DUST CUP/FILTERS/ACCESSORIES

Before turning on the vacuum:

- 21 Make sure that all filters are thoroughly dry after routine cleaning.
- 22 Make sure that dust cup and all filters are in place after routine maintenance.
- 23 Make sure accessories are free of blockages
- accessories (failure to do so will void the warrantyl.

HOSE ATTACHMENTS

- 25 DO NOT use if airflow is restricted. If the air paths or the motorized floor nozzle become blocked, turn the vacuum cleaner off and unplug from electrical outlet. Remove all obstructions before you turn on the unit again.
- 26 Keep the end of the hose and accessory openings away from face and body.
- 27 Keep cleaning tools and hose suction openings away from hair, face, fingers, uncovered feet, or loose clothing.
- 28 Only use manufacturer's recommended attachments.

GENERAL CLEANING

- 29 DO NOT vacuum up large objects.
- 30 DO NOT vacuum up hard or sharp objects such as glass, nails, screws, or coins that could damage the vacuum cleaner.

POLARIZED PLUG

To reduce the risk of electric shock, this vacuum cleaner has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other). As a safety feature, this plug will fit into a polarized outlet only one way. If the plug does not fit fully into the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician. DO NOT force into outlet or try to modify to fit.

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TROUBLESHOOTING GUIDE

A WARNING: To reduce the risk of shock and unintended operation, turn power off and unplug unit before servicing.

Vacuum is not picking up debris. No suction or light suction. (Refer to Maintenance section for more information.)

- Check fibers to see if they need elsening. Followins in atoms for desing and drying the filters. before re-inserting in the veguurn.
- Dust oup may be full; emply cust oup.
- Check hose, hose connections, nazzles, and appeasonies to blocksges; clear blocksges if required.
- Hemove any string, carpet floers, or hair that may be wrapped around the brushroll.

Vacuum lifts area rugs.

- Turn off unit to disengage the prushfoll. Ensure brushfol is turned off and restart with the POWER button for suction only clasning.
- Suction is powerful, lake pare when vacuuming area rugs of rugs with delicately sew tileages.
- Te minimize sucrien, refer to Sucrien Central section formate information on how to use.

Brushroll does not spin.

- if Enushroll Indicator Light on the floor intege turns red, the brushroll has stopded spinning. mmedically turn off and unplug vacuum, disconnect the nozzle, and remove blockage before reconnecting and turning wiccum back or.
- With the power on, recline the handle, which will suformatically turn on the taushold.
- Ensure that the BBUS-BOLL button is on for prushfold to agin

Vacuum turns off on its own or indicator light flashes red.

- This vacuum is solitoped with a motor-protective thermostar. If your wicuum overheats, the thermostativill automatically turn the suction motor off. Perform the following steps to restart
 - Turn vacuum off and unplug it.
 - 2. Empty dust oup and clean filters (see Maintenance and or).
 - 3. Check for blockages in hose, accessories, and inlet uponings.
 - Allow unit to cool for a minimum of 45 minutes.
 - 5. Plug in vacuum and turn it on.
 - 8. Restart the unit using either the POWER or BRUSHROLL buttons.

Note: If vacuum atill does not start, contect a service center.
