

WIRING & ANTENNA CONNECTIONS

TOOLS REQUIRED


- Panel removal tool
 Phillips screwdriver
- 10mm socket

ATTENTION: With the key out of the ignition, disconnect the negative battery terminal before installing this product. Ensure that all installation connections, especially the air bag indicator lights, are plugged in before reconnecting the battery or cycling the ignition to test this product.


NOTE: Refer also to the instructions included with the aftermarket radio.

DASH DISASSEMBLY

- 1. Unclip and remove the trim panel behind the radio display. (Figure A)
- **2.** Remove the (2) Phillips screws under trim panel removed in step 1. (Figure B)






- 3. Unclip and remove the small trim to the left of the instrument cluster. (Figure C)4. Remove (1) Phillins screw from behind
- **4.** Remove (1) Phillips screw from behind small trim panel removed in step 3. (Figure D)





DASH DISASSEMBLY (CONT.)

- **5.** Unclip and remove the entire trim surrounding the instrument cluster and including the a/c vents under the radio display. (Figure E)
- **6.** Remove (1) Phillips screws securing the trim panel below the radio display which had the a/c vents in it then unclip and remove the panel. (Figure F, G)







- Remove (2) Phillips screws and (1) 10MM nut securing the radio display and chassis. (Figure H)
- **B.** Unclip unplug and remove the radio display and chassis.




KIT ASSEMBLY

Pioneer modular DDIN radio provision


Note: For steps 1 and 2, reference the installation manual provided with the radio for which hardware to use. The display screen and radio chassis use two different types of screws.

- Secure the radio display to the Pioneer brackets using (4) screws supplied with the radio. (Figure A) (there are divots on the Pioneer brackets to align the correct mounting positions to the screen) (Figures A and B)
- Connect the radio display/bracket assembly to the radio chassis using (4) screws supplied with the radio. (Figure C)







KIT ASSEMBLY (CONT.)

- Secure the radio assembly into the radio housing back using screws supplied with the radio. (Figure C)
- Secure the radio housing front to the back using the supplied #8 screws. (Figure D)
- 5. Locate the factory wiring harness and antenna connector in the dash and complete all necessary connections to the radio. Metra recommends using the proper mating adapter from Metra and/or Axxess. Test the radio for proper operation.
- **6.** Slide the radio assembly into to the dash, then secure using the factory screws.
- 7. Reassemble the dash in reverse order of disassembly to complete the installation.
