Operating Instructions

- 1. Bluetooth mode:**
- (1) Put this product into the car lighter, open the phone Bluetooth, search by the Bluetooth.
 - (2) When there is an incoming call, the product can broadcast the caller's telephone number.
 - (3) When there is an incoming call, the product can broadcast the caller's telephone number.
 - (4) Press want to reject the call, long press C2 button.
 - (5) Press want to accept the call, long press C2 button.
- 2. 10.4GHz / 4.1GHz mode:**
