°C	Air Fryer Basket
Broil	10 mins	1-20 mins	400°F / 204°C	No Temperature Range	Air Fryer Basket, on Broil Tray
Bake	30 mins	1-60 mins	365°F / 185°C	180-380°F / 82-193°C	Air Fryer Basket, under Broil/Dehydrating Tray
Reheat	15 mins	1-60 mins	280°F / 138°C	120-360°F / 49-182°C	Air Fryer Basket, on Broil/Dehydrating Tray
Dehydrate	6 hrs	1-72 hrs	125°F / 52°C	105-165°F / 41-74°C	Air Fryer Basket, with Dehydrating Tray

These preset times and temperatures are based on common cooking times. Always follow a trusted recipe, as time and temperature will vary based on food type and quantity.
