Failure to use bare when nanding the blace assembly will result in airtskict Incaration.

# **BEFORE FIRST USE**

IMPORTANT: Peview all warnings. hafore ampaeding.

NOTE: All attachments are DPA free. and dishwasher safe. It is recommended that the container lie, and blade assembly be blaced on the top rack of the disawasher. Exercise care when handling blace assembly:







# Hand-Washing

Wash olade essembly in warm scapy water using a dishwashing utersit with a handle to avoid direct contact with i he blades. Exercise care when handling place assembly as the places are sharp. Thoroughly rinse and air-dry all parts.

## Dishwasher

All attachments are dispwasher safe  $\pm z$ recommended that the lig, container, and place assembly be placed on the top rack of the dishwasher ONLY. Ensure the bizde ascembly is removed from the container. before placing in the dishwasher, Exercise. care when handling blade assembly.

## STORING

## RESETTING THE MOTOR

This unit features a unique safety system. hat prevents camage to the motor and drive system should you inadvertendy. over dad the it. If the unit is over daded, the mator will be temporarily disabled. Should this occur, follow the reset procedure below.

- Unally the unit from the electrical outlet.
- Allow the unit to book for approximately 15 minutes.
- Remove the container's list and obese assembly Ernoty the container and rsure no ingredients are arming the blade assembly.

IMPORTANT: Ensure the Linealization depectites are not expected. This is the most typical cause of appliance over dad.

#### TROUBLESHOOTING GUIDE

WARNING: To reduce the risk of shock and unintended operation, turn power off and unplug unit before troubleshooting.

#### The LEDs on the control panel are flashing.

 If the unit is plugged in and powered on, but there is no container installed, the LFDs on the control panel will flash. Install a container and the available program. buttons will illuminate, indicating the unit is ready for use.

#### Unit doesn't mix well; ingredients get stuck.

 Using the Auto-iQ\* programs is the easiest way to achieve great results. The pulses and pauses allow the ingredients to settle toward the blade assembly. If ingredients are routinely getting stuck, adding some liquid will usually help.

#### Unit moves an counter while blending.

Make sure the surface and feet of the unit are clean and dry.

#### Unit doesn't create snow from solid ice.

- DO NOT use ice that has been sitting out or has started to melt. Use ice streight from the freezer.
- Start with a few pulses and then use a continuous blending cycle.

#### The pitcher lid handle will not fold down.

 If not attached to the pitcher, the handle will not fold down. For storage, place. the lid on the pitcher and press down on the handle until it clicks into place.

NOTE: In order to ensure the highest possible standard for refurbished items, all units are thoroughly inspected as part of the process. For this item, water may be used during the refurbishing process and so; you may notice some condensation in the water reservoir. It is rec-ommended to rinse the water reservoir with fresh water prior to its first use.
